Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds take on Gwinnett in game two of a six-game series against the Triple-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves. The Sounds dropped a 4-3 decision last night, with their ninth-inning rally coming up a run short. Right-handed pitcher and No. 24 prospect in the Brewers system (according to MLB Pipeline) Dylan File (0-0, 6.75) gets the start for Nashville. Allan Winans will start for Gwinnett.

Dylan File: 25-year-old Dylan File starts for the Sounds in tonight's contest. The right-hander makes his second start of the season after making his 2022 season debut on April 7 vs. Durham. File is 0-0 with a 6.75 ERA after allowing three runs (3 ER) and five hits in his first start of 4.0 innings. The Dixie State (UT) product spent a majority of last season with the Sounds, going 2-4 with a 5.27 ERA in 9 games (all starts) in 2021. He spent the first half of last season rehabbing from a stress fracture in his right elbow. File was drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Allan Winans: 26-year-old Allan Winans starts for Gwinnett in game two of the series tonight. The right-hander is making his second start of the season and his professional career. On April 8 at Memphis, Winans made his Triple-A debut and allowed two runs (2 ER) on three hits and two walks in 4.0 innings. He struck out four Redbirds in a no-decision in Memphis' 4-3 win. He totaled 62 pitches with 39 strikes. Winans was selected by the Braves from the Mets during the Triple-A phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft. In 2021, he split the season between Advanced-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton, going 2-3 with a 1.72 ERA in 26 games (no starts). He pitched in a career-high 30 games in 2019 with Single-A Columbia, going 1-3 with a 2.74 ERA while also adding 11 saves. Winans was originally drafted by the Mets in the 17th round of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Campbell University.

Streak Snapped: The Sounds completed their first series win with three-straight wins from April 8-10 against the Durham Bulls. Last night's 4-3 loss snapped Nashville's first streak of victories. In 2021, the Sounds put together nine winning streaks of three or more games.

The California Kid: Brice Turang has hit safely in each of his last three games, including two multi-hit games. He's batting .385 (5-for-14) during the brief three-game stretch.

Smashing Singleton: Jon Singleton became the first Sounds player to record a three-hit game in 2022 last night. He's batting .250 with two doubles, two homers and four RBI over six games this season.

Welcome Back: Abraham Almonte returned to Coolray Field last night after spending part of last season with the Stripers. The switch hitter went 2-for-4 with an RBI in his first multi-hit game of the season. In 19 games with Gwinnett, Almonte hit .403 (25-for-62) with 16 runs, 19 RBI, and 21 walks.

Bandits: Nashville is a perfect 8-for-8 on stolen base attempts in 2022, the sixth-most in the International League. Jonathan Davis and Corey Ray pace the team with two apiece while Jon Singleton, Garrett Whitley, Tyler White and Weston Wilson have one each.

Hold it: Nashville relievers lead all of Triple-A with 10 holds. Gwinnett is tied for the 2nd-most with seven. Hobie Harris and Miguel Sanchez have two apiece to lead the squad.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 513-463 record during this span.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.

LAST OUTING: File took a no decision in his first start of the season on April 7 vs. Durham. He allowed three runs (3 ER) and five hits in 4.0 innings of work. He threw a total of 69 pitches, with 45 strikes. Trailing 3-0 at his exit, the Sounds scored three runs in the fifth. The Sounds eventually fell 6-3.

AGAINST OPPONENT: File has one previous start against Gwinnett, taking a no decision on August 25, 2021. The right-hander went 4.2 innings on that night at First Horizon Park that night, allowing one run (1 ER) and four hits. File struck out five Strippers and allowed two walks. He totaled 90 pitches with 56 strikes. Gwinnett won that game 5-4 in 10 innings.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Tonight's start will be File's second start of the season with Nashville.
- He made one appearance for the Brewers in spring training, allowing four hits and two runs (2 ER) in 2.0 innings in relief on March 20.
- Enters the season as No. 25 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB Pipeline and the No. 28 prospect in the same category by Baseball America.
