

Tri-City Dust Devils Fan Code of Conduct

The Tri-City Dust Devils are committed to creating a family-friendly and welcoming environment at Gesa Stadium for all guests. As part of that commitment, we have adopted the following expectations for all fans and team members.

All Tri-City Dust Devils staff, including game-day staff, must receive a copy of this policy before working any games. In addition, all staff must receive annual training on this policy, the substance of the Fan Code of Conduct, and how to respond to prohibited fan behavior. All training will be documented.

Reporting An Incident

Any gameday team member who witnesses or receives a report of prohibited fan behavior by a fan must report the incident to Derrel Ebert or Ann Shively. If the previously listed individuals are unavailable, please notify Guest Services and an appropriate response will occur.

Use of derogatory language by a fan toward a player, umpire, Club staff, or their family members must be documented by the Club and reported to Derrel Ebert and to the Commissioner's Office.

Fan Code of Conduct

In order to provide a welcoming experience for all, the Tri-City Dust Devils have implemented a Fan Code of Conduct. Out of respect for fellow guests, players, coaches, and ballpark staff, all guests are prohibited from:

- Trespassing on the playing field at any time;
- Interfering with baseballs that are in play;
- Throwing or tossing objects;
- Using foul, obscene or derogatory language (see below) or gestures;
- Misusing or overconsuming alcohol, including underage consumption;
- Behaving in a manner that is disruptive, unruly, or abusive;
- Accessing areas of the ballpark without a proper ticket, pass or credential;
- Misusing tickets, passes, or credentials in any way; or
- Brining prohibited items into the ballpark. Prohibited items include:
 - Beach balls and other inflatables
 - Glass bottles
 - Fireworks
 - Firearms or other weapons
 - Laser devices

- Skateboards and roller blades
- Toy guns and knives
- Sticks and clubs
- Unmanned aerial vehicles
- Aerosol cans
- Baseball bats
- Coolers
- Outside food and beverage other than sealed plastic water bottles
- Cameras/recorders for video
- Animals with the exception of service animals to aid guests with disabilities
- Air horns or other distracting noise makers
- Visibly obscene, indecent, or inappropriate clothing
- Any devices that may interfere with and/or distract any sports or event participant, other guests, audio or audio/visual telecast or recording of the game, or any technology related service provided in the stadium

Derogatory language is defined as offensive language concerning a person's race, ethnicity, gender, religion, disability, age, sexual orientation, or national origin, and anyone using such language is subject to automatic ejection from the ballpark.

Violations of the Fan Code of Conduct will not be tolerated and may lead to ejection from the stadium, a ban on attending future games, or other consequences.

Fans are encouraged to report violations of the Fan Code of Conduct to the nearest front office team member. This can be done in person, at Guest Services on the concourse, or by emailing info@dustdevilsbaseball.com.
