RIDERS FALL IN ARKANSAS OPENER:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Arkansas Travelers in the series opener Tuesday afternoon 4-3 from Dickey-Stephens Park. Frisco (7-3) jumped on the board first in the initial inning, scoring twice against Arkansas (6-4) stater Raul Alcantara (1-0). **Aaron Zavala** started the scoring for the Riders with an RBI double before **Abimelec Ortiz** plated another run with an RBI fielder's choice. Those were the only runs Alcantara allowed in his five innings to earn the win. Frisco starter **Ryan Garcia** (0-1) was handed the loss, ceding all three of his runs in the bottom of the second. **Ben Ramirez** started the offense for the Travelers with an RBI single before Jared Oliva laced a two-run single to put Arkansas up 3-2. That lead held until the bottom of the seventh, when Oliva hammered a solo home run to increase the lead to 4-2. In the top of the ninth, the Riders threatened and scored a run on an RBI ground out from **Frainger Chavez**, but **Geisel Cepeda** grounded out with the tying run at third to end the game. Zavala paced the Frisco offense with two hits while both **Steven Jennings** (0.2 innings) and **Triston Polley** (1.0) threw scoreless baseball out of the bullpen.

POWER OUTAGE:

Through 10 games this season, the RoughRiders have only hit four home runs. **Scott Kapers**, **Abimelec Ortiz**, **Aaron Zavala** and rehabber **Nathaniel Lowe** are the only ones to leave the yard for Frisco so far. Their four home runs are last in Double-A and tied for 22nd-worst in all of Minor League Baseball (120 teams). For context, through 10 games last year, the RoughRiders had just six home runs while in 2022, Frisco had three home runs through 10 games. In 2022, the Riders hit 168 home runs, which was the second-most in franchise history.

ACKER HACKS THEM UP:

Starter **Dane Acker** was strong in his start on Opening Day for the RoughRiders, tossing 4.2 innings, allowing just one run, and threw just as well in his second start of the season against Corpus Christi. After tying his career high with seven strikeouts in his second start, he has allowed just one run over 8.2 innings while striking out 11 and walking three. The righty is allowing just a .167 batting average against.

HICKS IS THE PICK:

Liam Hicks has been treating Double-A like Little League so far in 2024, batting .368 (14-for-38)/.457/.447/.904 through the first 10 games with three doubles, four RBIs and seven walks. The catcher had multi-hit games in the first five contests. He is seventh in the Texas League in batting average (.382) and tied for fourth in hits (14). Hicks won the batting title in the Arizona Fall League, hitting .449 over 18 games after hitting .269/.408/.368/.776 with the Riders over 77 games in 2023 with 14 doubles, three home runs and 40 RBIs.

LITTLE PAPI ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz is hitting .313 (10-for-32)/.450/.563/1.013 with five doubles (1st in the Texas League), a home run, six RBIs and eight walks through his first nine games of the season. In the series finale on Sunday against the Wind Surge, he committed an eighth-inning throwing error from first base, allowing the game-tying and go-ahead runs to score, but redeemed himself when he hammered a two-run double in the top of the ninth in a 12-8 win for the Riders. Ortiz led all of MiLB with a .619 SLG in 2023 and was fourth in the minors in home runs (33) and OPS (.990) between Low-A Down East and High-A Hickory.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

After leading the league and setting a franchise record in walks in 2023, the RoughRiders are second the Texas League and all of Double-A in bases on balls this season with 60 on the offensive side in the first 10 games (6.0 per game). Frisco's OBP (.366) is third in the league while their OPS is seventh (.713) because of a .347 SLG, which is ninth in the 10-team league (Corpus Christi, .264). **Kellen Strahm's** 146 career walks with the RoughRiders are now second in franchise history. Guilder Rodriguez is first with 206.

DEBUTS ON DEBUTS:

The RoughRiders have had six former players make their Major League debut already in 2024 (soon to be seven with **Jack Leiter** slated to make his MLB debut for the Rangers on Thursday). The previous most for debuts in April was four in 2019. The most debuts the RoughRiders have had in a season came in 2014 with 18. **Ricky Vanasco** was the sixth former RoughRiders player to make his MLB debut in 2024 and the 203rd player in franchise history, joining **Wyatt Langford**, **Justin Slaten**, **Justin Foscué**, **Davis Wendzel** and **Cole Winn**.

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending 'Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22
