ZILCH, ZERO, NADA: RHPs Kodai Senga (2.2 IP) and Kade Morris (6.1) combined on a four-hit shutout, as the cyclones blanked the Renegades 4-0, on Wednesday....A night before, RHPs Jonah Tong (5.0 IP), Ben Simon (3.0), and Jake Stevenson (1.0) combined on a two-hitter in a 7 -0 triumph vs. Hudson Valley...cyclones pitching threw 20.1 consecutive scoreless on Monday and DH Omar Martinez's three-run blast in the first inning on On Monday and DH Omar Martinez's three-run blast in the first inning on from June 1-5 at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen...Brooklyn has thrown con secutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the Iron Birds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively... Each of Brooklyn's last three victories has come in shutout fashion...RHPs Dakota Hawkins (6.0IP) and Josh Hejka (3.0) united on a three-hit blanknow has 10 shutouts, the second most by a South Atlantic League pitching staff in 2024 trailing only Rome (13)...It is also tied for third most throughout Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones' single-season shutout record is 11 set during the 2023 campaign.
THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision last Wednesday night in Ab erdeen and threw 5.0 spotless innings to earn the win on Tuesday vs. Hudson 0.56 ERA ( 1 ER in 16.0 IP ), allowing only five hits and six walks ( $10.0 \mathrm{BB} \%$ ), while striking out 25 ( $41.67 \mathrm{~K} \%$ )...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit in strikeouts (63).... He is also tied for first in batting average against (194), second in ERA (3.02), fourth in WHIP (1.22), and 10th in innings pitched (47.2)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings (26.0\%), and 10th in strikeouts (99)

NICK SQUARED: OF Nick Morabito and IF Nick Lorusso have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...Lorusso is tied for seventh in the south Atlantic League in total bases (119), tied for eighth in
walks (39), 10th in OPS (.848), and tied for 10th in home runs (11)...Lorusso walks (39), 10th in OPS (.848), and tied for 10th in home runs (11)...Lorusso
is fourth among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in slugging (.478) is fourth among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in slugging (.478)

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn will play a home-andhome six-game series against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...Hudson Valley boasts four of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP Kyle Carr (11), INF Roc Riggio (18), INF Jared Serna (19), OF Jace Avina (28)...The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Hudson Valley in the first meeting on Coney Island (May 23-28), but the Renegades to 4-of-6 from Brooklyn in their last meeting in Wappingers Falls (June 11-16)...In 2023, the Cyclones went 6-6 against Hudson Valley on Coney Island and 8-4 at Heritage Financial Park...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 148-152 (.493).
TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with last Tuesday's game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones have just six home games over the next 28 days... Brooklyn's nex full six-game home series will take place from July $23-28$ vs. Rome...So fa Brooklyn is $3-7$ in the stretch...The Cyclones will play three games at home vs
Hudson Valley from July $1-3$ and another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19 21 immediately following the All-Star break....Brooklyn is also amid their longest stretch without an off day during the 2024 season...After Sunday's series finale, the Cyclones will play Monday, July 1, through Saturday, July 6, with three games on Coney Island and another three in Hudson Valley before back to-back days off on July 7 and 8 .

BROOKLYN-BOUND BÁEZ: INF Jesús Báez clobbered his first High-A first eight games at the High-A and has reached base safely in each of his organization according to Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB Pipeline...At 19 years old, Báez is the youngest player on Brooklyn's roster and is the first player in franchise history born in 2005 ...In 64 games at the Single-A level Báez accumulated a . 262 average (66-252) with 25 extra-base hits, 10 home runs, 39 RBI , and eight stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native departed the Florida State League with the most total bases (112) in the circuit...Báez
was also second in hits (66), tied for second in home runs (10), RBI (39), and extra-base hits (25) fourth in runs scored (40) sixth in slugging (444) and tied for sixth in doubles (16)...Among full-season Mets farmhands, the infielder is tied for first in doubles (17), tied for second in extra-base hits (29), third in hits (74) and total bases (126), fourth in RBI (43), tied for fourth in home runs (11), and fifth in slugging (.447).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF Omar De Los Santos rejoined Brooklyn's roster las Monday from Double-A Binghamton...In 13 games with the Rumble Ponies afte being transferred on May 20, the 24-year-old was 3 -for-22 (.336) at the plate pearing in only five games for the Cyclones since May 19 at Bowling Green, De Los Santos is still sixth in the South Atlantic League with 29 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT Jaylen Palmer's (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (66) earlier this season on May 2 Vs . Aberdeen...since the star of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is fifth across Minor League Baseball in

DOUBLE-DIGIT DOUGLAS: Orellana set a season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome....It was the second double-digit strikeout game of Orellana's career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out $10+$ hitters in a single game since RHP Robert Colina punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Orellana had his season-high 12.0-inning scoreless streak come to a close on May 5 vs. Aberdeen...During the stretch, he surrendered just three hits and fours walk, adding 13 strikeouts...The 22-year-old started the season by tossing a bevvy of zeroes too...The right-hander did not allow a run over his first two appearances and 8.1 innings...Orellana yielded only four hits and three walks in that span, while striking out eight.

DOUGIE HOWSER: The Caraças, Venezuela native was untouchable out of the bullpen on April 24 vs. Wilmington...The 22 -year-old retired all 15 batters he faced - striking out six - in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP Benito García (8/12/23 vABD), RHP Daison Acosta (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP Chris Schwinden (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit...Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all...However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch...LHP Nelson Pereira (5.0 IP) was the last to do it in a 2-1 win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.

2023: Orellana spent the entire 2023 season with current Brooklyn manager Gilbert Gómez and pitching coach Dan McKinney at Single-A St. Lucie...In his age 21 campaign, the right-hander made 23 appearances and 18 starts, tallying a 4-4 record and a 4.53 ERA (45 ER in 89.1 IP) with one save...Orellana issued 50 walks, but struck out 112 hitters...He finished fifth in the Florida State League in strikeouts and second on St. Lucie's roster behind LHP Felipe De La Cruz (114)...Orellana finished the season by being named the FSL's Pitcher of the Month for September...He permitted only two runs (one earned) on five hits in 10.2 innings, accruing two walks and 16 K 's.
