THREE-RUN SIXTH SINKS JACKSONVILLE

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp had no answer for the tough Memphis Redbirds bullpen as they fell 5-2 Thursday night. After tying the game in the top of the sixth, Memphis (38-34) got the bats going in the bottom of the sixth. With one out, Jordan Walker and César Prieto knocked back-to-back base hits off Jacksonville (32-40) reliever Bryan Hoeing (L, 0-1). Jared Young smacked the third-straight hit of the inning, scoring Walker from second to break the tie 3-2. Prieto advanced to third and scored on a single from Moisés Gomez and Young went first to third. With runners at the corners, two batters later, Gavin Collins plated Young on a base hit giving the Redbirds a 5-2 advantage.

X MARKS THE SPOT

In 2023, Xavier Edwards registered one of the most illustrious seasons in Jacksonville's Triple-A/Double-A history (1962-present). His .351 batting average was the best in club single-season history, with his .429 on-base percentage ranking second. Despite starting the season on the IL, Edwards has picked up right where he left off in 2024. The Coconut Creek, Fla., native has hits in 13 of his first 17 games with the Jumbo Shrimp, compiling a remarkable seven multi-hit contests. In all, he is 21-for-69, slashing .304/.342/.391/.733 with four doubles, one triple, three RBIs, four walks and four runs scored.

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late: Sanoja has reached base safely in 34 of his last 39 games, notching 17 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 54for-155 (.348/.402/.490/.892) with 10 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 25 RBIs, 16 walks and 22 runs scored.

STARTING FROM SCRATCH

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed scoreless outings in five of the last 11 games. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have ceded only 13 runs, 11 earned, on 31 hits (6.3 H/9) in 44.1 innings for a 2.23 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 39 strikeouts against 15 walks during this stretch

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 47 of Jacksonville's 72 games (65.3 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 29 of the club's last 41 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 24 of its last 32 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 20-27 (.425) in these affairs.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 38 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 41-for-hislast-127, slashing .323/.408/.654/1.062 with nine doubles, 11 home runs, 30 RBIs, 19 walks and 26 runs scored. Among the 126 qualified hitters in the IL. Conine ranks 11th in HR/ FB (26.9 percent). The 26-year-old has has driven in at least one run in 20 of those 38 games.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?

Jacksonville's 14-25 (.359) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 18-15 (.545) road record is one of only eight winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 171 runs in 33 games (5.2 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (second-fewest in Triple-A) 149 runs in 39 games, 3.8 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 196 runs (13th-most) in 39 home games (5.0 per game) compared to 147 (third-fewest) on the road (4.5 per game).

WALKIN' IN MEMPHIS

Jacksonville returns to Memphis for the first time since taking four-of-six from April 23-28. Since joining the International League in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp have had a lot of success playing in the friendly confines of AutoZone Park. Since that inaugural 2021 Triple-A season, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .289/.355/.474/.829 with 52 home runs, 224 RBIs at AutoZone Park. Those 52 homers since 2021 are the third-most in an opposing team's ballpark, trailing Durham Bulls Athletic Park (Durham, 60) and Truist Field (Charlotte, 58)

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Divison III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2024 SEASON 2023 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Led qualified pitchers in ERA (3.32)

-Among the 119 Southern League pitchers with at least 30 IP, Monteverde ranked 40th in stranded runners (71.3%).

2022 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.

-Over his final 13 starts in High-A, Monteverde went 3-4 with a 2.30 ERA. He pitched 70.1 innings, yielding only $5\overline{4}$ hits (.211 batting average against) and striking out 75against 21 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Six of his seven outings were in a relief role. Prior to that, he had not pitched in relief since 2017, his freshman year at Virginia Wesleyan. Even during that 2017 campaign, 11 of his 15 appearances were starts.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Monteverde's favorite pitcher growing up was Clayton Kershaw

-His favorite book is "To Kill a Mockingbird" and favorite movie is "American Pie."
