RIVER CATS RUN AWAY WITH IT

Round Rock earned a 5-2 win on Friday night over Sacramento. The River Cats jumped out to a 1-0 lead in the first inning. After a leadoff walk for DH Wade Meckler, a one-out double for RF Luis Matos gave the home team an early advantage. Round Rock answered in the third inning. After CF Aaron Zavala reached on an error, 3B Keyber Rodriguez singled. RF Abimelec Ortiz drilled a three-run homer and the Express held a 3-1 advantage. The E-Train added an insurance run in the ninth inning. 2B Alex De Goti led things off with a single. After a sacrifice bunt from CF Aaron Zavala, 3B Keyber Rodriguez singled and the Express held a 5-1 lead. Sacramento came back in the home half of the inning with a run. The River Cats loaded the bases and Matos delivered with a sacrifice fly. RHP José Ruiz shut the door though and the Express held on for a 5-2 win. RHP Josh Stephan earned the win with 3.2 scoreless innings out of the bullpen with five hits and one walk. LHP Seth Lonsway earned the loss following 4.0 innings with five hits, four runs and three earned and three strikeouts.

THE WOLF

RHP Jose Corniell is set for his third Triple-A start on Saturday. The 22-year-old collected his first Triple-A win with 5.1 innings of scoreless baseball with two hits, one walk and five strikeouts in Game 1 of last Saturday's doubleheader against Sugar Land. Corniell did not return to the mound until July after undergoing Tommy John ligament replacement surgery last year. He is one of just 12 pitchers 22 years and 90 days of age or younger to pitch in the PCL this year.

THE YOUNG PUPS

RHP Winston Santos made his Triple-A debut on Friday. He went 3.2 innings and allowed one earned run on three hits, two walks and four strikeouts. Santos needed 65 pitches and earned a no decision. RHP Josh Stephan collected his first Triple-A win after firing 3.2 scoreless innings with five hits and one walk.

NO STOPPING ABIMELEC

RF Abimelec Ortiz finished 1-for-4 with a home run, three RBI, a run scored, a walk and a strikeout last night. Ortiz is slashing .300 (18-60)/.403/.600/1.003 with five doubles, two triples, three home runs, 16 RBI, 15 runs scored, 10 walks and 11 strikeouts in 17 games this month. Ten of his 18 hits have been for extra bases.

HAUVER HEATER

OF Trevor Hauver is 7-for-13 with two doubles, a homer, eight RBI, five runs scored and four strikeouts in three games this week. Since August 1, he is slashing .287/.405/.493/.898 in 41 games.

FINISHING ON A HIGH NOTE

While the Express are eliminated from postseason contention, if they can win the next two games they can become just the 10th E-Train team to win 78 games or more in a season.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
