Last Night: Lugnuts 10, Loons 5. The Nuts won their 1701st game all-time, scoring five runs in the bottom of the eighth inning to break a 5-5 tie. **Max Schuemann** and **Shane Selman** each homered and a quartet of Lugnuts pitchers struck out 13 Loons in the winning cause.

Tonight: Coming off a win in the series opener, the Lugnuts play the second in a six-game series and 24 meetings overall this season against the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Tonight also marks the second game in a stretch of 12 home games in 13 days; the Lugnuts have won three straight home games.

Off the Field: It's Dog Days of Summer, with dogs welcome at the ballpark!

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland Athletics, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

This is the third year for Jesse and Adam partnering on the call in Lansing, following 2019 in the Midwest League and 2020 in the wood-bat, yellow-ball collegiate Lemonade League.

LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Meet the Boss: **Scott Steinmann** is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

Last Transaction: The Nuts have made only one roster move this year, placing starting pitcher **Jeff Criswell** on the Injured List and adding relief pitcher **Brandon Withers** from Extended Spring Training on May 12th. In the process, Withers became the 835th player in Lugnuts team history.

A Hail to Arms: The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.09 earned run average and has walked the fewest batters (56), struck out the most hitters (202) and recorded the best GO/AO ratio (1.41) in the league.

A Breath of Relief: The bullpen has been a strength for the Lugnuts, with a 2.89 ERA and 129 strikeouts (compared to only 29 walks) in 93 1/3 innings. **Aiden McIntyre** leads the High-A Central with nine appearances, while **Dalton Sawyer** is tied for second with eight appearances. **Jack Weisenburger**, meanwhile, has struck out 19 batters in just 8 2/3 innings.

The Bats Are ALIVE: After scoring a total of 12 runs in a six-game stretch from May 13-19 that left the Lugnuts with the fewest runs scored in the High-A Central, a dramatic turnaround has taken place. In the last five games, Lansing has scored 44 runs (by game: 12, 7, 7, 8, 10), with 13 home runs over that span, and now leads the league in runs scored (96), hits (156), total bases (267) and doubles (47), and ranks second in slugging (.415) and OPS (.743). The Nuts have also dropped down the most sacrifice bunts in the league (6).

Individual Excellence: Infielder **Max Schuemann** is second in the league in runs scored (18), steals (11), extra-base hits (10) and OPS (1.036); fourth in OBP (.429) and fifth in slugging (.607). Infielder **Jordan Díaz**, who homered in four of the first five games of the series at Fort Wayne, is tied for third in the circuit with 16 RBIs and tied for fourth with five roundtrippers.

Streaking: Outfielder **Michael Guldberg** enters play today on a 14-game on-base streak, hitting .321 (18-for-56) with four walks and two HBPs in that span. Infielder **Max Schuemann** enters on a 13-game on-base streak (15-for-50, .300, with four walks and five HBPs).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2018: The Lugnuts trailed the Fort Wayne TinCaps, 10-3, into the late-going, and weredown 10-5 going to the bottom of the 9th, but scored five runs to force extra innings, and then came back from an 11-10 deficit in the bottom of the 10th to walk off with a 12-11 win on a walk-off error on second baseman Estuary Ruiz.

Major League Lugnuts: Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher **Ty Tice** '18 and outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, with the duo making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals.

Familiar Settings: 14 of the 30 Lugnuts players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members **Scott Steinmann**, **Don Schulze** and **Anthony Phillips** all have experience in the league.

A Lineup of Starters: The Lugnuts have used nine starting pitchers this year, namely: **Seth Shuman** (May 4, May 15); **Brady Basso** (May 5, May 12); **Richard Guasch** (May 6, May 20); **Reid Birlingmair** (May 7, May 14, May 21); **Stevie Emanuels** (May 9, May 16, May 23); **Rafael Kelly** (May 11, May 18); **Jeff Criswell** (May 8); **Shohei Tomioka** (May 13); and **Colin Peluse** (May 22).

A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You: **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University, and **Jeff Criswell** (Portage Central H.S.) and **Jack Weisenburger** (Rockford H.S.) are the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverines to play in Lansing (following **Troy Miller**, **Jake Fox** and **Rich Hill**).

Finally: Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielders **Michael Guldberg** and **Jake Suddleson** are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. Outfielder **Jake Suddleson** and first baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (**Michael Guldberg**, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (**Brady Basso**, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (**Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger**, Michigan; **Dalton Sawyer**, Minnesota); and the SEC (**Cobie Vance**, Alabama, and **Ryan Gridley**, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (**Stevie Emanuels**, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. **Jake Suddleson** and **Patrick McColl** played together at Harvard, **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and **Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger** pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year.

Personal: Brady's last name is pronounced "bass-o," with 'bass' like the fish rather than the instrument... got married during the 2020-2021 offseason, spending 2020 hiatus wedding planning in addition to preparing for the 2021 season.

