## YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Baysox pitched their first shutout of the season and scored two runs in the eighth to break a scoreless tie and win the game 2-0. Zach Fruit, Peter Van Loon and Dylan Heid combined for a three-hit shutout. Carter Young delivered a go-ahead RBI double and **Anthony Servideo** delivered an RBI single for the only runs of the game. The victory completed a season-opening series win for a third straight year.

#### A LOOK BACK AT LAST YEAR

The 2024 Baysox finished the season with an overall record of 62-75 and fell short of the postseason for a third straight year. Despite this, Baysox pitching was one of the best in the Eastern League and in Double-A. Chesapeake set a single-season franchise record with 1,319 strikeouts, which was 2nd-most in the Eastern League and in Double-A. They also had the 4th-best ERA in the Eastern League (3.79). Samuel Basallo was named the Eastern League's Top MLB Prospect, becoming the second Baysox player in franchise history to be named and the first since Adley Rutschman. Two 2024 Baysox also made their MLB debuts in Billy Cook (Pirates) and Seth Johnson (Phillies).

## **MEET THE SQUAD**

Chesapeake's 2025 Opening Day roster features 19 returners from last year and nine newcomers. Of the returners, five are top 30 Orioles prospects with three in the top 15, according to MLB Pipeline. OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (No. 3), RHP Patrick Reilly (No. 10), C Creed Willems (No. 12), RHP Trace Bright (No. 25) and RHP Alex Pham (No. 29) all return to Bowie while notable newcomers include top-20 O's prospect RHP Juan Nunez (No. 20), RHP Zach Fruit, former Royal RHP Dylan Coleman and non-roster Spring Training invitee IF Jeremiah Jackson.

#### ELECTRIC ENRIQUE

OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. begins his first full season in Double-A after swiping the second-most bases in the Minors last year with 74 stolen bags. The Orioles' 17th overall selection in 2023 led all O's minor leaguers in runs, tied for second in triples, and was fourth in hits. The Orioles top outfield prospect also received a Minor League Rawlings Gold Glove Award after recording only two errors all season.

#### CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems is set to begin his first full season in Chesapeake. The Orioles No. 12 prospect matched his career-high with 17 homers and set a new career-high with 65 RBI last season. Willems raked in the final series of the regular season last year, going 10-for-21 (.476) with three doubles, a homer and eight RBI against Erie. He also played in the Arizona Fall League and was named a Fall League All Star after batting .338 with an .891 OPS.

#### **WE LIKE BRIGHT**

RHP Trace Bright is set to make his season debut for the Chesapeake Baysox. The 24-year-old spent all of last year in Double-A and threw a career-high 112 innings (his first season eclipsing 100 innings pitched) but also gave up a career-high 60 walks, which led the Eastern League. The Orioles No. 25 prospect ended the season strong with a 1.93 ERA in September. He holds a 3.68 ERA in five career starts vs Altoona.

#### TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

The Altoona Curve host the Baysox for the first three of 21 total meetings between the two this season. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates went 62-76 overall last year but fared better in the second half after a franchise record 15-game losing streak in the first half. Altoona's active roster features five Pirates' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com), IF Termarr Johnson (No. 4), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 7), IF Jack Brannigan (No. 11), UTL Mitch Jebb (No. 13) and LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 14).

#### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Anthony Solometo is scheduled to make his season debut for the Curve today. The Pirates No. 14 prospect is coming off a disappointing sophomore season at Double-A where he posted a near 6.00 ERA in 20 appearances. Solometo holds a 4.70 ERA in four career appearances against the Baysox. The 22-year-old was drafted with the 37th overall pick in the 2021 Draft out of Bishop Eustace HS in New Jersey.

**2024**: Completed third season in Orioles organization and first full season in Double-A with Bowie as a full-time starter. Eclipsed 100.0 IP for first time in career with 112.0 IP but allowed a career-high 60 BB. 2nd on team in IP and K (120). Led Eastern League in walks but finished 8th in K. Delivered 1,305th strikeout of the season in final start of year, which set a new Baysox single-season franchise record. Threw 4th-most IP, struck out 8th-most batters, and allowed 2nd-most BB in O's system. One of two winless starters in all of Double-A (minimum 20 starts). Went 5.0+ IP in only four starts. Baysox went 9-18 when Bright started. Started season strong with a 2.41 ERA in month of April (9th-lowest in EL) over 18.2 IP with 23 K. Ended season strong with a 1.93 ERA in 14.0 IP in September.

Career Notes: Began '23 in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in K. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in K. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least 4.0 innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.... Debuted professionally in '22 with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27.

**College**: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were 4th-most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

## JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen wher his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season - 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. ### **CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS**



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

#### CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión<sup>TM</sup>" or "Fun Cup<sup>TM</sup>"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball<sup>TM</sup> teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

#### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
