GAME INFORMATION

SANTUCCI MANE: LHP Jonathan Santucci, the Mets' No. 11 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is slated to start and make his Double-A debut tonight. Santucci was drafted by the New York Mets in the second round (46th overall) of the 2024 MLB Draft out of Duke. The 22-year-old is in his first professional season and went 5-4 with a 3.46 ERA and 75 strikeouts in 67.2 innings across 15 appearances and 13 starts with High-A Brooklyn. The Leominster, Massachusetts, native ranked ninth in ERA and 10th in strikeouts in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion to Double-A. Santucci went 5-0 with a 1.35 ERA, 54 strikeouts (46.2 IP) and a .174 BAA over his final nine appearances with High-A Brooklyn, since May 16.

FLASH GURDIN: RHP R.J. Gordon started and made his Double-A for Binghamton on Thursday and he earned the win and allowed one run over a career-high seven innings with eight strikeouts, while issuing just three hits and one walk. The 23-year-old retired the first nine batters he faced with five strikeouts and became the third Rumble Ponies pitcher to spin seven or more innings this season. The only run he allowed was on an inside-the-park home run. Gordon was drafted by the New York Mets in the 13th round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of the University of Oregon and is in his first professional season.

2025 MLB ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME: RHP Jonah Tong and OF Carson Benge were both selected to represent the New York Mets in the 2025 MLB All-Star Futures Game. The game will take place on Saturday, July 12th at Truist Park in Atlanta at 4 p.m. Tong, the Mets' No. 2 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 59 prospect, has spent the entire season with Binghamton and leads Minor League Baseball with 125 strikeouts in 78.2 innings, while holding 6-4 record and a 1.83 ERA in 15 starts. Benge, the Mets' No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 74 prospect, was promoted to Double-A on June 23 and reached base in each of his first eight games. The 22-year-old hit .302 with an .897 OPS in 60 games for High-A Brooklyn.

LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the Altoona Curve, 2-1, on Thursday at Mirabito Stadium. RHP R.J. Gordon (W, 7 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 K) grooved in his Double-A debut and allowed one run over a career-high seven innings, while retiring the first nine batters of the game. C Matt O'Neill (3-for-3, R) recorded his first 3-hit game since 2023 and scored the eventual game-winning run on a balk. SWERVE BENGE THAT CURNER: OF Carson Benge, the Mets' No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 74 prospect, walked and scored on Thursday in his final game before the MLB All-Star Futures Game in Atlanta on Saturday. Benge has reached base via a hit or a walk in 12 of his first 13 games at the Double-A level. Since going 0-for-8 in his first two Double-A games, the 22-year-old has produced a .351 AVG (13-for-37), .478 OBP, .595 SLG, 1.073 OPS, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 9 R, 3 2B, 9 BB, 7 K, 2 SB in his last 11 games. Benge was drafted by the Mets with the 19th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma State.

CLIFFORD CRUSH: 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford**, the Mets' No. 6 prospect, blasted 2 HR (3-run HR & grand slam) and recorded a career-high 7 RBIs on Tuesday. Clifford has hit 4 HR and driven in 12 runs over his last seven games. Over his last 29 games, since June 6, Clifford has produced a .269 AVG (28 H), .990 OPS, 9 HR, 24 RBI, 18 R, 6 2B, 16 XBH, 20 BB, 26 K. Clifford ranks T-2nd with Kyler Fedko (Wichita, MIN) in Double-A with 17 HR, behind Brock Wilken (18 - Biloxi, MIL) and also ranks among AA with 54 RBI (T-4th), 49 BB (4th), 32 XBH (5th), 482 SLG (8th). The 21-year-old ranks among the Eastern League: 17 HR (1st), 49 BB (2nd), 54 RBI (3rd), 32 XBH (T-4th), 482 SLG (5th), .836 OPS (8th).

MORABITO MAGIC: OF Nick Morabito, the Mets' No. 16 prospect, is riding a four-game hit streak (4 H, 2 RBI, 3 R, 3 BB). Morabito ranks among AA: 31 SB (T-1st), 23 2B (T-2nd), 82 H (10th) and among the Eastern League: 31 SB (T-1st), 2B (T-2nd), 82 H (4th), 48 R (4th), .288 AVG (4th), 43 RBI (T-6th), 29 XBH (T-9th), .359 OBP (10th). This season, Morabito has set career highs in RBI, 2B, XBH, and tied a career high in HR.

THE JETT: SS/CF Jett Williams, the Mets' No. 1 prospect & MLB Pipeline's No. 45 overall prospect, tied Binghamton's franchise record for the most doubles in single game with three doubles on Tuesday. He was the first player to record 3 2B in a game since Drake Osborn on May 23, 2024 @ REA. The 21-year-old ranks among AA: 23 2B (T-2nd), 34 XBH (4th), 5 3B (T-4th), 48 BB (T-6th), 49 R (T-8th), .858 OPS (8th).

RELIEF PONIES: RHP Cameron Foster earned his third win of the season with two scoreless innings in relief on Wednesday. Foster extended his scoreless streak to 12-straight Double-A outings. Foster over that span: 1-0, 2 SV, 15.2 IP, 6 H, 2 BB, 19 K. He holds a 1.13 ERA (3 ER in 23.2 IP) in 17 Double-A appearances and has not allowed a run with Binghamton, since April 26. RHP Anthony Nunez, the Mets' No. 28 prospect, recorded his second Double-A save with a perfect ninth inning on Wednesday against Altoona. Nunez extended his scoreless streak to nine-consecutive appearances (1-0, 2 SV, 10.2 IP, 1 H, 3 BB, 17 K).

-Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16).
-In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-conesecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A. Brignac helped the Mets' MLB staff after the MiLB season.
-In 2023, Brignac led Binghamton to the postseason for the first time since 2017, going 39-27 in the second-half and 17-5

in the final 22 games. Binghamton swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to advance to the Eastern League Championship Series for the first time since 2014, before falling to the Erie SeaWolves.

-In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, Bryce Montes de Oca).
-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School in Louisiana.
