Toledo Mud Hens LHP Dietrich Enns (0-1, 3.68) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Robert Stock (2-0, 1.37)

Six Toledo Hens – The Worcester Red Sox look to get back to their winning ways when they begin the back half of their 13-game homestand tonight with the opener of a 6-game series vs. the Toledo Mud Hens (AAA-Detroit) at 6:05 pm at Polar Park. The WooSox won the first four games of their homestand/series vs. Syracuse last week but then dropped the last three games over the weekend. Thus they are 4-3 on this season-high 13-game homestand that resumes tonight with the first of six vs. the Mud Hens. The clubs play tonight through Friday night all at 6:05 pm and then over the weekend on Saturday (we hope) at 4:05 pm and Sunday at 1:05 pm. This evening's game can be seen live on NESN+ and heard on NASH 98.9 FM, The Pike 100.1 FM, and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network.

Turn the Beat Around – Worcester's current 3-game losing skid matches their longest of the season thus far (also from April 5-9). The Sox need a win tonight to avoid their longest losing streak since they dropped 4 in a row last July 20-24 (two at Lehigh Valley and two at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre). The WooSox had won 10 of their previous 11 games from April 13-24 before this mini-skid.

Stay Single Please – The WooSox and Mud Hens hope to play each game during this 6-game set one night/day at a time. The last three series have all included at least one make-up doubleheader. Not since April 1-6 in Jacksonville, FL (no surprise there) have the WooSox played a series without a twin bill. Worcester split a make-up doubleheader at home vs. Columbus on April 8, swept a make-up doubleheader in Rochester on April 17, and just played two more twin bills in a five day stretch during their last series vs. Syracuse at Polar Park (sweeping the Mets on April 23 and getting swept by the Syracuse this past Sunday afternoon, April 27. Thus, the WooSox are 2-1-1 in their four doubleheaders this season (two sweeps, once swept, one split). Last year they played 10 doubleheaders going 0-2-8 in those (twice swept & 8 splits). The Worcester club-record for most twin bills in a season is 11 in 2023.

Last Series – As mentioned, WooSox did win their last series, 4 games to 3 over Syracuse. Worcester out-scored the Mets, 29-9 while winning the first four games, but then got out-scored by Syracuse, 34-20 while losing the final three games including a wild 20-12 loss in Game 2 of Sunday's doubleheader...the highest-scoring game in Worcester and Polar Park history.

Worcester vs. Toledo – Worcester and Toledo met for a pair of 6-game series last season and the Mud Hens won the season-series by a 7 games to 5 margin. A little over a year ago these two clubs (or a reasonable facsimile) met for closely-contested series in Toledo in late-April with the Mud Hens winning 4 of the 6 games. Toledo took a trio of 1-run victories and a 2-run win sandwiched around a 2-run WooSox win and then a 3-run WooSox victory in the series-finale on April 28. All six games were thus decided by 3-runs or less. From August 27 – September 1, 2024, the clubs split a 6-game set here at Polar Park with the Sox winning the opener, 12-2 and the finale, 11-6.

Holy Toledo! - Toledo and Worcester have played 24 times since first meeting on May 3, 2022 and the Mud Hens have won 15 of those 24 games including a 7-5 record here at Polar Park and an 8-4 record at Fifth Third Field in Ohio.

