NOTES AND NUGGETS

PITCH, PLEASE!

Yesterday was Omaha's 2nd shutout win of the season, continuing a strong stretch on the mound for the Storm Chasers arms.

Omaha has not allowed a run in its last 16.0 innings, a season-high streak dating back to 3rd inning in Friday's win over Louisville ... the staff's longest scoreless streak of the season passes a pair of 12.0-inning stretches, most recently between May 3 (3rd inning) and May 4 (5th inning).

After Storm Chasers pitchers worked a 5.36 ERA in April (3rd-worst in the league), the staff has worked a 3.65 ERA in May (tied for 7th-best in the IL) ... the drop of 1.71 in ERA is the 3rd-best from April to May in the league.

After a 21-game stretch without a quality start (April 9 to May 3), Omaha has 3 in its last 6 games, including a pair from **Luinder Avila**.

WHAT A RELIEF

Omaha got 2.0 scoreless innings from its bullpen yesterday, after 7.2 scoreless Friday, which was one of the relief corps' top performances of the season.

Omaha's relievers have not been charged with a run in the last 12.2 innings, going back to Thursday's win over the Bats ... this is the 2nd time the relievers have combined for more than 12.0 innings without a run, also doing so for 12.1 innings between Friday, May 2 and Sunday, May 4.

Yesterday was the 10th time Omaha's relievers have combined to not allow a run in a game ... it was the 3rd straight game and 5th time in the last 7 games the bullpen combined for a scoreless day.

This month, Omaha's bullpen has a 2.82 ERA, the 6th-best in the International League in May.

7.2 scoreless innings on Friday was the longest scoreless bullpen performance of the season, passing 7.1 scoreless innings from the relievers on May 3 vs. Indianapolis.

LET'S RAVE

Outfielder **John Rave** has been a consistent presence at the top of the Omaha all season long, contributing in all facets of the game.

Rave leads the league lead in triples (4), is 2nd in runs scored (31), tied 6th in stolen bases (12), tied 7th in total bases (55), tied 7th in extra-base hits (15) and 9th in slugging percentage (.533) ... in addition to these categories, he also leads Omaha in hits (35) and home runs (6).

Rave has served as Omaha's leadoff hitter in 30 of 36 games this year ... he's reached base to begin 13 of 30 games (.433 OBP leading off the 1st inning), including 4 straight games this week ... that includes 9 hits (3 singles, 3 doubles, 3 homers), 3 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch ... his 3 leadoff homers this year are tied for the most in the Minor Leagues.

5 of Rave's 6 home runs this season have come against Louisville, including all 3 of his leadoff homers ... between 2024 and 2025, Rave has hit 10 of his 27 homers against the Bats, the most of any player in the last two years against Louisville, while his 20 RBI vs. Louisville in that span are also the most in the league.

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 364 strikeouts this season ... that is tied 2nd in both the league and at the Triple-A level and just 8 strikeouts behind first place.

Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.42 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

With 364 strikeouts through 36 games, an average of 10.11 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,506 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

GET RATIODED

A pair of Storm Chasers have some of the best ratios in the Minors right now.

With 30 walks this season to just 17 strikeouts, **Nick Loftin's** 1.765 BB/K rank as the 3rd-best walk-to-strikeout rate in the Minors (min. 100 PA) ... his .213 walks per plate appearance is the 12th-best in Minor League Baseball.

Right-hander **Andrew Hoffmann** has struck out 30 batters in 19.1 innings, with just 4 walks ... his 7.50 K/BB is the 3rd-best strikeout-to-walk rate in Triple-A (min 15.0 IP), while a 13.97 K/9 ranks as the 5th-most strikeouts-per-nine-innings.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has the highest success rate on the basepaths in the IL.

Omaha has successfully stolen 53 bases this year, and only been caught 6 times ... 53 steals rank 5th in the International League.

53-for-59 in steal attempts is a 89.8% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd in Minor League Baseball (1st: San Jose Giants, 92%).

