LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn captured Sunday's series finale in Aberdeen with a 1-0 victory...The Cyclones scored the game's only run in the top of the 8th on a solo home run to left-center field by C Chris Suero...LHP Jonathan Santucci (5.0 IP, 1 H), RHP Noah Hall (3.0, 1), and RHP Chandler Marsh (1.0, 0) combined to toss a 2-hit shutout, Brooklyn's 8th of the season...Marsh stranded the tying and winning runs on base in the 9th, forcing 3B Anderson De Los Santos to fly out to left, to pick up the save...Santucci allowed 1 hit over 5.0 innings, striking out 5...Hall earned the win, punching out 4 over 3.0 scoreless innings of relief...Both teams finished the day with just 2 hits each...The game lasted exactly 2 hours, Brooklyn's second-shortest game by time this year.

WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS: Brooklyn clinched its first postseason berth since 2022 by winning the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown with a 6-4 win at Aberdeen on Thursday night...The playoff berth is the Cyclones' second since moving to the full-season level, winning the Second Half North Division tittle in 2022...With the win, 3 New York Mets affiliates that play half-based seasons won First Half titles in 2025...Double-A Binghamton and Single-A St. Lucie clinched the first half crowns in the Eastern League Northeast and Florida State League Eastern Divisions, respectively...Brooklyn's 46-20 (.697) record is the best first-half record in the South Atlantic League since Minor League Baseball reorganized prior to the 2021 season...It is also the best first half record in the SAL since Augusta (50-20, .714) and West Virginia (48-20, .706) in 2007...Brooklyn will have home-field advantage in the SAL North Division playoffs, hosting Game 2 and, if necessary, Game 3...The Clones .696 winning percentage is the best in Minor League Baseball...The 48 wins are 1 behind the Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas (49) for the MiLB lead.

SUPER SUERO: C Chris Suero provided the go-ahead 3-run home run in the 8th inning of Brooklyn's First Half North Division-clinching win at Aberdeen on Thursday night...The 21-year-old also delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 8th inning on Tuesday...For his efforts, Suero was named the South Attantic League Player of the Week on Monday...In 5 games against the Inoshids last week, he went 9-for-19 (.474) at the plate with 5 runs scored, a double, a triple, 2 home runs, 8 RBI, and a stolen base...During the week, Suero paced the circuit in batting average (.474), RBI (8), slugging percentage (.947), OPS (1.492), and was tied for the lead in hits (9)...He is the 3rd Cyclone to win Player of the Week honors in 2025, joining OF A.J. Ewing (May 13-18) and INF Jesús Báez (May 20-5)...The Bronx native has reached safely in 8-straight games, going 11-for-29 (.379) at the dish...In June, Suero is hitting .293/.408/.517/.925 with 10 runs scored, 6 extra-base hits, 3 home runs, and 4 RBI...Entering play on Tuesday, the catcher is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in hit-by-pitches (14), 4th in RBI (43), 7th in slugging percentage (.468), 8th in OPS (.858), tied for 8th in home runs (10), tied for 9th in stolen bases (21), and 10th in on-base percentage (.390).

BINGO BOUND: The Cyclones made a series of roster moves since Sunday's seris finale in Aberdeen...Brooklyn sent 3 players to Double-A Binghamton: OF Carson Benge, RHP Brian Metoyer, and INF Jacob Reimer...In 60 games with the Cyclones, Benge hit .302/.417/.480/.897 with 27 extra-base hits, 4 home runs, 37 RBI, and 15 stolen bases...Entering Tuesday, the Yukon, Okla. native was tied for the South Atlantic League lead in doubles (18) and triples (5)...Benge was also 2nd in runs scored (47), batting average (.302), on-base percentage (.417), and OPS (.897), 3rd in hits (68), 4th in slugging percentage (.480) and extra-base hits (27), 5th in total bases (108) and walks (41), and 9th in RBI (37)...Metoyer made 14 relief appearances with Brooklyn, recording 2 saves and a 0.93 ERA (2 ER in I.Metoyer made 14 relief appearances with Brooklyn, recording 2 saves in the 284/.502/.884 in 61 games for Brooklyn, posting 30 extra-base hits, 8 home runs, 39 RBI, and 11 steals...Entering Tuesday, the Yucaipa, Calif. native led the SAL in runs scored (52) and was tied for the league lead in doubles (18). Reimer was also tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (30), 3rd in slugging percentage (.502) and OPS (.886), tied for 3rd in triples (4), 4th in total bases (115) and hits (65), 6th in RBI (39), 7th in batting average (.284), and 9th in on-base percentage (.384).

