LAST TIME OUT: Started the second game of last Friday's doubleheader with Portland. Allowed one run in five-plus innings, but did not figure in the decision. He allowed three hits, walked four, and struck out six.

v. HARTFORD – Hard-luck loser to the Yard Goats in Manchester on April 28 when he matched a career-best with seven innings in a 2-0 loss. He allowed four hits and struck out six. Faced Hartford three times last season and was the winner August 16 at Dunkin' Park with five scoreless innings.

2023: Struck out a season-high nine in a 3-1 win over Binghamton 5/17...quality start (0 ER- 6 IP) in 3-0 win over Harrisburg 5/5 with 8K. Went 7 innings for the first time at AA on 4/28 vs. HFD in a 2-0 loss...Earned a complete game victory 4/22 at Somerset in game shortened to five innings. Had eight strikeouts in a 3-1 win...Took no-hitter into sixth at Somerset 6/24 but had to leave when hit by a line drive (single). Struck out eight.

2021: Kloffenstein spent the entire season with Class A Advanced Vancouver, making a career-high 23 starts. He pitched 101.1 innings and had a 7-7 record with a 6.22 ERA. He walked 61 batters and struck out 107.
2019: Had a 4-4 record and a 2.24 ERA with the Vancouver Canadians, who were the Class A short season affiliate of the Blue Jays in 2019. Kloff made 13 starts and threw 64.1 innings, 23 BB, 64 K. WHIP 1.09. .204 average against.
2018: Pitched with the GCL Blue Jays at the rookie level. (2.0 IP/2 starts)

Obtained: Kloffenstein was selected in the third round and 88th overall in the 2018 draft. He was drafted out of Magnolia High School, where he was teammates with Blue Jays prospect Jordan Groshans. He was originally committed to play at TCU and received a \$2.45 million signing bonus. **Personal:** Was ranked the No. 11 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. The slider is Kloffenstein's highest-rated pitch. **Pronounced:** KLOFF-en-steen
