GAME INFORMATION

FRANCISCO ALVAREZ REHAB: New York Mets **catcher Francisco Alvarez** has played in two games this series for Double-A Binghamton during his rehab assignment. Alvarez is 3-for-7 with a home run, three runs batted in, one run scored, one walk, and a hit by pitch. Alvarez caught the entire game defensively on Wednesday night and tossed out two would-be base stealers, while adding a two-run single in the seventh inning. He caught six innings behind the plate and hit a solo homer on Tuesday. The 23-year-old began his rehab assignment (fractured left hamate) on April 9 and played in three games at catcher for Class-A St. Lucie.

JEFF MCNEIL REHAB: New York Mets **second baseman Jeff McNeil** had his rehab assignment (right oblique strain) transferred from Class-A St. Lucie to Double-A Binghamton on Saturday. McNeil played in four games (three at 2B, one in CF) in his rehab with St. Lucie and went 3-for-11 with two runs, three walks, and two strikeouts. McNeil was placed on the 10-day IL on March 27. The 33-year-old is a 2x All-Star (2019 & 2022) and won the National League batting title and a Silver Slugger Award in 2022. McNeil played parts of three seasons (2015, 2016, and 2018) with Binghamton during his path through the minor leagues. McNeil was originally drafted by the Mets in the 12th round in 2013 out of Long Beach State and he made his MLB debut in 2018.

LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the Reading Fightin Phils, 6-5, on Friday at FirstEnergy Stadium to tie the series, 2-2. **Nick Lorusso** hit a two-run double and **Alex Ramirez** hit a two-run single, while **Jett Williams** scored twice. **Joander Suarez** tossed 4.2 scoreless frames in the start, **Cam Foster** earned the win with 1.1 innings out of the bullpen and **Felipe De La Cruz** recorded the save with three innings of work in relief.

LO KNOWS: INF **Nick Lorusso** hit a two-run double and walked on Friday, which extended his hit streak to seven games. Over his seven-game hit streak, Lorusso is 8-for-23, slashing .348/.423/.652/1.075 with one home run, four doubles, five runs batted in, three runs scored, and two walks. Lorusso ranks among the Eastern League leaders with: 5 2B (T-2nd most), .567 SLG (7th), 6 XBH (T-3rd most), .931 OPS (10th), .300 AVG (11th).

MORE MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito**, the Mets No. 18 prospect (MLB Pipeline), bunted for a hit on Friday at Reading and is now riding an eight-game on-base streak, hitting .242 (8-for-33) with three doubles, two RBIs, seven runs, two walks, and five stolen bases over that span. The 21-year-old is 5-for-6 in stolen bases and currently has the second-most stolen bags in the Eastern League. Morabito was named the Mets Minor League Player of the Year last year and is in his first season at the Double-A level.

MR. MCLEAN: RHP **Nolan McLean**, the Mets No. 5 prospect & No. 2 pitching prospect is slated to make his third start of the season on Saturday night. McLean is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (6th in EL) & 14 strikeouts in 9.0 innings over his first two starts. The 23-year-old made his second start of the season on Sunday against Hartford and earned the victory after striking out six batters over five innings, while only allowing one run. He stranded the bases loaded in the fourth inning and stranded six runners in the game.

RUN, PONIES, RUN: Binghamton currently has the 2nd-most stolen bases (19) of any team in the Eastern League this season, behind Altoona and Somerset (22). **Nick Morabito** and **Alex Ramirez** are tied for the 2nd-most SB in the EL with five each.

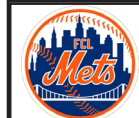

LAST START: Earned his first win of the season on Sunday against Hartford...Struck out six batters over five innings and only allowed one run, despite allowing four hits, three walks, and hitting two batters...McLean stranded the bases loaded in the third inning and stranded six runners total in the start.

2025 SEASON: Began the season with Double-A Binghamton.

LAST SEASON: Held a 3.00 ERA in final 12 starts of the season for Double-A Binghamton...Spun six scoreless frames and earned the win in his final start of the season on September 12 at Portland...Went 2-8 with a 4.19 ERA and an 80-to-32 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 81.2 innings across 18 starts for Double-A Binghamton, after being promoted on May 20...Played in 26 games as Binghamton's designated hitter and hit three home runs with eight runs batted in...Began the season with High-A Brooklyn and went 2-2 with a 2.57 ERA and 36 strikeouts in 28 innings across seven starts.

BACKGROUND: Drafted by the Mets in the third round (91st overall pick) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma State University...Originally drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the third round of the 2022 MLB Draft, but did not sign and returned to Oklahoma State for one more season...Played for three seasons as a two-way player (3B/OF/RHP) at Oklahoma State and played quarterback on the Cowboys football team in 2020...Two-time All-Big 12 selection as a utility player and relief pitcher...Semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award in 2022...Originally from Willow Spring, North Carolina, and was a standout baseball player and quarterback at Garner High School... Threw for 6,809 yards and 72 touchdowns in his high school football career.

Lorusso's 105 RBIs are the most for any Division I college baseball player since Billy Becher tallied 118 for New Mexico State in 2003... Set the Maryland program record for career runs batted in (175) in just two seasons...Holds the Maryland program record for RBIs in single-game (8), single-season (105) and career (175)...2023 Big Ten Tournament Most Outstanding Player, 2022 First Team All-Big Ten, and 2022 NCAA College Park Regional All-Tournament Team...Began collegiate career with three seasons (2019-21) at Villanova University... Big East Freshman of the Year in 2019...Was born in Carmel, New York, but grew up in Monroe, Connecticut, and went to Masuk HS.