HOU DO YOU DO: INF Colin Houck was added to Brooklyn's roster on Monday from Single-A St. Lucie...The 20-year-old was the New York Mets' first-round pick in the 2023 MLB froat...In 62 games with St. Lucie, Houck hit. 252/, 351/, 461/, 812 with 43 runs scored, 27 extra-base hits, 8 home runs, 38 RBI, and 11 stolen bases...Since May 25, the infielder has posted an impressive 321/, 420/, 583/1.003 slash line with 12 extra-base knocks, 4 homers, and 15 RBI...At the time of his promotion, Houck led the Florida State League in extra-base hits (27)...He was also tied for 3rd in runs scored (43), total bases (106), triples (5), and doubles (14), tied for 4th in RBI (38), 5th in slugging percentage (.461), tied for 5th in games played (62), and 10th in OPS (.812).

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn erased its 2nd 8th-inning deficit in 3 games in a 6-4 win at Aberdeen on Thursday night...The Cyclones trailed 4-2 entering the 8th on Thursday and 2-1 going into the 8th on Thuesday, coming back to win both...Brooklyn won 3 of their final 4 games of the first half when trailing in the 8th inning or later...The team also won 4 of their final 8 games of the final when either thed or trailing in the 8th inning or later...The Cyclones are 37-6 when scoring first and 11-15 when their opponent scores first.

LATE-INNING MAGIC: Brooklyn has dominated the latter stages of games in 2025...Despite trailing 2-1 through 7 innings on Tuesday and 4-2 through 7 on Thursday, the Cyclones came from behind to win both games en route to a South Atlantic League First Half North Division title...In 2025, Brooklyn has outscored opponents 74-24 (+50) from the 8th inning on...The Cyclones have outdueled their foes, 38-11, in the 8th, 32-11, in the 9th, and 4-2, in the 10th inning and beyond.

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn has been a model of consistency at Maimonides Park this year...June 12's defeat vs. Asheville marked the end of the Cyclones' 15-game home winning streak...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering play on Tuesday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 26-7 (7.78)...Greenville is second best (22-18)...The 26 home wins are 5th most in all of Minor League Baseball...The Atlantics' Triple-A Las Vegas and Seattle's Triple-A Tacoma lead the minors (28)...Brooklyn's .788 home winning percentage is the best in Mil.B...Pittsburgh's Triple-A Indianapolis (.750) is 2nd.

EWING-ING IT: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...Entering play on tuesday, the Springboro, Ohio native is 3rd in all of Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (47) and tied for 3rd in triples (7)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (33), registering 7 more than anyone else...He is also tied for 2nd in runs scored (36), 3rd in on-base percentage (408), tied for 3rd in triples (3), 4th in walks (30) and hits (50), tied for 5th in games played (45), and 7th in batting average (.292)...Overall, Evingi s 2nd in stolen bags (33) and 5th in on-base percentage (408) and batting average (.292)...The 2023 4th-round pick was regordized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the \$XAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Nick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024.

CAN'T TUCC THIS: LHP Jonathan Santucci has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 4-0 over his last 7 outings (5 starts), including a career-high-tying 51 score-less inning performance in a no-decision on June 4 at Wilmington...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has a 4-0 record with a 1.03 ERA (4 ER in 35.0 P) with 18 hits allowed, 11 walks, and 37 strikeouts...Santucci saw his scoreless inning streak come to an end at 18.0 frames in May 10's win vs. Asheville...The southpaw's streak spanned from the 2nd inning in Game 1 of a double-header on May 23 at Jersey Shore until the top of the 7th with two outs on May 10...Since May 16, Santucci leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.03) and batting average against (148), and is tied for 1st in wins (4)...He is also 2nd in WHIP (0.83), 3rd in innings pitched (35.0), and tied for 7th in strikeouts (37)

vs. JERSEY SHORE: After taking 5-of-6 on the road against Jersey Shore, Brooklyn returns home for their first home series of the second half...The BlueClaws dropped 3-for-5 at home last week to Hudson Valley...Thursday's first half finale was canceled due to weather...Jersey Shore is 11-21 on the road this season...Brooklyn is 7-5 against the BlueClaws in 12 games this season, all played at ShoreTown Ballpark... The BlueClaws boast 8 of the Phillies' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF Devin Saltiban (9), INF Bryan Rincon (14), LHP Mavis Graves (17), RHP Alex McFarlane (18), RHP Micah Ottenbreit (28)...In 122 meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 63-59 (.516)...Brooklyn is 28-26 (.519) against the BlueClaws in 54 games at Maimonides Park.

