Comeback wins 20 Walk-off W/L 0-9

vs. EL Northeast 29-40 vs. EL Southwest 14-8 YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats conceded a six-run lead and gave up six home runs in a 13-8 loss to the Hartford Yard Goats on Friday night at Delta Dental Stadium. New Hampshire held an 8-2 lead through five innings after exploding for six runs in the fourth. Hartford rallied for 11 unanswered runs with the long ball doing much of the damage. Kyle Datres hit a two-run shot in the sixth to pull the Yard Goats within three. Drew Romo launched his second home run of the game, a two-run homer in the eighth to make it a one-run game before Bedford native Grant Lavigne put the Yard Goats ahead with a two-run home run off right-hander T.J Brock. Hunter Goodman followed with a solo homer into the Hilton Garden Inn to go back-to-back with Lavigne, his 24th of the year and a new Yard Goats single-season record.

POP OFF PALMEGIANI: IF **Damiano Palmegiani** has recorded three straight multi-hit games and paces the team with 22 multi-hit games on the year. In the three games he has played in the series, he has seven RBIs to up his season total to 50 on the year, tied for sixth in the Eastern League. The Blue Jays No. 29 prospect is the team's active leader in home runs (12) and RBIs and has reached base in 67 of 81 games played.

CAPTAIN CLARKE: C **Phil Clarke** launched a pair of solo homers on Friday night, both against Hartford left-hander Joe Rock. It was Clarke's first two-homer game of his career and it was his first homers of the season at Delta Dental Stadium. He has multi-hit games in five of his last seven games. The 25-year-old catcher is hitting .379 over his last 10 games, with three doubles, two homers and five RBIs.

ROCKIN' AND RODEN: OF **Alan Roden** has made a strong first impression since arriving in New Hampshire last Monday. The Blue Jays 2022 third round pick has nine hits, a triple, eight RBIs and has walked more than struck out (9 BB/4 K) in his first nine Double-A games. The 23-year-old came to New Hampshire after leading the Northwest League with a .321 average and a .437 on-base percentage.

STEWARD THE SWIPER: With another stolen base on Wednesday, OF **Steward Berroa** is tied for the Eastern League lead in stolen bases with 37 on the season with Portland's Corey Rosier. Berroa currently owns the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League at 21 games, six games ahead of the next two longest active on-base streaks in Akron's Juan Brito and Jose Tena.

HITTING VS HARTFORD: INF Miguel Hiraldo leads the team in batting against the Yard Goats this season, hitting .351 (13-for-37) with a homer, two doubles and two RBIs. OF Will Robertson is hitting .347 with two homers, five doubles and eight RBIs, IF Damiano Palmegiani is hitting .320 with 4 homers and 12 RBIs and IF Trevor Schwecke is hitting .319.

JIMMY ON THE JOB: LHP **Jimmy Robbins** makes his 18th start of the year and his third against Hartford. The 25-year-old pitched one of his best games of his career last time out against Hartford on July 7 as he took a no-hitter into the seventh and struck out seven in a career-long 7.1 shutout innings of two-hit ball. Robbins' last home start was June 30 vs Portland. He struck out five in four innings while allowing three unearned runs.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (July 29, 2018) - The Fisher Cats made it five straight wins, completing a four-game sweep at Hartford with an 8-1 win. Eduard Pinto had a double and a homer, driving in four. Harold Ramirez also went deep at Dunkin' Park. T. J. Zeuch went six scoreless innings for his seventh win. He allowed five hits and struck out five.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: In Toronto (58-46), Shohei Ohtani hit his 39th homer, but that would be all the Jays would allow in a 4-1 win. Matt Chapman and Danny Jansen went deep. It was Jansen's 14th homer of the season...Buffalo (49-50) scored in each of the first four innings en route to a 12-2 win over Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Davis Schneider went 3-for-3 with two doubles, two RBI, and two runs scored. Tyler Heineman homered for the Bisons. Buffalo is in first place in the International League's East in the second half...Vancouver (58-35) dropped a 3-2 decision at home to Everett Friday afternoon. Cade Doughty's two-run homer in the first gave the Canadians an early lead, but Everett took the lead in the sixth with a two-run homer...Dunedin (42-51) was postponed at Tampa and the game is scheduled to be made-up today as part of a 4pm doubleheader.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue their home stand against the Hartford Yard Goats until Sunday. Promotions for the weekend include 90s Night Saturday presented by N-H Healthy Families with postgame Hyundai fireworks, and a Fisher Cats flag giveaway Sunday, courtesy of Delta Dental, with Kids Run the Bases Postgame, sponsored by the N-H Liquor Commission Division of Enforcement.

LAST TIME OUT: Started last Sunday's no-hit loss in Portland. Allowed two runs in five innings. Left in a 0-0 tie in sixth, but took loss when two runners who reached before he left scored. Struck out six.

v. HARTFORD– Had his best start of the season against the Yard Goats on July 7 when he went 7.1 scoreless innings in a 4-0 win. Took the loss here in Manchester against the Goats on April 27. Made his first Double-A start at Dunkin' Park last August 21.

2023: Opened season with his third consecutive outing at Double-A without allowing a run. Earned the win 4/8 at Altoona. Picked up second win on June 3 in a 2-1 win over Reading at Delta Dental Stadium. Beat Akron 2-0 on June 16 when he worked the first five, striking out a Double-A high eight batters. Pitched a career 7.1 scoreless innings in a 4-0 win at Hartford on July 7. Took the loss 7/23 at Portland in game NH was no-hit. Worked into the sixth before allowing two runs.

2022: Made his AA debut at HFD 8/21- made 5 starts in all with the Fisher Cats and did not allow a run in three of them. At the time of his promotion to NH on August 15, Robbins had an 0-2 record and 3.08 on the season across two levels. Had 72 Ks in 52.2 innings. Started the season with Single-A Dunedin, where he had a 1.56 ERA in six outings (one start). Struck out 26 batters in 17.1 innings with the D-Jays. Promoted to High-A Vancouver on June 7. Was primarily a start with the C's (10 outings, 9 starts). Had a 3.82 ERA and 0-2 record with Vancouver, throwing a career-high 11 strikeouts vs. Everett on July 31.

2021: Missed the entire season due to Tommy John surgery

2019: Threw in seven outings with three starts between Bluefield Blue Jays and GCL Blue Jays. Had a 2.84 ERA with 24 Ks in 19.0 innings across both levels. Totaled season-best seven strikeouts in 3.0 innings on August 7 against the Greeneville Reds.

Obtained: Drafted in the 20th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Rollins College in Rollins, Florida.
