JUMBO SHRIMP FALL TO MUD HENS 9-2

Despite a two-run home run from **Troy Johnston**, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Toledo Mud Hens 9-2 Tuesday night. The Mud Hens took a quick lead in the bottom of the first plating four runs thanks to three walks and two doubles in the frame. Toldeo added three more runs in the bottom of the second and one in the bottom of the fourth for an 8-0 lead. The Jumbo Shrimp broke through against Mud Hens southpaw **Lael Lockhart** (W, 2-5) in the top of the fifth. With two outs, **Connor Norby** singled and Johnston (8) blasted a two-run homer, cutting the deficit to six. Toledo's added their final run in the bottom of the sixth.

ROCKET MAN

At just 21 years old, **Deyvison De Los Santos** has had a monstrous 2024 season between Jacksonville, Triple-A Reno and Double-A Amarillo. Currently, De Los Santos leads all of full season Mil.B in home runs (31), RBIs (90), slugging (.636) and OPS (1.017). He ranks second in total bases (236), fifth in hits (120) and tied for third in extra-base hits (52). Of the top 100 exit velos in the minors in 2024, the Dominican has hit four of them, trailing **Jhonkensy Noel** (6x), **Orelvis Martinez** (6x) and **Pedro León** (5x).

IT'S TEARIN' UP MY START WHEN I'M WITH YOU

In 2005, Jacksonville starting pitchers ranked just 25th in Double-A with 741.0 innings, which represented 60.6 percent of the club's 1223.2 innings. This season, the Jumbo Shrimp's starting rotation has worked 51.2 percent of the club's innings, a total of 477.0 out of 931.2 frames. That figure is the eighth-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville lid-lifters are ranked third in ERA (4.62; next-closest is Gwinnett at 4.72) while ranking fifth in WHIP (1.40), ninth in BAA (.259), 10th in OPS against (.783) and ninth in walks (192).

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 24-32 (.429) record. Jacksonville has scored only 236 runs at home (4.2 per game), second-fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring more than a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 241 (4.7 per game). Meanwhile, on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 223 runs (4.4 per game), the second-fewest in Triple-A. They yielded the 12th-fewest runs of any team at home (4.9 per game).

GET PITCH OR DIE TRYIN'

Jacksonville has gone 26-21 (.553) in their last 47 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 29 of those 47 affairs (61.7 percent). Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in fewest runs allowed (193) and ERA (3.91) while ranking second in WHIP (1.37), fourth in BAA (.248), sixth in OPS against (.743) and fourth in hits allowed (378), respectively.

SOULJA TROY

Heading into play on May 25, **Troy Johnston**, the reigning Marlins Minor League Player of the Year, was hitting just .240/.294/.316/.610 with only 12 doubles, one home run, 21 RBIs, nine walks and 16 runs scored in 48 games. However, over the last 58 contests, the Puyallup, Wash., native is a sizzling 69-for-217, slashing .318/.385/.507/.892 with 14 doubles, three triples, seven homers, 30 RBIs, 21 walks and 39 runs scored. Johnston has 18 multi-hit games in his last 39 contests and is the season's IL leader in hits (116) while also ranking third in doubles (26) and 22nd in batting average (.281).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 63 of his last 74 games, notching 26 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 92-for-289 (.318/.387/.481/.868) with 21 doubles, four triples, six home runs, 42 RBIs, 34 walks and 38 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja ranks sixth in batting average (.299), tied for seventh in doubles (23) and tied for 10th in hits (98).

SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 11 of the last 14 games after doing so just three times in the previous 10 contests... Will Banfield is batting .342/.384/.605/.989 with four doubles, five home runs, 15 RBIs, six walks and 17 runs scored in his last 22 games... Jacksonville has dropped six of their last eight games. This stretch comes on the heels of seven victories in eight contests.

ABOUT YONNY

-A native of Bachaquero, Venezuela, Chirinos signed with the Tampa Bay Rays for \$10,000 as an international free agent from Venezuela in June 2012.

-On March 25, 2018, the Rays announced that Chirinos had made the Opening Day roster. Chirinos made his opening debut in a long relief role against the Boston Red Sox on April 1. He worked four scoreless innings while allowing just one hit. Chirinos set a franchise record by pitching his first 14 2/3 innings without allowing an earned run.

-Chirinos pitched for Tampa Bay on August 16, 2020 against the Blue Jays. His start that night followed a stint on the injured list due to right triceps inflammation. A week later, he underwent Tommy John surgery. Chirinos' rehab and recovery process was stalled in September 2021 when he fractured his elbow while throwing batting practice. The injury required surgery and, as it turned out, set him back another year. He wound up going 752 days between appearances for the Rays, finally returning to the mound on September 8, 2022. Chirinos allowed four hits, one walk and struck out four while blanking the Red Sox during a three-inning stint. When he took the mound in the fourth in relief of Jeffrey Springs, the game was scoreless. When he exited after the sixth, the Rays had a 1-0 lead. That is how the game finished and Chirinos had his first win since August 4, 2019.

-After more than a decade in the Rays' organization, Chirinos was claimed off waivers on July 23, 2023 by the Atlanta Braves. Atlanta non-tendered Chirinos in November and he signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins in February.

2024 SEASON

-Had his contract selected by Miami on June 19 and made six starts before getting designated for assignment on July 23 and outrighted to Jacksonville on July 25.

2023 SEASON

-With both Tampa Bay and Atlanta, when pitching with the bases empty, opponents posted an .832 OPS in 224 appearances. In 138 plate appearances with runners on base, that figure dropped to .794. Additionally, in 87 plate appearances with runners in scoring position, opponents compiled a .742 OPS.

-According to Baseball Savant, Chirinos was in the 87th percentile in offspeed run value (+4) while also ranking in the 71st percentile in ground ball percentage (46.3 percent).
