Last Series: The host West Michigan Whitecaps took four of six from the Lugnuts, though Lansing prevailed in the Sunday finale, 5-3, behind **Jack Winkler**'s first professional home run and 5 1/3 strong innings from **Oswaldo Berrios**. Winkler's homer was the Nuts' second roundtripper of the year, achieved in the ninth game.

LUG•NOTES

Talent Rich: The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in **Tyler Soderstrom**, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of six Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 10) and **Euribiel Angeles** (No. 11), starting pitcher **Joey Estes** (No. 19), first baseman/outfielder **Lawrence Butler** (No. 21) and pitcher **Jeff Criswell** (No. 22).

In Memoriam: Former Lansing Lugnuts general manager **Patrick Day** passed away suddenly of a heart attack this past week. His memorial service will be held this coming Thursday at the Peoria Sports Complex in Peoria, Arizona, at 12 local time. It will be streamed via Zoom and Facebook.

Wearing Out the Pitcher: 1B/OF Lawrence Butler is seeing a team-leading average of 4.8 pitches per plate appearance, with INF Brett Harris right behind him at 4.4 pitches/PA. In fact, no other batter in the Midwest League has seen more pitches than Butler's 189. Butler is tied for 1st in the league with 16 K and tied for 6th with 8 walks. (Butler, who hit 19 home runs last year, also leads the league with an 11.00 GB/FB ratio.)

No. 162: Reliever **Zach Jackson**, a member of the 2017 Lugnuts pen, made his MLB debut on April 9 for the Oakland Athletics. In doing so, he became the 162nd all-time Nut to reach the Majors. There are currently 15 Major League teams with at least one Lugnut representing, totaling 33 players, including five (Jackson, **Dany Jiménez**, **Zach Logue**, **Christian Lopes** and **Kevin Smith**) on the A's.

No. 1637 2018 Nuts pitcher **Zach Logue** was called up to the Major Leagues by the Oakland Athletics for the A's three-game series at Toronto, though he did not pitch. Yesterday, 2013 Lansing infielder **Christian Lopes** was added to the Oakland roster, too. If either appears in a game, they will become the 163rd Nut to reach The Show.

Record-Breaking: On April 10, reliever **Jordan Romano**, a member of the 2016 Lugnuts starting rotation, broke Tom Henke's Toronto Blue Jays franchise record with his 26th consecutive save, closing out the Yankees in a 3-0 Blue Jays win.

Welcome Back: The Nuts return one coach (hitting coach **Javier Godard**) and 12 players from 2021, pitchers **Oswaldo Berrios**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **David Leal**; catcher **Jared McDonald**; infielders **Brett Harris**, **Patrick McColl** and **Drew Swift**; and outfielders **Lazaro Armenteros**, **Austin Beck**, **Jonny Butler** and **Lawrence Butler**.

Recent Acquisitions: Three Lugnuts – pitcher **Joey Estes**, infielder **Euribiel Angeles** and outfielder **Gabriel Maeli** – join the Athletics organization for the 2022 season from outside the system. Estes was picked up from Atlanta in a four-player package for first baseman Matt Olson on March 14, 2022; Angeles was acquired from San Diego with a fellow prospect for pitcher Sean Manaea on April 3, 2022; and Maeli was selected in the Rule 5 Draft Triple-A portion from the Minnesota Twins on December 3, 2021.

International Appeal: In addition to 15 states plus Puerto Rico represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, the 2022 Nuts hail from Brazil, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

Down the Ladder: After losing their first five games this year, the Stockton Ports have caught fire with four consecutive wins, beating the Modesto Nuts 2-1 on Sunday behind six scoreless innings from former Michigan Wolverine right-hander **Blake Beers**. 2021 first-rounder **Max Muncy** is faring particularly well, hitting .314/.405/.686 with four doubles, three home runs and 12 RBIs in nine games.

26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: In an unusual shutout – and a brilliant relief appearance – Justin Shafer relieved Sean Reid-Foley (2 2/3 innings) and blanked the Dayton Dragons for the final 6 1/3 innings in a 4-0 win at Cooley Law School Stadium. Shafer struck out Gavin LaValley to escape a bases-loaded jam in the third inning and was never seriously threatened afterward, allowing four singles and whiffing five. Both Shafer and Reid-Foley went on to make the Major Leagues, with Reid-Foley (born in Guam) currently working out of the Mets' pen while Shafer last pitched in 2020 for the Miami Marlins.

Today: The Louisiana Tech Bulldog receives his first start of the year, becoming the seventh different Lugnuts pitcher to receive a start this season (joining Grant Holman, Diego Granado, Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels, Joey Estes and Osvaldo Berrios).

Command Artist: Of 463 total batters faced in his Minor League career, Leal has walked just 13 -- two intentionally (both on June 23, 2021, at Cedar Rapids) -- while striking out 139.

