The Fightin Phils return home for their second-to-last home series of the season against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It's the 14th-of-17 matchups between the teams this season, and third-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading leads the season-series 8-5.

### Two In a Row

The Fightin Phils aveneged another late surge from New Hampshire en route to their second-straight win, 5-4, over the Fisher Cats on Wednesday night. Reading scored four runs in the bottom of the third, thanks in large part to two-run double from Trevor Schwecke. After allowing a run in the first inning, Braeden Fausnaught settled in to allow one run over five innings, with five strikeouts in his Double-A debut. New Hampshire tied the game with three runs off Andrew Baker in the sixth inning. The Fightin Phils got a run in the seventh to re-gain the lead 5-4. Konnor Ash got the win with two-strong innings of relief, then Andrew Schultz closed the door on the Fisher Cats with his fifth save in the ninth for Reading's second-straight victory.

Justin Crawford turned in another stellar performance on Wednesday night. The Phillies No. 3 Prospect had two hits and a run scored. So far in Reading, Crawford is slashing .347/.390/.467, with an .857 OPS over his first 18 games in Double-A. He's added 11 runs, six doubles, one home run and 15 RBI. Crawford owns eight multi-hit games and five multi-RBI games, and is hitting .438 with runners in scoring position.

Gabriel Rincones Jr.'s power surge continue with a 410 foot home run to right field on Tuesday night that landed on route 61 outside of FirstEnergy Stadium. Over his last seven games, Rincones is slashing .393/.433/.929, with a 1.362 OPS. He's added eight runs, three doubles, four home runs and nine RBI. Rincones also homered in three-straight games (8/9-10), making him the first R-Phil to homer in three-consecutive contests since Oliver Dunn did it from Aug. 15-17, of

### The Local Kid

Braeden Fausnaught fired five-strong innings in his Double-A debut on Wednesday night. He went five innings and allowed one run on five hits, with no walks and five strikeouts. Fausnaught had tons of family and friends on hand for his debut on Wednesday. He played his high school baseball at Danville High School, which is 71 miles away from FirstEnergy Stadium. Fausnaught then played collegiately at West Chester University, which is just 45 miles from Baseballtown.

### Streaks on Streaks

Multiple Fightin Phils currently own impressive hitting and on-base streaks. Otto Kemp leads Reading with a 14-game on-base streak currently, where he's hitting .308, with a .400 on-base percentage over the streak. Carson Taylor is on a 12-game on-base streak, where he's hitting .325, with a .451 on-base percentage.

MLB Pipeline released their latest prospect rankings on Tuesday night. In total, eight members of the Fightin Phils current roster were ranked amongst the Phillies' top-30 prospects: Andrew Painer (2), Justin Crawford (3), Gabriel Rincones Jr. (11), Jean Cabrera (13), Christian McGowan (22), Caleb Ricketts (24), Moises Chace (26) and Otto Kemp (26). Cabrera and Kemp are new to the top-30 after previously being unranked. Four former R-Phils were ranked as well: Mick Abel (6), Seth Johnson (15), Griff McGarry (21) and Carlos De La Cruz (25). The Philies had four players in MLB's top 100: Aidan Miller (29), Andrew Painter (34), Justin Crawford (58) and Starlyn Caba (91).

### This Day in Baseballtown History

August 15, 2023: At Reading, the R-Phils beat Somerset 6-5 in a game that was completed after being suspended on July 9. Reading, playing as the road team, scored two runs in the tenth to give Tristan Garnett his first Double-A victory in relief. Reading would fall 4-3 to Somerset in the originally-scheduled contest.

New Hampshire enters tonight after finishing in last place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 30-38 record. They are last in the Northeast Division with a 13-25 record in the second half of the season. New Hampshire most recently took two-of-five at home against Erie. Following this week, New Hampshire hosts Hartford. New Hampshire's roster features eight players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Charles McAdoo (9), Adam Macko (10), Eddinson Paulino (19), Dahian Santos (22), Yohendrick Pinango (23), Dasan Brown (25), RJ Schreck (29) and Josh Rivera (30).

### Cat on the Bump

Righty Michael Dominguez makes the start tonight for the Fisher Cats. This season, Dominguez is 2-5, with a 5.00 ERA over 16 starts (72 IP, 60 H, 41 BB, 66 SO). This will be Dominguez's first start since July 4 at Portland, where he took the loss by allowing two runs on six hits over 4.2 innings of work. Dominguez faced Reading on June 23, taking the loss by allowing five runs on five hits over 4.2 innings, with five strikeouts. He split 2023 between High-A Vancouver and New Hampshire, combining to go 8-3, with a 3.87 ERA over 23 starts. Toronto drafted Dominguez in the 15th round of the 2019 draft out of Jefferson High School in Tampa, Florida.
