THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this date in 1999, Chad Hermansen hit his 55th career home run, setting a new franchise record. He would finish his Sounds career with 92 homers.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Columbus Clippers play game three of a six-game series tonight. The two teams have split the first two games of the set. Right-hander Thomas Jankins starts for Nashville against Heath Fillmyer for Columbus.

Thomas Jankins: 26-year-old Thomas Jankins makes his 15th appearance (13th start) for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander is 1-5 with a 6.63 ERA in 58.1 innings. He has allowed 68 hits and 22 walks to go along with 43 strikeouts. Jankins last pitched on July 23 in Jacksonville and turned in a quality start (6 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 5 K). In 2019, Jankins went 11-5 with a 4.19 ERA in 25 games (23 starts) with Triple-A San Antonio and Double-A Biloxi. He finished tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League for wins (10), logged 10 quality starts and four starts of 6+ IP and one or less runs allowed. The Brewers drafted Jankins in the 13th round of the 2016 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Heath Fillmyer: 27-year-old Heath Fillmyer starts for the Clippers in game three of the series tonight. The right-hander is 1-3 with a 6.81 ERA in 10 games (7 starts) with Columbus. He has covered 35.2 innings and has allowed 39 hits and 13 walks to go along with 30 strikeouts. Fillmyer last pitched on July 23 in a home start against Iowa and allowed 6 runs on 8 hits in 4.2 innings. He walked a season-high 4 batters and struck out a pair. Cleveland signed Fillmyer to a minor league contract on May 30. He was drafted by the Oakland Athletics in the 5th round of the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 44, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Jankins' Turnaround: The 2021 season has been a tale of two halves for tonight's starter Thomas Jankins. From Opening Day through his start against Gwinnett on June 16, Jankins was 0-3 with a 10.33 ERA (31 ER/27.0 IP). In those 8 games (6 starts), Jankins allowed 38 hits and 13 walks to go along with 18 strikeouts while opponents hit .333 against him. Since then, Jankins has made 6 starts and is 1-2 with a 3.45 ERA (12 ER/31.1 IP). He has allowed 30 hits and only 9 walks to go with 25 strikeouts. Opponents during that span are hitting .263.

Welcome Vogelbach: Another Major League rehabber is set to join the Sounds tonight. Daniel Vogelbach will play first base and bat second tonight. Vogelbach has been on Milwaukee's 10-day injured list since June 23 when he suffered a strained left hamstring. In 67 games with the Brew Crew, he was hitting .216 (37-for-171) with 23 runs, 8 doubles, 7 home runs, 16 RBI, 27 walks and 42 strikeouts. Vogelbach joins infielder Travis Shaw and right-handed pitcher Dylan File who are also on rehab assignment with the Sounds.

So Long, Cooper: Yesterday the Brewers traded Nashville outfielder/catcher Cooper Hummel to the Arizona Diamondbacks. In 54 games with Nashville, Hummel hit .254 (32-for-126) with 27 runs, 8 doubles, 3 triples, 6 home runs, 15 RBI, 41 walks and 26 strikeouts. Hummel's 41 walks are tied for second-most in the Triple-A East. He will report to Triple-A Reno.

Let's Play the AL: After last night's win, the Sounds are now 17-8 against American League affiliates compared to 25-23 against National League affiliates. Coincidentally, the designated hitter spot in the Nashville lineup has hit just .244 (22-for-90) this year.

Barker Saves It: Luke Barker notched his team-leading fifth save of the season Tuesday night with a five-out save. Barker passed Hoby Milner (4) for the outright team lead. Barker also leads Nashville in games finished with 18. Prior to Tuesday, Nashville's last save happened back on July 9 when Barker closed a 3-1 victory in Gwinnett.

Henry's Heating Up: After hitting just .105 (2-for-19) in his first six games with Nashville, catcher Payton Henry has hit .353 (13-for-38) in his last 12 games. In those 12 games he has 2 runs, 3 doubles, 3 RBI and 2 walks.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,073-1,953. The 2,073 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.
