**RIDERS RALLY FOR LATE WIN TO EVEN SERIES WITH MIDLAND:**

On Friday night at Riders Field, the Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Midland RockHounds 4-3 in the series' third consecutive one-run game. Frisco (5-2) struck first against Midland (5-2) starter Corey Avant on a two-out, two-run single from **Orlando Martinez** in the first inning to take a 2-0 lead. The RockHounds notched an unearned run against Riders' righty **Leandro Lopez** in the second, but Lopez finished with 5.2 innings, only surrendering that unearned tally while striking out three. **Frainyer Chavez** then launched his first 2026 home run in the fifth inning, adding insurance for a 3-1 lead. Midland made things interesting again in the seventh, though, with a two-RBI double from Jared Dickey to tie the game 3-3. **Wilian Bormie** (2-0) calmed the seas and kept the game tied in relief with 1.2 innings of scoreless baseball, whiffing two. In the eighth inning, **Tucker Mitchell** delivered the lead right back for the Riders with an RBI single through the right side off of AJ Causey (0-1) to score **John Taylor** from second base. He also helped secure the game-clinching out in the ninth by snaring a ground ball and flipping it to **Bryan Magdaleno** at first base to strand two RockHounds aboard. Magdaleno beat Tommy White by a step to earn his first save of the season.

**GET RICH OR DIE DREILING:**

RoughRiders outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** has been on a heater to start the season. The No. 10 prospect in the organization is hitting .321 (9-for-28)/.424/.571/.995 with 1 double, 2 home runs, 7 RBIs, 5 walks, 5 runs and a steal through 7 games. He is splattered all over the Texas League Leaderboards, ranking T-6th in RBIs (7), T-10th in hits (9) and T-6th in total bases (16).

**CHAVEZ IN CHARGE:**

RoughRiders infielder **Frainyer Chavez** has been on fire at the plate. On Thursday, Chavez tied a career high with 4 hits, going 4-for-5, and followed that up with a two-hit game on Friday, including a home run. On a five-game hitting streak, he is batting .500 (10-for-20)/.542/.750/1.292 with 2 doubles, 1 home run, 2 RBIs, 3 walks and 9 runs scored. The five-year RoughRider is 4th in the league in batting average (.393), 4th in OBP (.486), 8th in OPS (1.057), T-3rd in hits (11) and T-6th in total bases (16).

**YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:**

Through five games the RoughRiders are first in Double-A with 77 hits and second in all of Minor League Baseball below Triple-A. Among teams with at least seven games played, they are first in Double-A in batting average (.307) and T-12th in runs (39). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Holding them back, they are hitting just .222 (20-for-90) with just a .573 OPS with runners in scoring position. Their 77 hits are the most in the first seven games in recorded franchise history (since 2005), more than the previous record of 72 in 2025. **Keyber Rodriguez** has 12 hits through seven games, which is tied for the Texas League lead and is just two off the franchise record through seven games (**Josh Hatcher** in 2025 with 14). **Tucker Mitchell's** .407 batting average (11-for-27) is tied for the best in the Texas League and he is T-1st in doubles (4).

**QUITE THE START:**

Frisco's overall 2.43 ERA through seven games is the best in the Texas League, while they are T-3rd in batting average allowed (.210) and second in WHIP (1.11) in the league. Since 2005, their 2.43 ERA is the second-best in franchise history (2016 with a 2.22 ERA). Their bullpen ERA of 2.23 (31.1 IP/8 ER) is the 4th-best in MiLB and their bullpen WHIP (1.02) leads all of MiLB.

**CAUGHT YOU THIEVING:**

RoughRiders catcher **Julian Brock** had a sparkling day on Wednesday, going 2-for-4 at the plate with a double and an RBI while also catching three baserunners trying to steal. He added a home run on Thursday. Through seven games, he is second in Minor League Baseball with 6 caught stealings and is 6-for-8 in catching runners. That includes all Triple-A catchers who have played upwards of 13 games. In 17 games for the RoughRiders last season, Brock hit .321/.400/.446/.846 with 4 doubles, 1 home run and 10 RBIs.

**IMMACULATE:**

On Thursday, Riders reliever **Zach Bryant** threw an immaculate inning in the seventh, striking out three batters in just nine pitches. It was the first immaculate inning since **Danny Duffy** threw one in the final game of 2023 at Amarillo, which ended up being his final appearance with the RoughRiders. Bryant has now made three appearances for the Riders, allowing just one run over 3.1 innings (2.70 ERA) with 4 strikeouts to 1 walk.

**SOUTHERN SUCCESS:**

Since 2021, the Riders have been very good against their South Division opponents, going 255-187 (.577) against their division teams. The only problem is that they have gone just 57-55 against Midland while they went a combined 197-132 (.599) against Corpus Christi, Amarillo and San Antonio.

**FAMILIAR AND NEW FACES IN FRISCO:**

The RoughRiders welcome 16 returning players in 2026, but will have just three players on the roster (infielder **John Taylor**, outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** and RHP **Dylan MacLean**) made their Double-A debut in the season-opening series. Of the 28, 10 players made their Rangers organization debut with the RoughRiders in Corpus Christi.

### ABOUT DYLAN

- Drafted in 2020 out of Central Catholic High School in Portland, Oregon.
- Named 2019 Oregon Gatorade Player of the Year in junior year, leading all Oregon pitchers in wins (10), ERA (0.51), strikeouts (128) and WHIP (0.71). Led Rams to 6-A State Championship game against Jesuit (nicknamed the "Holy War") and faced now-Phillies pitcher Mick Abel. Jesuit won 2-1 in 13 innings.
- Was named as the No. 2 pitcher in Oregon's 2020 class behind Abel.
- At 13 years old, he pitched for Oregon in the opening round of the 2015 Little League World Series. In 1-0 loss to Texas, he threw 5.2 innings, striking out 12 batters.
- Before signing with the Rangers, MacLean was committed to the University of Washington.

- Opening the season as the Saturday starter for the RoughRiders

- Returned from injury to High-A Hub City, dominating at home (2.45 ERA as opposed to a 4.08 ERA on the road)

## CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

## THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

## JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.
