- Bradenton's pitching staff quieted the Blue Jays bats to take a 4-1 victory on Saturday night at TD Ballpark.
- Marauders starter Christian Curtis delivered six shutout innings, punching out nine.
- Blue Jays' starter Nolan Perry was strong, only allowing an Omar Alfonzo first inning homer, striking out seven in four frames.
- After Bradenton left runners in scoring position in the sixth and seventh, they broke through against Keiner Leon with three runs in the top of the eighth.
- Dunedin averted the shutout with a Jean Joseph RBI single in the bottom of the eighth, but left men on the corners.

SERIES SUCCESS

With Friday night's win, the Blue Jays have clinched five straight sets with a split or better. Across that stretch, Dunedin has earned two splits and two series wins. A loss today would mark the second split of the season with Bradenton. Across the last five weeks, the Jays are 18-15. Last week's series win on the road marked the Jays' first road series victory since they took five of six from Tampa, April 9-14.

OUTSTANDING STANIFER

After surrendering 8 ER in 4.2 innings in his first two starts, Gage Stanifer is in the midst of a strong stretch, having allowed just three earned runs in 21 innings across his last five starts. Dunedin has won four of those five contests. The stretch includes a 5-inning, 7-strikeout outing at Bradenton on May 26.

FIRST HALF FINISH

With four games remaining in the first half, Dunedin's record stands at 32-30. While eliminated from playoff contention, a win would clinch the Jays' best first half record since 2019, when the D-Jays went a whopping 41-24 in the FSL North. Dunedin went 32-34 in the first half last season.

NIGHT AND DAY DIFFERENCE

The Blue Jays have hit significantly better in day games (.251 in 11 games) than night games (.218 in 51 games). Manuel Beltre is hitting .308 (12-39) in nine day contests. On the other side of the scorebook, Dunedin pitching has struggled during the day, surrendering a 5.51 ERA, compared to a 3.72 mark in night games. Dunedin is 6-5 playing during the day.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

With Wednesday night's 2-1 win, Dunedin has played 21 one-run games this season, going 10-11 in those contests. 42 of the Blue Jays 62 games this season (67%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 21-21 record in those games.

K COUNTER

The Blue Jays pitching staff punched out 16 Marauders last night - tying a single-game season high. The Jays' staff is second in the Florida State League with 648 strikeouts this year, second to Clearwater's 667.

RAIN, RAIN STAY AWAY

Last night's contest marked the only game of the series unaffected by rain, as Tuesday's game was postponed, Thursday's game was suspended, and Friday night's game saw a 38-minute rain delay.

DEFENDING HOME TURF

Dunedin has lost just one series at home this season: April 16-21 vs Clearwater. In five sets at TD Ballpark, the Jays have split twice and won twice.

ARIAS SHOW

Victor Arias' 8-RBI performance Friday night marked the most RBIs in a single game by a D-Jay since Blue Jays No. 2 prospect Orelvis Martinez tallied nine, along with three homers, on July 17, 2021. In that same 2021 campaign, Addison Barger tallied 7 RBIs on May 28. The two-homer game is the second by a Blue Jay this season (Feliz, 5/4 vs Tampa). 8-RBIs in a single game are the second-most in the FSL this season, behind Jordan Viars' nine for Clearwater on May 30.

- Was the fifth player to be drafted out of Westfield HS - recent draftees include big leaguers Ryan Pepiot (TB) and Kevin Plawecki (BOS).
- Low-to-mid 90s fastball is considered best pitch, complimented by a slider and split changeup.
