THE LO DOWN: Brewers' no. 6-rated prospect Logan Henderson will take the ball for Nashville on Sunday night. The right-hander enters the game tied for the most wins in the minors this season with nine and was 3-0 in his first four Major League starts with the Brewers. Nashville has a chance to secure their first three-game series sweep since August 19-21, 2019, against Oklahoma City.

COUNTDOWN TO 65: Following the two straight wins against Indianapolis coming out of the All-Star break, Rick Sweet is 10 wins away from passing Buddy Bailey for the third-most wins by a Minor League manager in history.

PATTEN DOWN THE HATCHES: Right-hander Chad Patrick made his second start this season in a Sounds uniform and 26th all-time. Patrick picked up a no-decision, allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits, four strikeouts, and a walk over 5.0 innings of work. It is Patrick's third straight start, including his time with Milwaukee, that the 26-year-old has given up two or fewer earned runs when tossing 5.0 or more innings. He now holds a 3.27 ERA with 11 strikeouts over his first 11.0 frames with Nashville.

PAINT IT BLACK: Tyler Black extended his hitting streak to six games and his on-base streak to 11 games in the Sounds Saturday night win over the Indians. The 24-year-old went 1-for-4 with an RBI single in the bottom of the third. Black's hitting streak is his highest of the season and has tied his season-high on-base streak that went from May 15 through June 17. The first baseman also currently holds a six-game RBI streak which ties Daz Cameron for the longest RBI streak by a Nashville player this year. Over Black's hitting streak, he is 9-for-24 (.375) with eight RBI and three extra-base hits.

THIRD INNING MAGIC: Nashville's offense made a statement in the bottom of the third, scoring four runs on four hits against the Pittsburgh Pirates No. 3 prospect, Hunter Barco. All nine Sounds hitters came to the plate, notching two doubles, two singles, and a walk. The last time Nashville put up four or more runs in an inning was July 12 against Durham when the Sounds scored five runs in the third inning. Nashville has scored a total of 69 runs in the third, which is the most out of any inning this year.

WALK THE LINE: Bobby Dalbec worked a career-high four walks against Indianapolis pitching on Saturday night, and it was the second time this season a Nashville hitter walked as many times. Jefferson Quero was the other, working four walks against the Iowa Cubs back on June 21. Dalbec walked a career-high three times in just three games over his career before Saturday, including one this season on July 5 against Memphis.

YODELAYHEEHOO: Craig Yoho earned his ninth consecutive appearance without allowing an earned run and picked up his sixth save of the year. The Brewers No. 19 prospect now has a 0.87 ERA over 31.0 innings with Nashville this year. The last time Yoho allowed an earned run was on June 12 against Norfolk. The right-hander is three outings shy of tying his season-high of 12 straight scoreless appearances, which he achieved through his first 14.2 frames of the year.

HOM3 COOKIN': Daz Cameron's multi-HR game on Friday night was the second in 17 total games with Nashville and he began the game with his fourth leadoff home run and his second leadoff blast in a four-game span. Cameron has six XBH (4 HR) and 10 RBI in his last five games played. He's one of nine players (6 in Triple-A) with 4+ leadoff home runs this season and the first Nashville player with 4+ leadoff home runs in a season since Craig Gentry in 2015. **In his 17 games played with the Sounds this year, Cameron is slashing .391/.443/.928 with 10 HR, seven doubles, 28 RBI, five walks, and 17 runs scored.**

NASHTY: Rehabbing Nestor Cortes earned the win in his third rehab start of the season. The 5.1 IP and 80 pitches thrown were the second-most in a game this season and the most since he earned his only other win of the year on April 3 vs. Cincinnati before landing on the IL. The first inning run allowed by Cortes was the first run he had allowed since March 29 in his season and Brewers' debut. He had 13-consecutive innings over his last three games entering the start against Indianapolis on Friday night. Cortes improved to 2-0 in his three career games against Indy having allowed three earned runs over 16.2 IP on nine hits.

- Currently ranked as the no. 6-ranked prospect in the Brewers top 30...no. 2-ranked RHP behind Jacob Misiorowski.
- Made his Major League debut in 2025 and tossed a quality start in his first career start (6.0 IP, 3 H, ER, HR, 9 K, BB) against the Athletics...Through first four MLB starts is 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (14 H, 4 ER, 29 K, 6 BB)...One of two MLB pitchers since 1901 to have struck out at least 29 and allowed four or fewer runs through first four MLB starts...Joined fellow Brewer Freddy Peralta.
- Got a late start to his 2024 season after injuring his oblique during the 2024 Spring Breakout Game...Made his season debut on May 9th in the Arizona Complex League.
- Earned Southern League Pitcher of the Month as well as Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month in June 2024 after going 4-0 with a 1.66 ERA in four starts...Held opposing hitter to a .192 AVG and matched his single-game career-high with 10 strikeouts in two of his outings (6/15 vs. TEN and 6/28 vs. PNS).
- From the time of his first start with High-A Wisconsin on May 24th until he was promoted to Nashville (8/8) he led the Brewers farm system with his 78 strikeouts.
- Made his Triple-A debut on 8/9/24 and allowed one run on three hits over 4.0 IP but took the loss...Tossed a quality start in his second game vs. DUR (6.0 IP, 0 R, 8 K, 3 H).
- Finished the 2024 season 8th in the Milwaukee farm system in strikeouts (104) and was T-8th in wins (7)...Added to the Brewers 40-man roster on November 19th. 35.2% strikeout rate was fourth best among 661 minor leaguers with at least 70.0 IP in 2023.
- Missed the majority of 2022 after undergoing non-Tommy John elbow surgery in the spring.
- Pitched one season at McLennan CC in Texas and was named NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year after going 10-2 with a 1.66 ERA in 17 games (14 GS)...Led NJCAA DI in strikeouts (169) and IP (97.2)...Struck out 17 over 8.0 IP with one run allowed to guide the Highlanders to their first championship since 1983.
