Last Night: Lugnuts 4, Dragons 3. With two outs in the eighth, **Jared Dickey** drilled a two-run go-ahead homer, lifting the Nuts to victory in front of a roaring crowd of 6,614.

On Deck: After three games at Fort Wayne, the Lugnuts' next home game arrives on Independence Day, July 4th, with a LAFUCU Fireworks Spectacular!

Big Nate: Nate Nankil has been spectacular the month and yesterday was no exception, going 1-for-3 with a walk to extend his hitting streak to 13 games (24-for-51, .471) and his on-base streak to 19 games (30-for-74, 6 BB, 3 HBP, .405 avg., .470 OBP, .568 slugging). Nankil is 2nd in the Midwest League in batting average (.319), 3rd in base hits (79) and 3rd in doubles (18).

Anything's Possible for KG: Joshua Kuroda-Grauer has hit safely in his last eight games (16-for-37, .432), with a .529 average (9-17) in this series. Kuroda-Grauer is hitting .386 (17-44) in the season series against Dayton, the Nuts' far and away best hitter vs. Dragons pitching.

Sunday Funday: The Nuts have been at their best on Sundays this season, posting an 8-3 record behind the hitting of **Ryan Lasko** (10-for-22, 10 R, 2 2B, 1 3B, .455 avg. in five games) and **Jared Dickey** (13-for-35, 10 R, 3 2B, 1 HR, 10 BB, .371 avg. in 10 games).

Dragon Slayer: Last night's hero, **Jared Dickey**, has homered twice in the last three days and has hit all three of his home runs this season against Dayton. Last year, Dickey batted .450 (9-for-20) against the Dragons in five games with the Nuts – after batting just .176 (3-for-17) in five games for Quad Cities vs. Dayton.

Prospecting: The Lugnuts have eight of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 6 **Tommy White**, No. 9 **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, No. 11 **Steven Echavarria**, No. 15 **Ryan Lasko**, No. 16 **Rodney Green, Jr.**, No. 26 **Nate Nankil**, No. 29 **Tzu-Chen Sha** and No. 30 **Wei-En Lin**.

Midsummer Classic: Major League Baseball All-Star Game voting has advanced to phase 2, with three former Lugnuts (Toronto first baseman **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, A's shortstop **Jacob Wilson** and Toronto catcher **Alejandro Kirk**) each making the final two at his position. A run-off vote will determine the starter between Guerrero and the Yankees' Paul Goldschmidt, Wilson and the Royals' Bobby Witt, Jr., and Kirk and the Mariners' Cal Raleigh. A little more on Wilson, who played 23 games for the Lugnuts in 2023: he ranks 2nd in the Majors to Aaron Judge in both batting average (.340) and base hits (106) and is on pace to become the first ever rookie to start the All-Star Game at shortstop for the American League. The last Athletics starting shortstop in the All-Star Game was Bert Campaneris in 1974.

Mark it Down: With a scoreless ninth inning last night, **Mark Adamiak** took the Minor League lead with his 13th save of the season. Adamiak entered this season after recording two saves last season for Stockton – and having never recorded a save before that, neither in college nor summer ball nor high school. Adamiak's 25 appearances this season tie for the Midwest League lead.

O Canada: T.J. Schofield-Sam leads the Midwest League in batting average (.335), HBPs (23) and base hits (85), ranks 2nd in OPS (.908) and total bases (125), 3rd in OBP (.416), 4th in slugging (.492) and tied for 5th in runs scored (48).

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in fewest strikeouts (504), 2nd in batting average (.260), 2nd in base hits (644), 2nd in doubles (143), 4th in on-base percentage (.352), 4th in total bases (949) and 4th in OPS (.735).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is 1st in the league in holds (30), tied for 1st in complete games (2), 1st in fewest HBPs (26), 1st in fewest balks (4), 2nd in fewest walks (275) and tied for 2nd in saves (20).

In the Field: The Nuts have turned 75 double plays this season, two in the final three innings last night, good for 3rd in the Midwest League.

JUNE 29TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2007: The Lugnuts faced the Great Lakes Loons' Clayton Kershaw for the second and final time, torching him for six runs (five earned) on six hits and two walks in 4 1/3 innings and handing him the defeat in a 15-7 Lugnuts win at Dow Diamond. The Nuts scored three runs in the 2nd and three more in the 5th vs. Kershaw, who did strike out seven, before blowing the game open with four-run rallies in the 8th and 9th. The Loons scored six runs in the bottom of the 9th to make the game a bit closer.

2019: On Backyard Baseball Night II, the Lansing Mighty Wombats built a 3-0 lead against Bowling Green ace Shane Baz behind a Griffin Conine two-run homer in the first inning and a DJ Neal RBI single in the second inning, and Troy Miller pitched 6 1/3 innings – only to see Juan Núñez allow a game-tying two-run homer in the seventh and a Jonathan Aranda RBI single in the eighth in a 4-3 loss.

Last Time Out: Started the first game of this series, June 24... gave up seven runs in three innings-plus, allowing two-run homer to Carter Graham in a four-run 3rd inning, departing after allowing an HBP and walk in 4th inning (both runners scored against Jake Christianson)... the Lugnuts fell behind 8-1 and lost 13-8... 76 pitches, 51 strikes.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

19-year-old Steven Echavarria is part of an exclusive club: players who suited up for the Lugnuts as teenagers. Future Major Leaguers include 19-year-old Max Muncy, who joined the Nuts for the final 42 games of 2022; 19-year-old Gabriel Moreno, who homered in his first Lugnuts at-bat in 2019; Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. and Bo Bichette, who were 18 and 19 respectively when they dominated the 2017 Midwest League and appeared in the Futures Game; 18-year-old Carlos Beltrán, who was in the Lugnuts' very first Opening Day lineup on April 5, 1996; and the 1999 Lugnuts teenage duo of 19-year-old Corey Patterson, who was named the Midwest League Prospect of the Year, and 18-year-old Carlos Zambrano, who won 13 games and worked 153 1/3 innings. As of today, however, Echavarria is the second-youngest player on the team, eclipsed by new arrival Wei-En Lin, who will turn 20 on November 4th.

Path to Lansing: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six may starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... vs. right-handers: .306/.386/.387, 1 HR, 5 GiDP... vs. left-handers: .316/.431/.474, 3 HR, 1 GiDP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
