- Both starting pitchers went at least six innings as Palm Beach used 7 strong frames from Darlin Saladin to take a 3-2 win on Wednesday night.
- The game lasted just an hour and 52 minutes - the fastest game of the season for Dunedin.
- Palm Beach scored first on a fielders' choice in the top of the first against Juaron Watts-Brown. Watts-Brown allowed just one hit in the next four innings to keep the score at 1-0.
- The Blue Jays snagged a 2-1 lead in the top of the sixth, scoring on a balk and an RBI groundout from Kekai Rios.
- The lead was short-lived, as Watts-Brown ran into trouble in the sixth. The Cardinals put men on first and second with a single and an error - then scored on a two-out RBI double from Chase Davis to regain a 3-2 lead. Both runs were unearned.
- Watts-Brown did not walk a batter in his six innings - his first walk-free outing of the year.

### JUNE SWOON

The Blue Jays offense has gotten off to a slow start in the month of June, tallying six total runs in the first four games of the month. The stretch comes after a streak of six consecutive games in which the team scored four or more runs. Across the last five games, Dunedin is 3-32 (.094) with runners in scoring position.

### HE GETS ON BASE

With a single last night, Manuel Beltre extended his on-base streak to 19 games - now tied for the longest by a Blue Jay this season (Jean Joseph). The stretch is tied for the longest active streak in the Florida State League. Across the streak, Beltre is hitting .273 with a .778 OPS.

### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Including last night's defeat, Dunedin has played 19 one-run games this season, going 9-8. 37 of the Blue Jays 53 games this season (69%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 19-19 record in those games.

### JAYS JUICE

The Blue Jays are tied for the Florida State League lead with 40 home runs. The team trails Modesto by six homers for the Single-A lead. Dunedin has homered in 17 of its last 22 games. Across that stretch, 11 different players have gone deep.

### RELYING ON RELIEF

Much of the Blue Jays' success this season has largely hinged on its bullpen, with distinct differences in relief performance in wins and losses. In wins, Jays relievers have pitched to a 3.08 ERA with a 1.23 WHIP. In losses, the bullpen has accumulated a 5.29 ERA with a 1.56 WHIP. The bullpen allowed all 11 earned runs in the final two games of the series with the Mets.

### STRONG SEVEN

With seven innings of one-run ball Tuesday night, Blue Jays starter Jorge Bautista became the first D-Jay this season to pitch seven full innings this season. Bautista did so on just 77 pitches. After Juaron Watts-Brown went six innings last night, Dunedin starters have pitched six innings or more nine times. Dunedin is 4-5 in these games.

### ANYBODY HAVE A STOPWATCH?

Last night's one hour and 52 minute contest marked the fastest game of the season for the Blue Jays, and the first decided in less than two hours. Tuesday's series opener was two hours and two minutes. Dunedin's average time of game this season is 2:35.

### REHAB CITY, USA

With Kekai Rios starting a rehab assignment with the Blue Jays last night, Dunedin has hosted 10 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. MLB rehabbers Alek Manoah and Erik Swanson both pitched on April 7 against Lakeland.

### PALMEGIANI PARTY

Damiano Palmegiani, the Blue Jays No. 14 prospect, joined the Blue Jays on a rehab assignment from AAA-Buffalo last week. Palmegiani played 56 games with Dunedin in 2022, hitting .256 with 11 homers before his promotion to A+ Vancouver. Palmegiani belted 23 homers in 2023 between AA-New Hampshire and AAA-Buffalo.