NOAH CAMERON SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline

Scouting grades: Fastball: 50 | Curveball: 55 | Changeup: 60 | Cutter: 50 | Control: 55 | Overall: 50

Somewhat of a local product from nearby St. Joseph, Mo., Cameron was selected by his favorite team in the seventh round of the 2021 Draft out of Central Arkansas. He had undergone Tommy John surgery that year, so his pro debut was delayed until 2022. The lefty has had a steady progression through the Minors since, and 2024 was his best year yet, when he put together a 3.08 ERA across 25 starts (128 2/3 innings) between Double-A and Triple-A. His run in Triple-A nearly had him in the big leagues by year's end, with a 2.32 ERA in nine starts, a 1.01 WHIP and 62 strikeouts to just 11 walks in 54 1/3 innings.

What stands out about Cameron is his command. He's a strike-thrower, and he doesn't walk batters: He had just a 6.7% walk rate in the Minors in '24. There was an uptick in his fastball, averaging 92 mph but with flashes of the mid-to-upper 90s. Although it can be susceptible to hard contact at times, it also grades better because of its command and how well it plays with his other pitches. Cameron's bread and butter pitch is his plus changeup, a low-80s offering that tumbles and misses a ton of bats. He mixes in a plus upper-70s curveball that has a tight break and tunnels well with his fastball. He also brought back an upper-80s cutter, an effective pitch that helps his fastball play better by adding another dimension for the hitter to think about. Cameron is beginning to tinker with a slider too, potentially giving him a fourth pitch. With a clean over-the-top delivery, Cameron understands how to use his pitches -- and how they play off each other -- to keep hitters off balance.

Cameron's mix, in addition to his command and makeup give him a starter's projection, and now he's on the cusp of Kansas City as one. The Royals added him to the 40-man roster last November and see him as a future part of their rotation. Cameron will likely return to Triple-A aiming for more sustained success with his debut coming at some point this year.

Track Record: Cameron continues to defy projections that say he doesn't have enough power on his fastball to consistently retire more advanced hitters. He has maintained his advance through the Royals' system without hitting that imaginary wall. The Missouri native, who missed his junior season at Central Arkansas to Tommy John surgery, has performed consistently well at every level since first getting into minor league games in 2022, one year after being drafted in the seventh round. His nine starts at Triple-A Omaha to end 2024 represents the best run of his career, with a 2.32 ERA and 62 strikeouts to just 11 walks in 54.1 innings.

Scouting Report: A finesse lefthander with a sneaky four-seam fastball averaging 92 mph, Cameron excels because of the deceptive life on the pitch and its good vertical carry, helping to compensate for lower velocity. He added an extra tick of zip in 2024 and now touches 96 mph, and he may still have more in the tank. Cameron's best secondary pitch is a plus low-80s changeup with good vertical separation off his fastball. It's a deceptive pitch with big tumble, depth and command. Cameron has good feel for an above-average 78-83 mph curveball with 11-to-5 shape and tight break that he throws for strikes and tunnels well with the fastball. His fourth pitch is an 88-91 mph cutter with average horizontal movement. Cameron gets swings and misses from both his changeup and curve, and he's a savvy hurler who mixes his pitches well. His arm action and repeatable over-the-top delivery work well.

The Future: Cameron's next big test will be to see if he can repeat the success he had in Triple-A, leading to a determination on if he's got enough stuff to face big league hitters. The Royals added him to the 40-man roster in November, and he could make his MLB debut in 2025.

Made his first start back with Omaha since making his Major League debut, and took his first loss of the season ... opened the game with 3.0 scoreless innings, including 1-2-3 innings in the 1st and 3rd ... in the 4th inning, a walk, double, RBI single and sac fly plated 2 runs against him ... pitched a scoreless 5th ... allowed a solo homer to Recy Hinds to open the 6th, then got a flyout and his night ended ... did not get a run of support for the 2nd time in 2025.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
