FROM THE CROWS NEST

ROSTER MOVES: On Saturday, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced that **C Jason Delay** is scheduled to begin his Major League rehab assignment with the Bradenton Marauders. Delay played in just one game for the Pirates this year before being placed on the 10-day IL with right knee inflammation on April 3. The former 4th round pick by the Buccos back in 2017 out of Vanderbilt played for the Marauders back in 2018 where he played in 67 games. Delay made his Major League debut back in 2022 and has appeared in 128 games across three seasons for Pittsburgh. He becomes the third Major League rehabber Bradenton has had this season, joining RHP Carmen Mlodzinski and OF Ji Hwan Bae.

HANGING TOUGH: Over the past two nights, the Marauders bullpen has combined to allow just two hits and four walks while striking out 10 in 8.0 scoreless frames against Dunedin. In the series, Bradenton's bullpen owns a 1.50 ERA after allowing just three earned runs in 18.0 innings. The 1.50 ERA is the third-best in Minor League Baseball during this period. The Fresno Grizzlies (Single-A, COL) lead the way with a 0.00 ERA in 12.1 innings and the Jupiter Hammerheads sit just in front with a 0.55 ERA in 16.1 innings.

HE JUST GETS ON BASE: With a pair of hits, **C Omar Alfonzo** extended his on-base streak to 11 games. During his streak, the Pirates' No. 28 prospect is slashing .333/.510/.417 with three doubles, five RBIs, 12 walks, two intentional walks, and six runs scored. Since the streak began on May 11, only Brock Vradenburg (17), Jupiter Hammerheads, has more walks at the Single-A level.

FLYING AROUND: On Wednesday night, the Marauders stole a season-high five bases against the Dunedin Blue Jays. So far in the first four games of this week's series, Bradenton is a perfect 11-for-11 in stolen base attempts, the sixth-most in MiLB during this span. The Lynchburg Hillcats (Single-A, CLE) have swiped 15 in 17 attempts this week.

CHECKMATE: Over the last five games, OF Braylon Bishop has been a tough out at the plate. The Marauders outfielder is 8-for-19 with two doubles, a triple, one HR, six RBIs, and five runs scored. Bishop played in just four games before being placed on the injured list on April 12. He was activated last Monday and played in two games during last week's series. The home run on Tuesday was Bishop's first since 8/21/23 against the FCL Rays.

WINNER, LEAGUE LEADER: LHP Yoldin De La Paz earned his fifth win of the season on Thursday night to improve to 5-0 on the year with the five wins being the most in the Florida State League. The southpaw is off to a great start in 2024, having allowed just three earned runs in 22.2 innings this year, good for a 1.19 ERA in 12 appearances. He's also currently riding a season-long 8.1 scoreless innings streak.

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders clubbed two more home runs on Friday night against Dunedin to bring their team total up to a 17 home runs in 21 games durign the month of May, the second-most in the FSL with the Dunedin Blue Jays in front with 18. It's also the fourth-most HR in Single-A with the Fredericksburg Nationals (WAS) hitting 20 longballs in 21 games this month.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Friday's victory marked the Marauders 18th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 10-8 record in those games with 31 of their first 43 (72.1%) games having been decided by three runs or less.

GOT EM!:Carlson Reed picked off Victor Arias in the second inning on Thursday night for the Marauders 13th pickoff of the season. As of Saturday, the Marauders are currently tied for second in Milb, with the Quad Cities River Bandits (High-A, KC) leading the way with 16. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in Milb.
