TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes lost game two last night, 3-2, and have dropped the first two games of a series for the sixth time in 2024 ... Peyton Battenfield is slated to start for Albuquerque while Carson Seymour is scheduled to toe the rubber for the while Cars
River Cats.

ATTENDANCE: The Isotopes have tallied the highest total attendance in all of Minor League Baseball with 213, 534 fans over 33 openings.
JONESY: In his sixth rehab game with the Isotopes last night, Nolan Jones went 2 -for-3 with a two-run homer and double. Over six games, Jones is 4 -for-19 with three RBI, three walks, eight punchouts and one home run.
DOWN UNDER: Albuquerque is 17-42 on the year-tying the most games under .500 (25) in franchise history (also: Sept. 25, 2022, 60-85, and Sept. 27, 2022, 61-86).

ONE-RUN GAMES: The Isotopes fall to 5-12 in one-run games and 1-7 on the road. The club has dropped six of their last seven one-run games ... Albuquerque has lost two-straight one-run one-run games ... Albuquerque has lost two-straight one-run
games in back-to-back days for the second time this year (also: games in back-to-back dal
May 22-23 at Salt Lake).
CS: Willie Maclver threw out two River Cats attempting to steal last night, the first game since Aug. 6, 2023, vs. Las Vegas the Isotopes have caught two runners attempting to steal. Maclver also nabbed two runners in that contest.

Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach . An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI )... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008
. Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ...