Last Outing: Started for a second consecutive Wednesday, May 19th, pitching at Fort Wayne... started well before running into difficulties in the 4th inning, finishing with 3 2/3 IP, 3 hits, 2 runs, 1 walk, 4 strikeouts on 57 pitches (38 strikes)... dominant 1st inning with a strikeout and two weak groundouts... three of the first four TinCaps attempted to bunt their way aboard, none successful... 1-2-3 2nd inning on three lineouts... sandwiched two strikeouts around an Ethan Skender double in a scoreless 3rd... Reinaldo Illaraza led off the 4th with a double, moved to third base on a groundout, followed by a walk to Agustin Ruiz; Tirso Ornelas followed with a grounder initially ruled a fielding error on first baseman Patrick McColl, then changed to an infield hit, as Illaraza scored; Basso struck out Justin Lopez looking before exiting... new reliever Shohei Tomioka allowed his inherited runner to score... Basso received no-decision in Lugnuts' 6-3 loss to the TinCaps.

Previously in 2021:

- Started Wednesday, May 12th at Dayton, and fired three scoreless innings, allowing two hits, striking out five... allowed leadoff single to Brian Rey in 1st inning and then picked him off, striking out Michael Siani and Quin Cotton to end the inning... gave up a two-out single to Victor Ruiz in the 2nd inning but retired Miguel Hernandez on a flyout to strand the runner at first... caused his own troubles in the 3rd inning, following a strikeout of Bren Spillane, allowed Jacob Hurtubise to reach on his own fielding error; after a passed ball by Drew Millas moved Hurtubise to second, committed a throwing error on a pickoff to advance Hurtubise to third; struck out Brian Rey and dispatched Michael Siani with a groundout to strand Hurtubise at third and end the inning and his outing... received no-decision in Lugnuts' 7-2 victory.

- Used in a piggyback role starting in front of Rafael Kelly on Wednesday, May 5th, the second game of the 2021 season... worked around a one-out single in the 1st inning, a two-out single in the 2nd and a one-out two-base error in the 3rd... ran into trouble in the 4th, allowing a leadoff triple to George Valera followed by consecutive singles, giving Lake County a 1-0 lead... recovered with a double-play grounder and a groundout, ending his outing: 4 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 2 K... charged with the loss as the Lugnuts fell, 3-1, to the Captains.

Raising Expectations: An MLB.com from Athletics MiLB camp by Jonathan Mayo on April 28, 2021, carried a bit of surprising news on a couple of breakout pitchers. One of them was today's starter. As Mayo wrote, "Brady Basso's role is changing. A lefty who signed for just \$75,000 as a 16th-round pick in the 2019 Draft out of Oklahoma State, Basso pitched almost exclusively in relief in college and threw well in that role in the Rookie-level Arizona League in 2019. Now that he's up to 95-96 mph with his fastball to go along with a curve that flashes plus and a work-in-progress changeup, he's going to get the chance to start." Melissa Lockard, writing for The Athletic on May 2, 2021, included Basso in her Lugnuts preview, writing, "Left-hander Brady Basso (2019, 16th round) opened a lot of eyes this spring with his fastball sitting at 95-97 mph."

Pro Debut: Brady pitched for Athletics Gold in the AZL after signing: 15 G, 1 GS, 1.64 ERA, 25 2/3 IP, 0 HR, 8 BB, 38 K... limited right-handed hitters to .194/.257/.313 in 74 PA, while lefties hit .250/.344/.286 in 32 PA... opposing base stealers were nabbed twice out of three attempts... made first professional start on 8/16/19, tossing three innings with 4 K's.

Draft Day: Basso was selected 494th overall in the 16th round of the 2019 draft from Oklahoma State... scout: Chris Reilly... signed for \$75,000... in the same round, two all-name players were drafted: the Tigers selected Kona Quiggle and the Blue Jays took Jackxarel Lebron... one of eight OSU Cowboys to be drafted in 2019... one of 10 Lugnuts drafted in 2019, including the 6th round (Seth Shuman), 7th round (Drew Millas), 9th round (Colin Peluse), 10th round (Patrick McColl), 19th round (Jared McDonald), 20th round (Jack Weisenburger), 21st round (Shane Selman), 26th round (Elvis Peralta, Jr.) and 33rd round (Charles Hall).

College Days: Brady was primarily a reliever at Oklahoma State (12 G, 2 GS as freshman; 18 G, 5 GS as sophomore; 14 G, 0 GS as a junior)... after a rough sophomore season (8.27 ERA), rebounded as a junior (1.64 ERA, 11.0 IP, 6 H, 16 K)... majored in finance in Stillwater with the intention of becoming a financial advisor after his playing career ends.

Let Your Babies Grow Up to be Cowboys: Oklahoma State players in MLB have included Allie Reynolds, Robin Ventura, Jeromy Burnitz, Pete Incaviglia, Mickey Tettleton, Mike Henneman, Doug Dascenzo, Andrew Heaney, Matt Hague and Jordy Mercer.

Baseball Runs in the Family: Brady's father, Mike, played in the minors for nine seasons in the San Diego Padres system, 1986-1994, rising as high as Triple-A... after retiring as a player, immediately began managing in 1995 at age 30, and managed in the Padres' org. from 1995-2000... joined the Toronto Blue Jays and managed in the Jays system in 2003-2006 and 2009... spent the next decade as an MLB scout before being let go by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2020.

Hometown: Hails from Pearland ("PAIR-land"), Texas, south of Houston... during senior year at Pearland H.S., posted 0.48 ERA, with 101 strikeouts in 57 innings... named All-District in football, averaging 29.9 yards per catch as a receiver with one primary route: go deep... also from Pearland H.S.: Kirk Dressendorfer, Clay Hensley and Robbie Weinhardt; Megan Thee Stallion spent her teen years living in Pearland.