NOAH'S ARC: After being limited to just 13.0 innings in his first professional season in 2024, RHP Noah Hall has found a new gear in 2025...The 24-year-old registered his 1st pro save on June 5 at Wilmington, tossing 4.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball...The save was Hall's first since April 30, 2021, vs. the University of Louisiana at Monroe, while pitching for Appalachian State University...Entering play on Tuesday, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.27), tied for 5th in wins (5), 6th in batting average against (196), tied for 8th in innings pitched (63.1), and 9th in strikeouts (69)

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly returned to form...Since the start of May, Báez is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in RBI (34)...He is also 4th in on-base percentage (.393). 7th in OPS (.885), 9th in batting average (.290), and tied for 9th in total bases (67) and hits (42)...On the year, Báez is tied for 7th in RBI (.38)...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the May 20-25 series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit. 647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (1.059) OPS (1.798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF A.J. Ewing won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win vs. Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Th-City..Brooklyn enters play on Tuesday with 156 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (165)...The 156 steals are the 6th most in Minor League Baseball...Cleveland's Single-A Lynchburg leads Milb (197)...Brooklyn already has 3 players with 120-plus steals, 7 players with 10-or-more steals, and 9 players with 5-plus... The 156 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 69 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 53 swipes...The 2005 club is 2nd with 103...The Cyclones are 25 steals shy of breaking their single-season franchise record of 181 steals set in 2024.

MARCO POLO: INF Marco Vargas has been scorching hot over the last few weeks, helping lead Brooklyn to a First Half North Division crown...The 20-year-old had an 11-game on-base streak since June 8 snapped on Sunday, He hit 385/468/436/904 with 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, 7 RBI, 7 walks, and 10 stolen bases during that time...In June, Vargas is slashing .293/.373/.328/.701 with 8 runs scored, 2 doubles, 8 RBI, 8 walks, and 12 swiped bags...Since making his Cyclones debut, the Chihuahua, Mexico native is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in stolen bases (23)...He is also tied for 6th in the league in steals for the year.

GIRT 'ER DONE: After tossing 5.0 perfect innings in June 14's 1-0 win vs. Asheville, RHP Brendan Girton was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on Monday for Week 12 (June 10-15)...The 23-year-old is the first Cyclone pitcher to receive a weekly honor this year and the first to win Pitcher of the Week since LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home the award for May 20-26, 2024...Girton is the first Cyclones' right-hander to earn the honor since RHP Luis Moreno won for July 25-31, 2022...Girton did not receive a decision on June 14, but retired all 15 batters he faced, striking out 6...He, RHP Jeol Pitch (3.0) IP), and RHP Raimon Gómez (1.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout...Since May 1, the Gage, Okla., native leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (1.69), and is 4th in WHIP (0.96) and ERA (2.36)...Among pitchers with 45.0 or more innings, Girton is 9th in the SAL in strikeouts-per-9-innings (10.76) and ERA (2.92) and tied for 9th in strikeout rate (29.1%).

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first δ9 games of the 2025 season with Friday's Second Half-opening victory at Aberdeen, earning the series victory...Through Brooklyn's first 12 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 9-0-3 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 5-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 11-0-3 in a series of any length.