What Have You Done for Me Lately – Some recent WooSox standouts (in alphabetical order). **Batters...**OF **Roman Anthony** has not played since leaving the game on Friday after fouling a ball off his right foot but has reached base safely in 16 games in a row (since April 6) including 13 games with at least one hit and the other 3 games with at least one walk. He has hit safely in 5 straight (7-for-14, .500) with 2 2B, 1 HR, 2 RBI, 5 BB, and 7 runs scored. INF **Alex Binelas** has a 4-game hitting streak (5-for-12) with 1 2B, 2 RBI, and 5 runs scored. OF **Nate Eaton** has hit in 9 of his last 10 games (13-for-39, .333) with 5 2B, 1 HR, 7 RBI, and 9 runs scored. C **Yasmani Grandal** has hit in 5 in a row (6-for-15) with 3 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI. 1B **Nathan Hickey** has hit in 8 of his last 10 games (14-for-41, .341) with 2 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, and 8 runs scored. C **Mark Kolozsvary** has hit in 5 straight (9-for-18, .500) with 2 2B, 1 HR, 8 RBI. INF **Marcelo Mayer** has hit in 8 of his last 9 games (15-for-36, .417) with 4 2B, 5 HR, 24 RBI, and 9 runs scored. He leads all of professional baseball with 34 RBI on the season and is tied for 2nd in the league with 7 HR. Injured OF **Tyler McDonough** has hit in 3 games in a row (7-for-12) with 1 2B, 1 HR, 3 RBI. OF **Corey Rosier** has hit in 5 straight (7-for-16, .438) with 1 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI, and 5 runs scored. INF **Nick Sogard** has a 4-game hitting streak (6-for-17) with 3 2B, 1 RBI, 4 runs scored. And INF **Abraham Toro** has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games at a .378 clip (17-for-45) with 3 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 7 RBI, and 11 runs scored. **Pitchers...**Reliever **Nick Burdi** has allowed just 1 run in his 9 relief appearances on the season (12.1 IP) going 2-0 with 1 SV with just 3 BB with 17 SO. Starters RHP **Cooper Criswell** has given up just 1 ER in his 11 IP (3 games), LHP **Shane Drohan** has allowed just 2 ER in his 18.2 IP on only 9 hits with 28 SO in his 5 games, and RHP **Robert Stock** has yielded 3 runs in his 19.2 IP with 24 SO in his 5 games.

High Five – Worcester has had two season-high 5-game winning streaks from April 13-18 and again from April 20-24. Even with 3 straight losses, the WooSox have still won 10 of their last 14 games since April 13.

Below and Above – The WooSox were a season-low 4-games below .500 (4-8) on April 11 and turned things around quickly to reach a season-high of 5-games above .500 on April 24 (14-9). They are now 14-12.

10/4 – While going 10-4 in their last 14 games, the WooSox are hitting .329 during these 14 games (154-for-468) with 44 2B, 18 HR, and 106 runs scored while Sox pitchers are 10-4 with a 5.13 ERA (65 ER in 114 IP) giving up 72 runs and 19 HR.

First in Class – Worcester leads the 20-team International League in a host of offensive categories. WooSox batters are 1st in the league in Average (.279), 1st in runs scored (157) – they also led the league in runs last season with 869 – are 1st in hits (239), 1st in doubles (61), total bases (390), OBP (.364), slugging percentage (.455), and OPS (.819). The Sox are tied for 3rd in HR (28). Not to be forgotten, Worcester pitchers pace the league with 5 shutouts while their 4.66 ERA is 14th in the IL. The WooSox staff did not earn their 5th shutout victory last season until July 6th which was their 86th game.

Home Run Derby – The WooSox have maximized their use of the long-ball all season as 20 of their total 28 HR on the year have come with runners on base. Worcester batters have belted eight solo HR, thirteen 2-run homers, four 3-run blasts, and three grand slams.

Take Home a Dozen or More – This current 13-game homestand (WooSox are 4-3 thus far) is the longest in terms of games for Worcester this season. The WooSox do have another double figure homestand from July 29 – August 10 that will be 12-games including six vs. Lehigh Valley and six vs. Buffalo. Worcester has played seven extended homestands of 12 games or more - featuring two series each - during their first four years of existence. They have had four winners and three losers during their seven “long” homestands in WooSox history (the first two of which included Syracuse)...

A Winning Tradition – The 2024 Worcester Red Sox went 79-71 to post a winning season for the fourth time in as many years of existence and for the third year in a row under manager Chad Tracy. Trace is only the second Red Sox Triple-A manager to ever post three consecutive winning seasons. Darrell Johnson did so from 1971-73 (the first two years when the Red Sox Triple-A club was in Louisville before moving to Pawtucket in 1973). Worcester finished 35-40 during the first half last year but then improved to 44-31 in the second half. Overall the 2024 WooSox went 40-34 at home and 39-37 on the road. The 2021 WooSox had a 74-54 record during their abbreviated inaugural season, the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73, and the 2023 club posted a 79-68 mark.

2024 WooSox Batters Led the Way – Worcester led all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories last season. The WooSox led the league with 869 runs scored (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was next with 846 runs scored). The Sox also led the IL with 786 walks (Toledo was a distant 2nd with 676 walks). Worcester paced the league by a wide margin with an impressive .369 on-base pct. as the WooSox were the only team in the IL with an OBP of over .359 (Scranton/WB was 2nd at .358). Furthermore, Worcester had the 2nd best OPS in the league at .795 (Columbus was 1st at .804).