Space City: Notable native Houstonians who've reached MLB include Michael Bourn, Carl Crawford, Adam Dunn, Curt Flood, Kelly Gruber, Doug Gwosdz ("GOOSH"), Mike Jackson, Scott Kazmir, Kyle Kendrick, Chuck Knoblauch, Jason LaRue, James Loney, Mark Lowe, Henry McHenry, Joe Nathan, Anthony Rendon, Mike Stanton, former Lugnaut Ryan Tepera, and the legendary Anthony Young, who lost 27 consecutive decisions while with the New York Mets.

School Days: David attended MacArthur High School, where he was named 2015 Pitcher of the Year... attended Wharton County Junior College (the Pioneers; Wharton, TX) in 2016-2017... as a freshman: 71 1/3 IP, 60 K, 18 BB, 5.17 ERA... as a sophomore: 76 1/3 IP, 75 K, 5.07 ERA... as a junior, transferred to Louisiana Tech and was named 2018 Second Team All-Louisiana honors and ABCA/Rawlings Second Team All-Region, leading Bulldogs in innings (87 1/3) and ranking second in Conference USA in WHIP (0.90), 14th in the nation... scheduled to be Tech's Saturday starter as a senior, but underwent foot surgery a week before the season was scheduled to start... finished as No. 2 in Division 1 among active players in lowest walks per nine innings (1.20)... posted career K/BB ratio of 135 K / 19 BB in 142 2/3 innings.

Draft Day: Taken 1154th overall in the 38th round, 2019, and signed for \$1,000... scout: Kelcey Mucker... after David was drafted by Oakland, Bulldogs head coach Lane Burroughs said, "He is the epitome of what hard work and dedication to one's craft looks like. This young man came into our program and changed his body, overcame a significant foot injury and absolutely attacked the game with a relentless work ethic. He found a way to get better every day, and is one of the best I've ever seen at commanding the baseball. He is what our program is all about. Tremendous character and makeup, great student, selfless and just a wonderful teammate. He is the ultimate competitor and undoubtedly will go down as one of the best to ever step foot on the mound for the Bulldogs."

Pro Debut 2019: Debuted in A's system on June 27 in AZL... did not walk his first batter until 10th appearance, 20 innings in... promoted to Stockton for final appearance of the year, August 31 at San Jose... left-handed batters hit 3-for-44 (.068) with 0 walks and 19 K's... right-handers batted 22-for-102 (.216) with 4 walks and 32 K.

2021 in Low-A West: Began the season with Stockton, tossing three scoreless innings in relief on Opening Day, May 4 at Modesto... worked six innings apiece in final two starts with Stockton, June 1 vs. Lake Elsinore (3 H, 0 R, 1 HBP, 0 BB, 5 K) and June 8 vs. San Jose (8 H, 3 R, 2 HR, 0 BB, 3 K... in all, walked just 1 batter of 106 total batters faced, spanning 26 2/3 innings.

2021 in the High-A Central: Joined the Lugnuts on June 15 with relief ace Jack Weisenburger's promotion to Double-A Midland... made Lugnuts debut that same day, starting the series opener vs. Great Lakes... gave up a second-inning two-run double to Justin Yurchak but that was it: 4 1/3 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 5 K... stint on the Injury List, August 11-26... 70% of pitches (459 of 655) were thrown for strikes, after tossing 71% (258 of 363) in Stockton for strikes... left-handers batted .303/.333/.485 compared to right-handers hitting .267/.300/.438... committed only balk in his career on June 15, 2021, due to the short-lived stepoff rule, which was not enforced in Stockton and shortly thereafter would not be enforced anywhere else in MiLB.

The Gabriel Maciel Game: On June 23, 2021, piggybacked on opener Bryce Nightengale's start in Game 1 of doubleheader at Cedar Rapids... held Kernels to only one hit (Trey Cabbage double) and no walks in first four innings of relief... in the bottom of the 7th inning with the game tied 0-0, allowed a second double to Cabbage, who moved to third on a Jair Camargo flyout to right... issued a pair of intentional walks to load the bases, then struck out Michael Helman for the second out... got in front of No. 9 batter (and current Lugnaut) Gabriel Maciel 1-and-2, but served up walk-off grand slam in 4-0 Lugnuts loss... struck out seven batters in 4 2/3 innings in defeat.

History Against the TinCaps: Pitched against Fort Wayne just once, tossing four scoreless innings on September 10 at Parkview Field, allowing two singles (by Euribiel Angeles and Brandon Valenzuela) and five strikeouts... Lugnuts blanked the 'Caps 2-0 in a combined five-hit, 13-K shutout lasting three hours and 14 minutes. (Note that in 2022, thanks to the pitch clock, this game would likely take two hours or less.)

2022 in the Midwest League: Opened the season in the bullpen, entering in the 2nd inning in Game 2 of a doubleheader on Saturday, April 9, vs. Lake County, and recording three scoreless frames with seven strikeouts... followed up with 2 2/3 innings of relief in Game 1 of a doubleheader on Thursday, April 14, at West Michigan; relieved Joey Estes with the Lugnuts leading 7-2 and finished off an 8-5 win.
