LATE HITS LIFT JACKSONVILLE TO WIN IN OPENER After a back-and-forth game, the Jumbo Shrimp broke a 4-4 tie in the eighth inning thanks to RBI singles from Jordan Groshans and Jerar Encarnacion to go on to a 6-4 win over Nashville Tuesday night. After the Sounds put a three-spot up in the bottom of the first, Jacksonville answered on Encarnacion's 19th homer of the year to cut the deficit to 3-2. Jacksonville knotted the game at three in the top of the third but Nashville regained the lead 4-3 in the bottom of the third. **Peyton Burdick** tied the game in the fourth with his 19th homer of the year and the Sounds were held scoreless for the final six innings.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 33 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 55-for-142 at the plate, slashing .387/.432/.493/.925 with six doubles, three home runs, 22 RBIs and 31 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to second in the International League in batting average (.359) and fifth in OBP (.432). Among the 272 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards ranks second in swinging-strike rate (3.9 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 44 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 45-for-153 (.294/.379/.699/1.078) at the plate with nine doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 43 RBIs and 30 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 19.3 percent of the time in 2023.

STOCKING STUFFED

Jacksonville's 9-8 loss on Sunday to Worcester capped a sweep for the Red Sox. The brooming marked the first time since losing all five games of a series from May 1-5, 2019 at Mississippi. The Jumbo Shrimp had not been broomed at home since Montgomery swept a six-game series from June 28-July 3, 2018 at 121 Financial Ballpark. Meanwhile, Worcester has won eight of the nine games they've played at 121 Financial Ballpark over the last two years.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Following their 6-4 win over Nashville on Tuesday, 11 of Jacksonville's last 11 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 90 games played thus far in 2023, 49 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 23-26 (.469) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer.

ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 - and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. In the other 10 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 4-6, with three of those victories coming by one run. In five games, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 31 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are -26 against their other second-half opponents (Durham, Worcester & Nashville).

MINIMUM EFFICIENCY

Over the entirety of their six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9, the Jumbo Shrimp walked just 20 Knights. Jacksonville has followed that up with a whopping 35 walks over their last 11 games, including 11 on Saturday against Worcester, which matched a season-high. The Jumbo Shrimp have thrown 778 pitches during the 36 innings they've played since that series (21.6 per inning). In comparison, the WooSox and Sounds have tossed 609 in 36 innings over the four games, an average of 16.9 per inning.

SHRIMP BITES

Three Jumbo Shrimp rank in the top 10 of the International League in home runs (Austin Allen, Peyton Burdick and Jerar Encarnacion, T-7th, 19). Burdick ranks 17th in the circuit in slugging percentage (.522)... Xavier Edwards ranks seventh in the league in stolen bases with 24. He has not been caught stealing since April 23, swiping 20 consecutive bags successfully... Jacksonville is 7-5 against Nashville in 2023, but the Sounds have outscored the Shrimp 61-51.

ABOUT RONALD

-Before coming to the United States, Bolaños played for Mayabeque of the Cuban National Series. He signed with the San Diego Padres as an International free agent on August 11, 2016.

-The Padres selected Bolaños' contract and promoted him to the major leagues for the first time on September 2, 2019. He made his major leagues debut on Spetember 3rd vs. the Arizona Diamondbacks, allowing two runs over six innings pitched.

-On July 16, 2020, Bolaños and outfielder Franchy Cordero were traded to the Kansas City Royals in exchange for LHP Tim Hill.

-On April 16, 2023, Bolaños signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.

-Entering the 2023 season, Bolaños has pitched in 18 major league games, including five starts with Kansas City and San Diego. In those games, he is 0-4 with a 5.25 ERA. Over 48.0 innings, he has yielded 49 hits and struck out 43 against 29 walks.

-When he was signed by San Diego, the then-19-year-old was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 20 international prospect in the 2016 class and ranked by Baseball America as the fourth-best Cuban pitcher available.

-In 2014, he played in the COPABE 18U Pan American Championship in Mexico.

-The Cuban native came up as an outfielder before converting to a pitcher.

2022 SEASON

-With Triple-A Omaha, went 0-1 with a 3.52 ERA in four starts. Over 15.1 innings, yielding 17 hits and struck out 16 against four walks. However, over 24 relief apperences with the Storm Chasers, he posted an 0-3 record with a 7.63 ERA. In those relief apperences, he allowed 42 hits in 26.2 innings and struck out 18 against 14 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Bolaños began the year with Triple-A Omaha and made four starts before joining the Royals on June 4th. He closed the season with the Storm Chasers

2020 SEASON

- Made a pair of starts, July 26 at Cleveland and Aug. 1 vs. the White Sox... Took the loss in his first start, allowing two unearned runs on three hits and a walk over 2.0 innings.

-Became the third Cuban-born pitcher to start a game for the Royals, joining Onelki García (2017) and Zip Sánchez (1988).
