Today's Game: The Sounds and Tides wrap up their 2024 season with a matinee at Harbor Park. Nashville has a chance to even the series after winning last night, 6-1. Right-hander Easton McGee makes his second start for Nashville and faces off against left-hander Tucker Davidson.

Easton McGee: The 26-year-old makes his 11th appearance (second start) of the season for Nashville. His lone start came on August 2 where he gave up six runs (five earned) in 3.2 innings at Gwinnett on August 2. After a blow-up outing at the end of August, he has rebounded with 6.1 innings and just one earned run in his last three outings. Though mainly used as a reliever this season, he is no stranger to the starting role. In 121 career minor league appearances, 101 of them have come as a starter. Before signing as a free agent in the offseason, McGee made one appearance for the Rays in 2022 and had one start for the Mariners in 2023 before getting injured. He carried a no-hitter into the seventh inning and has not allowed an earned run in 9.2 MLB innings. The Rays drafted McGee in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft from Hopkinsville High School in Kentucky.

Tucker Davidson: The 28-year-old makes his 32 appearance (17th start) for the Tides this season. His first 10 outings this season came as a reliever but has recently been a staple in the rotation with his last 10 appearances coming as a starter. In his last time out, he went 6.0 innings with two earned runs in a win at Durham on September 15. Prior to that start, he had lost each of his last three starts. The left-hander has spent time in the MLB with the Braves, Angels, and Royals dating back to the 2020 season. In those 55 appearances, he is 3-10 with a 5.98 ERA (125.0 IP/83 ER) and 99 strikeouts. He was claimed off waivers by the Orioles in the offseason and has spent the entire season with the Tides. The Amarillo, Texas native was drafted in 2016 by the Braves in the 19th round (559th overall). This season, he has been tough on lefties, holding them to a .209 batting average (31-for-148) with a .642 OPS.

Francisco! Francisco Mejia went 2-for-3 with a home run and three RBI last night. It was the fifth time this season he has had three RBI in a game. Since August 2, he is hitting .344 (32-for-93) with six home runs and 15 RBI. He has also been excellent with runners in scoring position, slashing .368 (32-for-87) with 47 RBI and a 1.024 OPS this season.

All Black: Tyler Black launched his 13th home run of the season and stole his 20th base of the season last night. Last year, the Sounds did not have a player reach 20 stolen bases but have two this season (Brewer Hicklen, 44 stolen bases). Black also scored three times for the second time this season (April 23 at Louisville). Both Black and Hicklen sit at 99 hits this season heading into the season finale.

Guitar Heros: Last Sunday, the Nashville Sounds presented the 2024 player awards. Brewer Hicklen and Isaac Collins were both awarded the team MVP award. Chad Patrick received the Pitcher of the Year honor. Vinny Capra was voted the Sounds Fan Favorite Player by fans on social media. Kevin Herget was also honored as the Community Player of the Year. Also, the team recognized athletic trainer Jeff Paxson on winning his second straight International League Trainer of the Year award.

Patrick is a Star: Like clockwork, Chad Patrick dominated once again en route to his 14th win of the season. He became the first Sounds pitcher since Rodney Bolton in 1995 to reach 14 wins in a season. He's also the first pitcher in the International League since Cole Irvin (Lehigh Valley) in 2018 to reach 14 wins. He leads the IL in wins (14), ERA (2.90), WHIP (1.09), and strikeouts (145). The Sounds are 21-3 with Patrick on the mound. After Robert Gasser's 166 strikeouts last season, the Sounds have had a pitcher reach 135+ strikeouts in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2002-2003 (Salomon Torres 136 in 2022, Ryan Vogelsong 146 in 2003).

Fresh Faces: Though he has been with the Sounds since June 24, Andy Yerzy has spent nearly the whole time on the development list and has not played. He was activated on Thursday and is in the starting lineup for today's game. This season with Biloxi, Yerzy hit .194 (13-for-67) with two home runs and 14 RBI. Also added to the roster is six-foot-seven-inch tall, Sam McWilliams. The 29-year-old reliever spent time this season with Triple-A Iowa where he faced Nashville three times in their series in July. After being released on August 13, he was signed by the Brewers on September.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history - he has 397 wins in Nashville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 759-650 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,352-2,170 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

LAST OUTING: McGee gave up two runs (one earned) across 1.1 innings against Memphis on September 13. His only previous start with Nashville this season came on August 2 at Gwinnett.

AGAINST OPPONENT: McGee has faced Norfolk six times (four starts) in his career dating back to 2021. The first five came with Durham in which he has a 2-1 record with 15 earned runs allowed in 12 total innings. His only outing against Norfolk this season, he gave up one earned in 2.0 innings on July 21.
