2025: Pitched 5.0 innings and gave up 3 R on 3 H and 3 BB with 4 K in most recent start on 8/8 @ AKR. 4th-most strikeouts (110) and 5th-most innings pitched (93.1) in Orioles system. Has not allowed more than 3 ER in five straight outings (10 ER/25.1 IP, 3.55 ERA). Holds a 6.48 ERA (6 ER/8.1 IP) in two starts this season vs Erie. Recorded a 4.91 ERA in month of July after finishing month of June with a 2.49 ERA (8th-best in EL), a 0.74 WHIP (2nd-best in EL) and a .135 BAA. Named EL Pitcher of the Week for 6/10-6/15 after 6.0 shutout, one-hit innings and 6 K on 6/13 vs HBG. First Baysox player this season to be named EL Player/Pitcher of the Week. Threw 11.2 consecutive scoreless innings to start month of June. Pitched 5.2 shutout innings and struck out six in Double-A debut on 5/16 vs AKR. Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 5/13. Started season in High-A Aberdeen. Made six starts and posted a 3.60 ERA with 37 K over 25 innings pitched over 10 walks allowed. Struck out seven batters in each of his final three starts with IronBirds before earning promotion. At time of promotion, was tied for 10th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts.

2024: Spent first season in Minors between Single-A Delmarva as a starter and High-A Aberdeen as a tandem reliever. Struck out 90 batters in 73.2 innings to a 1.59 ERA. Began season in Delmarva. Recorded a 1.49 ERA in 48.1 IP with 57 K. Missed a month of season from 5/15-6/14 due to injury. Promoted to Aberdeen on 8/1. In seven outings, posted a 1.78 ERA in 25.1 innings with 33 strikeouts over just three walks. Excelled at home: 0.69 ERA in 11 home outings.

Manager

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
