### PELICANS BLANK CANNON BALLERS, SECURE AT LEAST A SPLIT

The Myrtle Beach Pelicans defeated the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers 5-0 on Saturday at Atrium Health Ballpark. The Myrtle Beach Pelicans (14-5, 39-44) opened the scoring in the third inning when Christian Olivo singled to drive in Angel Cepeda, giving the Birds a 1-0 lead. Derik Alcantara hit a sacrifice fly to plate Matt Halbach, and Olivo followed with a single to bring home Eli Lovich and Alexis Hernandez in the fourth inning, pushing the lead to 4-0 for the Pelicans. Owen Ayers launched a solo homer to center field in the eighth inning, extending the Pelicans' lead to 5-0. The Kannapolis Cannon Ballers (7-12, 39-47) managed only two hits and went 0-for-4 with runners in scoring position, unable to plate a run against the Pelicans' pitching staff. Pelicans starter Kevin Valdez (2-3) earned the win, pitching 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits with five strikeouts and two walks. Yoendris Gonzalez and Luis Martinez-Gomez combined for 3.0 scoreless innings, with Martinez-Gomez striking out five. Kannapolis' Reyes took the loss, allowing four runs on seven hits over 6.0 innings. Olivo led the Pelicans, going 2-for-3 with two RBIs, while Hernandez went 2-for-4 with a run scored. Ayers and Alexey Lumpuy each contributed a hit, with Lumpuy stealing two bases. For Kannapolis, T.J. McCants and George Wolkow each had a hit.

### HERE TO STAY

The Pelicans celebrated their 25th season in 2024. After the departure of the Myrtle Beach Hurricanes in 1992, the Pelicans were established in 1999 following the relocation of the Durham Bulls to Myrtle Beach. During their 25 seasons, the Pelicans have won four Carolina League titles in 1999, 2000, 2015, and 2016. Myrtle Beach has been affiliated with three teams in their 25 seasons, including the Atlanta Braves (1999-2010), Texas Rangers (2011-2014), and the Chicago Cubs (2015-present). Following negotiations with the Myrtle Beach City Council, the Pelicans were awarded a 30-year extension on the lease at the ballpark that keeps baseball at the beach through the 2055 season.

### A NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN

The Pelicans have a new manager in 2025. Yovanny Cuevas joined the Chicago Cubs organization as a player in 2015. His minor league career ran through 2021 with stops in the Dominican Summer League (DSL), the Arizona Complex League (ACL), and the Northwest League with the Eugene Emeralds. Overall, Cuevas' minor league slash line was .241/.369/.356 over 272 games. In 2022 Cuevas transitioned into a coach. His first assignment was with the ACL Cubs. The following season Cuevas was the hitting coach for the DSL Cubs Red squad, the Cubs affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. Last season he returned to the ACL Cubs as the hitting coach.

### MEET THE "SQUADRON"

Highlighting the Pelicans roster are six of the Cubs' Top 30 prospects in Cole Mathis, Angel Cepeda, Yahil Melendez, Nazier Mule, Ty Southisene and Eli Lovich. Mathis is the 15th ranked prospect in the organization and made his minor league debut this season with the Pelicans after being drafted 54th overall by the Cubs out of the College of Charleston in 2024. Cepeda slots into the 17th spot in the prospect rankings and is also the youngest player on the roster, having turned 19 in January. Angel grew up in New Jersey and scouts began taking interest in his talent when he was just 14 years old. He moved back to the Dominican Republic before signing with the Cubs in 2023.

The Pelicans Opening Day roster also welcomed eight Cubs' picks from the 2024 MLB Draft to the Grand Strand, including Mathis. Of the eight 2024 draftees, four are pitchers and four are position players. Brooks Caple, Evan Aschenbeck, Hayden Frank, Brayden Risedorph make up the pitchers while the hitters include Mathis, Owen Ayers, Matt Halbach and Cameron Sisneros.

16 players who have experience wearing the Pelicans uniform will return in 2025. Nazier Mule made 13 starts last season for the Pelicans, which was third most by any pitcher last season and leads all returners. In 2022 he was drafted by the Cubs in the 4th round and the 20-year-old is ready for his second season in Myrtle Beach.

Other returning players include Ayers, Sisneros, Jeral Vizcaino, Leonel Espinoza, Eriandys Ramon, Christopher Paciolla, Jose Escobar, Dilan Granadillo, Yenri Rojas, JP Wheat, Anderson Suriel, Alfredo Romero, Will Frisch, Luis Martinez-Gomez and Mathew Peters.

### THE LUCKY NUMBER 19

The Pelicans Opening Day roster featured three of the Cubs top thirty prospects, including 19-year-old Angel Cepeda. Since that roster was announced Cepeda has seen the promotions of three other 19-year-old top prospects in Yahil Melendez, Ty Southisene (now 20) and Eli Lovich. Melendez and Southisene were promoted together, each debuting on May 7th against the Delmarva Shorebirds. The two hit back-to-back in the 7th and 8th spots of the lineup and rolled a 6-4-3 (Melendez-Southisene-Sisneros) double play. Eli Lovich was promoted prior to the series opener on June 10th as the Birds hosted the Hickory Crawdads. The lefty opened his tenure with Myrtle Beach with back-to-back multi-hit nights.

### BIRD DROPPINGS

- After leading the league in home runs in both 2023 and 2024, the Pelicans have hit 38 homers this season which is 7th in the league. Myrtle Beach has hit 26 of their 37 homers on the road, 3rd most road homers of any team in the league. Their 12 homers at home are tied for the least of 12 teams.  
- Leonel Espinoza's 11-game hitting streak from 4/6-4/18 was the longest hitting streak in the league when it ended. Cameron Sisneros matched his streak with an 11-gamer from 4/25 to 5/11.  
- Angel Cepeda's 26-game on-base streak from 4/24 to 6/11 was the longest streak for a Myrtle Beach hitter since Parker Chavers reached base in 27 consecutive games from 5/31/23-7/14/2023.

- Eriandys Ramon set the single-game franchise record with four doubles on 8/15/24 vs. Columbia. He is 1 of 14 MB hitters with multiple doubles as the Pelicans rank 2nd in the Carolina League with 116 two-baggers. Ayers, Escobar and Espinoza are responsible for a team-leading 13 doubles. Escobar connected with his 13th on 7/4 where he fell a 3B shy of a cycle.  
- Pelicans' backstop Owen Ayers has been a dominant force in controlling the running game...he ranks 2nd in all of affiliated baseball with 37 caught stealings while ranking 23rd in total innings caught (422.2).  
- Defensively, Myrtle Beach is 1 of 3 teams in the Carolina League with a fielding percentage above .970.  
- MB has allowed 3 or less runs in 14 of 19 games in the second half, going 2-3 in games in which they allow 4+ runs.
