**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the final game of the 2024 season against the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Nuts are 8-15 against West Michigan, 3-8 at LMCU Ballpark, with all 24 of matchups taking place in the second half. Lansing has lost its last eight games, including dropping the first five games of this series.

**On the Air:** Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa call the game on StreamGuys, and Dan Hasty & Nate Wangler deliver the action on MiLB TV and Bally Live.

**Last Night: Whitecaps 2, Lugnuts 1.** A's trade deadline acquisition **Kade Morris** twirled seven scoreless innings for the Lugnuts, protecting an early 1-0 lead, but Tigers trade deadline acquisition **Thayron Liranzo** greeted reliever **Micah Dallas** with a go-ahead two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth, launching the Whitecaps to a fifth straight win over the Lugnuts.

**On Deck:** We are 206 days away from the next Lugnuts game, the 2025 Crosstown Showdown on April 1 vs. Michigan State, and 213 days away from Opening Day.

**Rocking Out in Double-A:** The reigning Midwest League Pitcher of the Week, **Will Johnston**, makes his Midland RockHounds debut today after acing the Whitecaps with a career high six innings in the first game of the series. Johnston joins fellow 2024 Lugnuts **Euribiel Angeles**, **Henry Bolte**, **Brayan Buevas**, **Will Simpson**, **James González** and **Colton Johnson** in Midland.

**The Power of Will:** Speaking of Will Simpson, the first baseman went 2-for-3 with a walk yesterday in Midland's 4-0 win over Amarillo (led by seven scoreless innings from 2023 Lug **Jack Perkins**). Simpson is batting an even .500 for Midland: 20-for-40 with four walks in 11 games.

**Battle of the Parent Clubs:** While the Nuts and Whitecaps lock up today one last time at LMCU Ballpark, the A's and the Tigers wrap up a three-game series at the Oakland Coliseum at 4:07 p.m. Oakland won the opener in 13 innings on a **Seth Brown** walkoff, but Detroit overcame six shutout innings from former Nut **Brady Basso** in a 2-1 win yesterday afternoon.

**They Fought the Law and the Law Won:** 2021-22 Lugnut **Lawrence Butler** is not only the reigning American League Player of the Week, he's making a bid to retain the honor. Butler put together a franchise record with a nine-game streak with extra-base hits and enters today riding a 17-game hitting streak. In September alone, Butler is slashing .414/.452/.655.

**The Best Lugnut Ever?** 2017 Nut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** ranks 2nd in MLB in batting average (.326); 3rd in base hits (176); 4th in on-base percentage (.397); 4th in doubles (40); 5th in total bases (303); 6th in extra-base hits (69); 7th in OPS (.955); and 8th in slugging percentage (.558).

**Roll Call:** The Lugnuts used 48 different players this year, 25 position players and 23 pitchers. The most recent was right-hander **Drew Conover**, who became the 950th different player in team history. He is also the third Rutgers Scarlet Knight on the squad, joining SS **Josh Kuroda-Grauer** and CF **Ryan Lasko**.

**From 517 to The Show:** Nine former Luggies made their MLB debut this season: **Max Schuemann** on April 12, **Brett Harris** on May 3, **Brady Basso** on May 31, **Leo Jiménez** on July 4, **Jacob Wilson** on July 19, **Luis De Los Santos** on July 31, **Grant Holman** on August 17, **Jeff Criswell** on August 21 and **Griffin Conine** on August 26. 193 former Nuts have now worked their way up to the Majors.

**Prospecting:** Lugnuts among MLB Pipeline's updated Top 30 A's Prospects include **Luis Morales** at No. 3, **Josh Kuroda-Grauer** at No. 13, **Kade Morris** at No. 19, **Jared Dickey** at No. 27 and **Ryan Lasko** at No. 30.

**Off to Arlington:** Luis represented the Oakland Athletics in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game on July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, becoming the fifth active Lugnut in team history to participate in the Futures Game, joining Denzel Clarke (2022), Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (2017) and Ángel Perdomo (2016). He was one of seven current Midwest Leaguers to be part of the Futures Game roster, along with Ethan Salas (Fort Wayne), Ben Kudrna (Quad Cities), Noble Meyer and Thomas White (Beloit), Thayron Liranzo (Great Lakes) and Cam Collier (Dayton). He faced four batters, striking out two, hitting Dylan Crews with a pitch and walking Liranzo.

**Prospecting:** Morales is ranked the Athletics' no. 3 prospect and top pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50. They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodríguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings."

**Path to Lansing:** Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder.

- Aug. 16 - The Lugnuts drew their 10 millionth fan to Michigan Ave., between Cedar and Larch Streets downtown.

- Aug. 21 - P **Jeff Criswell** becomes the 192nd Lugnut to reach the majors, tossing a scoreless inning for the Colorado Rockies.
- Aug. 26 - OF **Griffin Conine** becomes the 193rd Lugnut to reach the majors, striking out in his only at-bat for the Miami Marlins.
- 2015 Lugnut **Danny Jansen** becomes the first player in Major League history to play for both teams in the same game.
- Aug. 29 - **Lawrence Butler** hits three homers in a 10-9 loss at Cincy, becoming the second A's player ever to have two 3-HR games in the same season.