THRICE IS NICE: The Cyclones completed the 2nd triple play in franchise history in the top of the 9th inning in Sunday's comeback win vs. Asheville...Tourists SS Drew Vogel hit into a 4-3-5 triple play...2B Marco Vargas fielded the ball behind second, stepped on the bag, and threw to 1B Jacob Reimer for a double play...Reimer then threw across the diamond where 3B Jesús Báez tagged out CF Lucas Spence, who overslid the bag, for the triple play...It marked Brooklyn's first triple-killing since July 10, 2016, on a 2-6-4 triple play from CD Dan Rizzie, to SS Colby Woodmansee, to 2B Nick Sergakis...1B Pete Alonso was on the field for the 1st triple play in franchise history...Brooklyn then turned a double play to start the 10th inning, as 1B Oliver Carrillo filed out to left and Vogel was tagged out trying to advance to 3rd...RHP Ben Simon recorded 6 outs by facing only 3 batters...It is the only known occurrence of a pitcher recording at least 6 outs and facing 3 or fewer batters since at least 1910.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 6 alumni have already accomplished the feat in 2025...RHP Paul Gervase (2023), who was traded to the Tampa Bay Rays at the trade deadline last year, made his MLB debut on Saturday, tossing 2.0 innings of scoreless and hitless relief...He struck out CF Parker Meadows looking for his first career strikeout...RHP Blade Tidwell (2023) became the 5th to debut this year, suffering the loss in a start for the New York Mets in Game 1 of May 4's doubleheader at St. Louis...OF Rhylan Thomas (2023) with the Seattle Mariners, RHP Mike Vasil (2022) with the Chicago White Sox, OF Jake Mangum (19, '21) with the Rays, and C Hayden Senger (18, '21) with the New York Mets are the others to debut this year.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 11 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (11), INF Boston Baro (12), INF Marco Vargas (13), RHP Nate Dohm (18), C Chris Suere (20), OF EI Serano III (21) and C Ronald Hernández (25), OF A.J. Ewing (26), RHP WIII Watson (29), and INF Colin Houck (30)...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (6), Ewing (8), Vargas (11), Baro (17), Santucci (18), Suero (19), Serrano I(20), RHP Raimon Gómez (21), Dohm (24), and Houck (28)...Brooklyn also hosts 10 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), Gómez (28), and Houck (30).

LAST TIME OUT: Shined in a no-decision last Wednesday night at Aberdeen...Did not allow a run on 1 hit over 4.0 innings...Walked 2 and struck out a career-high 8...Threw 67 pitches and 41 strikes (61.19%)...Recorded 7 of his final 8 outs via strikeouts...Relieved by RHP **Raimon Gómez** to start the bottom of the 5th inning with Brooklyn leading 6-0...The IronBirds broke up the shutout in the 6th inning, but the Cyclones went on to win the penultimate game of the first half, 6-1.

DOHM-INATION: Dohm has been outstanding for the Cyclones over the last few weeks...Since his start on May 30 vs. Aberdeen, the Zionsville, Ind. native has a 1-1 record, but a spotless 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 16.1 IP)...Dohm has allowed just 7 hits and 7 walks, while striking out 22...He has allowed 4 unearned runs over the 4 starts, all coming on June 12 vs. Asheville...Since May 30, Dohm has thrown the most innings in the South Atlantic League (16.1) without permitting an earned run...He is also 4th in the circuit in strikeout rate (34.9%) among arms with 16.0 or more innings since that date.

2025: Broke camp with Single-A St. Lucie...Suffered the loss as the Opening Day starter on 4/4 vs. JUP (3.1 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 2 K)...Earned his 1st win of the season on 4/18 vs. TAM (5.0 IP, H, R, ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...Struck out a season-high 7 in a no-decision on 4/22 vs. Daytona (4.0 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 7 K)...Earned the victory, tossing a career-high 5.1 innings on 5/3 @JUP (5.1 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 6 K)...At the time of his promotion, Dohm was tied for 5th in the Florida State League in strikeouts (34) and tied for 7th in innings pitched (28.1)...Transferred to Brooklyn on 5/12...Took a no-decision in his Cyclones and High-A debut on 5/15 vWS (3.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 4 K)...Tossed 3.2 innings of shutout ball in a no-decision on 5/30 vABD (3.2 IP, 3 H, BB, 4 K)...Earned the 1st win of his Cyclones career with 5.0 shutout innings on 6/5 vWIL (5.0 IP, 2 H, BB, 6 K)...Struck out a career-high 8 over 4.0 shutout, 1-hit innings in a no-decision on 6/18 @ABD (4.0 IP, H, 2 BB, 8 K).

PROSPECT RADAR: Dohm is ranked as the New York Mets' No. 24 prospect in 2025 per *Baseball America*...He entered 2025 ranked as the Mets' No. 23 prospect by that publication...He is considered New York's No. 18 farmhand by MLB Pipeline and the organization's No. 20 prospect per SNY's **Joe DeMayo**.
