FROM THE CROWS NEST

DOUBLE DIP: During their doubleheader on Thursday night, the Bradenton Marauders beat the Clearwater Threshers 9-1 in game one and fell 5-4 in game two at BayCare Ballpark. **Konnor Griffin** and **Wyatt Sanford** both finished the game with three hits each. **Axiel Plaz** also drove in three and launched his ninth homer of the year in the process. Bradenton starter **Victor Cabreja** earned his team-leading fifth win of the year (tied with **Greiber Mendez**) after tossing five innings of one-run ball. He has completed five innings in three consecutive starts. In game two, the Marauders fell 5-4, dropping their first game since last Sunday. Griffin notched another two hits and **Eddy Rodriguez** launched his third homer of the season

RAIN MAKING WIN: After a one hour and 15 minute weather delay, The Maruaders earned a gutsy 8-5 win over the Threshers on Tuesday night to take game one of the series. Bradenton took the lead on the first on a **Wyatt Sanford** two-run homer. After Clearwater tied it up in the bottom of the third, Bradenton pushed across one in the sixth and three in the eighth en route to the seires-opening win.

STUMBO TOES THE RUBBER: Right hander **Peyton Stumbo** toes the rubber for his tenth outing and ninth start of the season. Last Saturday, he tossed 4.0 innings of one-run ball vs Lakeland. His fastball sat at 91-92 and topped out at 94.0 miles per hour. In the month of May, Stumbo made six starts and tossed 24.1 innings while pitching to a 3.70 ERA. Before walking two hitters in his last start, Stumbo has not allowed a free pass in his five previous starts. Tonight marks his third start versus Clearwater in his last four outings. In his previous two meetings with the Threshers, he has combined for seven innings while allowing four earned runs on eight hits.

WELCOME WYATT: On Tuesday, the Pirates promoted 2024 Second Round Pick **Wyatt Sanford** to Single-A Bradenton. In his first at bat, he launched a solo homer to right in his first Single-A at bat. He finished the night 1-4 with 3 RBI. At 19 years old, 2025 marks his first professional season. In 20 games in the FCL, Sanford went 14-for-54 (.259) with one home run and six runs batted in. He also walked as many times as he struck out (15) and went 13-for-14 in stolen base tries. The middle infielder is highly touted for his defensive prowess. He becomes the second highest ranked Marauder in the Pirates system behind only **Konnor Griffin**. Sanford was drafted out of Independence High School in Frisco, Texas.

FOUR-GAME SPRINT: Last weekend, the Marauders dropped three of four from the Lakeland Flying Tigers at LECOM Park. After falling 9-3 in Friday night's series opener, the Maruaders and Flying Tigers played three games in a stretch of 24 hours due to a Saturday doubleheader. On Sunday, Bradenton fell 5-1 in an extra-inning battle. After limiting Lakeland to just one unearned run through nine innings, Lakeland broke the game open with a four-run top of the tenth. Bradenton is now 1-2 in extra innings.

KG SAYS HELLO: 2024 first-round pick Konnor Griffin has led off in 47 of his 48 games started in 2025. In the first inning this year, he is slashing .311/.340/.511 with two home runs and five extra-base hits. Over the last two weeks, he has homered on the first pitch of the game's first frame twice, including last two weeks ago versus No. 71 overall prospect Trey Yesavage. Moreover, while jumping on the first pitch in general this year, he is 14-for-28 (.500), with five of those hits coming in the first inning.
