JACKSONVILLE WINS FIFTH STRAIGHT

Jerar Encarnacion reached base four times, homered, threw out a runner at the plate and scored two runs Thursday as the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp recorded their fifth straight win with a 7-2 triumph at the Charlotte Knights from Truist Field. With Charlotte (5-7) ahead 1-0, Encarnacion singled and Peyton Burdick walked against Knights starter **Daniel Ponce de Leon** (0-1) to start the second. A bunt pushed the runners into scoring position before **Jacob Amaya** laced a double off the right field wall to plate two and give Jacksonville (7-4) a 2-1 advantage. Jacksonville blew the game open in the sixth on Jerar's three-run homerun. Their final tally came in the top of the ninth when Amaya scored on a **Charles Leblanc** triple.

FIRST THINGS FIRST

Jacksonville's streak of 10 leadoff men reaching base to start off the game ended last night. Of those 10 leadoff baserunners, five have come on swings on the first pitch. Seven of those 10 leadoff baserunners have also come via hits; Brian Miller reached on an error to start the Jumbo Shrimp's contest on April 2 at the Stripers, Edwards walked to start the bottom of the first on Sunday against Durham and Edwards drew a free pass to start Thursday's affair at Charlotte.

LEADERS, NOT FOLLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp weren't able to get a first inning tally last night which ended their streak of five consecutive games with a first inning run. In their last 11 games, the Jumbo Shrimp have struck for at least one tally in their first at-bats nine times. Jacksonville has scored first in seven of its 11 games thus far in 2023, going 6-1 when doing so. The Jumbo Shrimp scored the game's first run 83 times in 2022 (55.7 percent) and had a 62-21 (.747) record when doing so.

CHARLOTTE'S WEB

Since the club's first season back in Triple-A, Jacksonville owns a 31-23 record against the Knights. The two teams played each other to a razor thin margin last year (16-14). Against Charlotte, the Jumbo Shrimp hitters slashed .288/.367/.470 with an .837 OPS (2nd-highest) among 2022 division opponents. The pitching staff owned 4.51 ERA (3rd-lowest) among 2022 division opponents.

THE ENDS JUSTIFY THE MEANS

Only four teams in the IL (Iowa, Omaha, Toledo and Columbus) have scored more runs than Jacksonville through the season's first ten games. Despite the club's 74 runs scored, the Jumbo Shrimp are ranked 7th in average (.258), 13th in on-base percentage (.336), T-9th in slugging percentage (.430) and 10th in OPS (.776). With runners in scoring position, though, Jacksonville's slash line jumps up to .262/.340/.454/.803, figures that rank ninth, 11th, sixth and eighth, respectively.

ON THE OTHER SIDE THOUGH...

While the Jumbo Shrimp are tied for fifth in the league in runs scored, they also have ceded the third-most runs in the IL. Jacksonville has yielded 71 runs, an average of 6.5 per game. Charlotte, is tied for 15th in the 20-team league entering play on Friday. They have surrendered 67 tallies (5.6 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have issued the ninth-most walks (50) in the circuit, while ranking seventh in batting average against (.260) and 16th in hits allowed (102). The club has surrendered at least five runs in all but four game so far.

GO C.J., GO C.J., GO C.J., GO

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than C.J. Hinojosa. Through seven games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 12-for-34, slashing a robust .375/.382/.688/1.070 with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, 10 RBIs and five runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for 14th in the International League in RBIs, seventh in batting average, 14th in slugging and 14th in OPS. He has scored at least one run in every game he's played so far this year, including hits in six of his seven contests.

SHRIMP BITES

Jordan Groshans has at least one hit in eight of Jacksonville's first 11 games so far this season, going 11-for-46 (.239/.314/.304/.618) at the plate with two doubles, five RBIs and six runs scored...Groshans increased his on-base streak to 11 straight with a walk last night... Peyton Burdick has two multi-homer games this season...His 116 MPH home run on 4/12 was the second hardest hit ball in MiLB this season.

ABOUT BRYAN

-In high school, Bryan was selected as a 2014 Under Armour All-American and was rated the 131st-best prospect in the nation by Perfect Game in 2015.

-He was ranked as the fourth-best player in the state of Indiana and the third-best right-handed pitcher as a senior in high school.

-Hoeing was named to All-Tournament Teams at 2014 Perfect Game WWBA 17U National Championship and 2013 Perfect Game WWBA 16u National Championship.

2023 SEASON

-Made first appearance of the season, coming out of the bullpen against Gwinnett. He tossed three innings, allowing just one run on five hits with four punch outs.

2022 SEASON

-Made MLB debut on 8/20/22 against the Los Angeles Dodgers.

-Hoeing was transferred to Jacksonville on May 3 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, Hoeing was leading the Southern League in both ERA (0.35) and innings pitched (25.2) while ranking second in both batting average against (.211) and WHIP (0.94), tied for fourth in wins (2) and sixth in strikeouts (26).

2021 SEASON

-There, Hoeing made 22 appearances (22 GS) going 7-6 with a 4.83 ERA in 121.0 innings, he allowed 65 ER and held opponents to a .267 batting average.

-After posting a 7.91 ERA in May (19.1 IP), 6.12 ERA in June (32.1 IP) and 6.29 ERA in July (24.1 IP), Hoeing closed the season strong. In August, he went 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in four starts (27.0 IP, 16 H, 7 BB, 23 K). In three September starts, the right-hander worked to a 2-0 record and 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 19 H, BB, 11 K).

2019 SEASON

-After being drafted in the seventh round of the MLB draft in 2019, Hoeing was sent to the NYPL with the Batavia Muckdogs.

-In nine relief appearances, he tossed 22.1 innings and struck out 17 in his professional debut season.

-He tallied his first professional strikeout on 7/18 vs. the Auburn Doubledays.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Originally drafted out of high school by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 32nd round (2015) but elected not to sign.

-Signed with Louisville but also strongly considered North Carolina, Vanderbilt, Indiana and Georgia Tech.

-His mom, Donna, is the person whom had the greatest influence on his athletic career. She played basketball at Ball State. Meanwhile, Bryan's cousin, Alex Meyer, plays in the Minnesota Twins' organization.
