SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Bowie Baysox, 5-4, in 10 innings to close out the homestand at The Diamond. The Baysox broke a scoreless tie with a bases-loaded walk by Jaylen Ferguson in the sixth inning. In the bottom of the sixth, **Shane Matheny** hit a two-run double to put Richmond ahead, 2-1. In the bottom of the eighth, Matheny padded the lead to 4-1 with another two-run double. With two outs in the top of the ninth, **Adley Rutschman** hit a game-tying, three-run homer. The Baysox took a 5-4 lead in the top of the tenth with a sac fly by Ferguson. Bowie reliever **Diogenes Almengo** held the Flying Squirrels off the scoreboard in the bottom of the tenth to close out the game. Richmond starting pitcher **Sean Hjelle** set a new season high with eight strikeouts and allowed one unearned run over 5.1 innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels open a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, at FirstEnergy Stadium. This series marks the only trip to Reading this season for the Flying Squirrels. The Fightin Phils play six games at The Diamond from August 3-8.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped seven of the last nine games and four of five. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 3.5 games behind Bowie. Over the last nine games since May 14, the Flying Squirrels are batting .216 (64-for-296) as a team. Through the previous 10 games, the Flying Squirrels hit .264 (84-for-318), third-best in the league.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS are in fifth place in the Double-A Northeast Division, 10.0 games behind first-place Somerset. They have lost four consecutive games and 12 of the last 13 overall since May 9. For the season, Reading is ranked 28th of 30 Double-A teams with a .194 team batting average. Their 7.50 team ERA is the highest in Double-A and the second-highest of the 120 affiliated minor league teams. Reading's roster includes four of MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects, including RHP Francisco Morales (4), C Rodolfo Durán (19), LHP Ethan Lindow (24) and RHP James McArthur (29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his fourth Double-A start. Last time out, he allowed his first two runs of the season (one earned) over 5.0 innings in a loss against Bowie on Wednesday at The Diamond. In his first two starts of the year, he combined for 11.0 scoreless innings. On May 13 at Harrisburg, Frisbee worked 6.0 perfect innings in the franchise's first nine-inning no-hitter. He is currently leads all of Double-A in BAA (.093) and WHIP (0.38) and ranks fourth in ERA (0.56). He is also third in the Double-A Northeast in ERA. He spent most of the 2019 season with San Jose, going 9-8 with a 3.17 ERA in 22 outings (20 starts). He went 4-2 with a 1.91 ERA in his last 10 appearances (56.2 IP) of the season while picking up 60 strikeouts. Following the season, Frisbee was named a Giants Organizational All-Star by MiLB.com. He was drafted by the Giants in the 15th round in 2018 out of UNC Greensboro. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

FOR READING: Right-hander **Colton Eastman** makes his second start of the season and his fourth overall appearance. In his most recent outing, he worked 3.0 relief innings at Akron last Tuesday, allowing two runs in a loss. In his only previous start this season on May 12 at Bowie, Eastman allowed four runs (two earned) over a season-high 3.2 innings in a loss. Eastman was drafted by the Phillies in the fourth round in 2018 out of Cal State Fullerton. He climbed three levels during the 2019 season, his first full year in professional baseball, combining to go 7-8 with a 3.71 ERA in 24 games (19 starts). He made six appearances (four starts) for Reading in 2019, going 1-1 with a 3.03 ERA.

STRONG ARMS: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank fifth in all of Double-A in ERA (3.00), which is fourth in the Double-A Northeast. The Richmond pitching staff also ranks tied for third in shutouts (2), tied for second in saves (7), fifth in fewest runs allowed (65) and fifth in opponents' batting average (.199). Starting pitcher **Matt Frisbee** is fourth among qualified pitchers in ERA (0.56). He is first in Double-A in opponents' batting average (.093) and WHIP (0.38).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the second-best bullpen ERA in all of Minor League Baseball at 1.97 on the season. The bullpen is tied for sixth in the minors and tied for first in Double-A with seven saves. Richmond relievers have allowed the fourth-fewest earned runs (16), third-fewest runs (20) and fourth-fewest hits (40) in the minors and have the fourth-lowest opponents' batting average (.158).

ANGULO ADJUSTING: **Andres Angulo** is currently ranked ninth in the Double-A Northeast with a .319 batting average despite only 73 games of experience at the Low-A level and no games at High-A prior to this season. He is batting .333 (5-for-15) and has five RBIs in the current series against Bowie, both of which are ranked second on the team behind **Heliot Ramos**. In his work behind the plate, Angulo leads the Double-A Northeast with seven base runners caught attempting to steal out of 11 attempts against him.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 10-8 record is the third-best start through 18 games in team history, trailing only a 12-6 start in 2018 and an 11-7 start in 2014.

A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS: The Flying Squirrels have sold out their maximum capacity crowds at The Diamond for 10 of their 11 openings this year. For the first homestand, the Flying Squirrels drew the maximum allotted crowd of 2,943 for all five openings. In the current homestand, the maximum capacity is 3,448. After drawing 3,057 fans last Tuesday (89%), the Flying Squirrels have sold out their last five home games.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Ten players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (5), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

GOING FOR GOLD: Flying Squirrels manager **José Alguacil** is taking an absence from his position in Richmond to manage the Venezuelan national team for the WBSC Baseball Americas Olympic Qualifier at Clover Park in St. Lucie, Fla. and The Ballpark of the Palm Beaches in West Palm Beach, Fla. Venezuela is playing in Group B with Canada, Colombia and Cuba. After scrimmage games against the Dominican Republic and the United States, Venezuela will play its first game of the Qualifier on May 31 against Cuba in West Palm Beach. The top two teams from each group will play in a super round on June 4 and 5, with the team holding the best record from that round earning a spot in the Olympics in Japan. **Tony Diggs** will manage the Flying Squirrels for this week's series in Reading. Diggs, who is the Giants' Minor League Field Coordinator, previously spent 16 seasons with the Milwaukee Brewers organization, including managing in the Arizona League from 2008 to 2012 and 2016, as well as with the Helena Brewers from 2013 to 2015. Catcher **Andres Angulo** will also be in Florida to play for his home country, Colombia, in the Qualifier.

MOVING UP: Left-handed pitcher **Sam Long** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on Tuesday. He made four starts with the Flying Squirrels, going 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA. He had five strikeouts in each of his first three starts with Richmond before punching out seven over 4.0 scoreless innings on Saturday. Among qualified pitchers, Long ranked tied for 14th in the Double-A Northeast in ERA (3.00), tied for 11th in strikeouts (22), ninth in K/9 IP (13.2), eighth in K% (36.7%) 16th in BAA (.214) and 14th in WHIP (1.07).
