SAN ANTONIO BRINGS OUT BATS IN WIN OVER RIDERS:

Aaron Zavala and Evan Carter homered in the sixth inning and the Frisco RoughRiders pulled out a 10-3 win over the San Antonio Missions on Thursday at Riders Field. Already leading 6-3, Frisco extended the lead in the sixth with Zavala's solo homer to left. The two-out rally continued when Luisangel Acuña singled and stole second base to retake the league lead with his 37th steal, and then trotted home on Carter's two run blast. Frisco (9-9, 40-46) never trailed in the ballgame and retook the series lead at 2-1 over San Antonio (7-11, 44-43). Frisco struck first with five hits and five runs in the second inning. Liam Hicks singled for the first RBI and Acuña poked a grounder up the middle for two more runs. After adding a run in the third inning on Josh Hatcher's sacrifice fly, but San Antonio threatened the 6-0 lead in the fourth. The Missions scored three runs in the fourth and Grant Wolfram (6-0) entered with the bases loaded and one out. He struck out the first man he saw and ended the inning on a foul out. Wolfram completed 1.1 innings with one hit and no runs allowed, striking out three. Gabe Mosser (0-1) took the loss, allowed two earned runs and three unearned over the first 1.1 innings of the game. Ryan Garcia allowed three runs in his start for Frisco, all in the fourth inning. Through the first three innings he had allowed just one hit and picked off the one batter who recorded the hit. Aidan Anderson also recorded a pickoff soon after he entered in the sixth inning. Anderson went three scoreless innings. Matt Bush pitched a hitless ninth inning to close the night. The Riders capitalized on three San Antonio errors, including a three-base error to begin the third inning. Thomas Saggese ended up at third on a throwing error by the pitcher Jose Espada and then scored on Hatcher's sac fly. Saggese also scored in the seventh inning on a wild pitch after he singled and advanced to third on Hicks' double. Hicks went 2-for-3 on the night with a walk. Acuña, Carter and Saggese all had two hits, a stark turna Aaron Zavala and Evan Carter homered in the sixth inning and the Frisco RoughRiders pulled out a 10-3 win over the San Antonio

GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.14 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and last in the Texas League. They have used 16 different starting pitchers, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and just under the 19 they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not had a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 31 games since June 11th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.66 (93ER/109.1IP) while the bullpen has a 4.58 ERA (81ER/159.0IP). Over the 31 games, the Riders have the fourth-best offense in the league by OPS (.771) and have hit 31 home runs (7th in the Texas League).

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 16 games, he has driven in 19 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .324/.349/.486/.835 with two homers and 15 RBIs in 10 games.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 23 games since his return, he has nine multi-hit games, batting .348 (31-for-89)/.433/.629/1.062 with three doubles, two triples, six home runs, 18 RBIs and 19 runs scored.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 35 games, he is hitting .356/.437/.637/1.074 with nine home runs and 31 RBIs. The California native is currently fifth in the league in batting average (.310), third in RBIs (66), second in hits (104), fourth in doubles (20) and second in total bases (169).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League (min. 11 at-bats) with a .567 average (17-for-30) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.494 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. Luisangel Acuña has also been great, hitting .448 (26-for-58) on the initial offering while his 26 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 37 and is on pace for a career-best 58 swipes. Acuña is on pace to set a single-season record for the Riders, as **Elvis Andrus** has the record with 54 swipes in 2008. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 111 bases in 133 attempts (83 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE, AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season. They are one of four teams with at least seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ROUGH MATAIA: RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .328/.397/.410/.807 in July. He is seventh in the Texas League in batting average (.305), third in hits (102), third in doubles (21), second in runs (61) and first in steals (37).

ABOUT NICK								

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June $15 \mathrm{th}$.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1--0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