2024 Rankings – Worcester finished 5th in the IL in team batting with a .259 average. On the pitching side, the Sox were 10th in team ERA (4.84). Sox pitchers allowed the 2nd fewest HR in the league (141 HRA while Nashville had 139 HRA). Defensively, the WooSox were 11th with a .979 field pct. (107 errors in 5126 total chances).

Players Aplenty - The 2024 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records (previously set by the 2023 WooSox) as they made 281 player transactions during the 2024 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used 84 different players in 2024 (37 position players and 47 pitchers) to better the mark of 79 players in 2023. Ironically, the 2021 WooSox broke a long-standing Red Sox Triple-A record when they used 72 different players to beat the 1995 Pawtucket Red Sox (during a strike year when replacement players were used for the first month+ of that season) and the 2006 PawSox who each employed 70 different players. When Chad Tracy made his Worcester debut in 2022, the WooSox quickly set a new record using 75 different players (that was immediately topped first in 2023 and again in 2024).

WooSox to BoSox - The WooSox sent 28 different players to Boston during the 2024 season (not counting rehab players).

Sea Dog to Woofsters – A total of 22 different players were promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester last season.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) GAME RECAP – The Portland Sea Dogs (11-6) were postponed both Saturday and Sunday at home due to rain. The games will be made up when Reading returns to Maine later in May. Portland opens an 8-game series in the next 6-days at New Hampshire beginning this evening.

Marcelo Mayer Named International League Player of the Week for the week of April 21-27 – Worcester Red Sox infielder **Marcelo Mayer** was named International League Player of the Week yesterday for the week of April 21-27. The 22-year-old played in 6 games for the WooSox during the week and batted .450 (9-for-20) with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 12 RBI, and 7 runs scored. Among his home runs was a 445-foot blast to RCF in Game 2 of Worcester’s doubleheader sweep of Syracuse on April 23 at Polar Park. During the week, Marcelo played 3 games at shortstop, 1 game at second base, 1 at third base, and 1 as the DH.

In 23 games this season, Mayer leads all of Professional Baseball with 34 RBI. Next closest in the Minor Leagues is INF Ildemaro Vargas of the Reno Aces (AAA-Arizona) who has 28 RBI. San Francisco Giants DH Wilmer Flores leads Major League Baseball with 28 RBI. Mayer is hitting .280 overall this season with 4 2B, 7 HR (2nd in the league behind Charlotte 1B Tim Elko who has 9 HR), 34 RBI, 51 total bases (tied for 3rd in the IL), and a .548 slugging pct. (10th in league).

Mayer (MY-er) is ranked among baseball's top prospects by MLB.com (No. 11) and *Baseball America* (No. 12). In 2024, the left-handed hitter batted .307 with 28 doubles, 8 HR, 38 RBI, and 60 runs scored in 77 games with Double-A Portland. He was promoted to Worcester in August but did not play for the WooSox due to a lower back injury. Marcelo committed to play at the University of Southern California before being chosen by the Red Sox with the fourth overall selection in the 2021 Draft (Boston's highest draft pick in over 50 years). Mayer, who was born in Chula Vista, CA on December 12, 2002, is bilingual as his parents, Enrique and Myriam, were both born in Nogales Municipality, Sonora, Mexico.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – The Red Sox today transferred righthanded reliever **Jonathan Brand** back to Double-A Portland and the WooSox added RHP **Cooper Criswell** from Worcester. Criswell was appointed as Boston's 27th man for their doubleheader on Saturday in Cleveland, but did not pitch. He is 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA in 3 games (2 starts) for the WooSox this season – 11 IP, 7 H, 4 R, 1 ER, 3 BB, 16 SO and slated to start this Friday night vs. Toledo.

Since the start of the season (4½ weeks) the WooSox have sent RHP Hunter Dobbins (twice), RHP Robert Stock, C Blake Sabol, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Michael Fulmer, NF Nick Sogard, RHP Luis Guerrero, and RHP Cooper Criswell to Boston; although Stock, Sogard, Dobbins, Winckowski, and Criswell are all back with Worcester. Fulmer elected to become a free agent and signed with the Cubs following his outright assignment. RHP Quinn Priester was traded. And OF Corey Rosier and C Enderso Lira were sent to Double-A Portland (although Rosier rejoined the WooSox on April 20). All players involved are from the WooSox 2025 Opening Day Roster.
