Home For the Week

The Fightin Phils return home for their third-to-last home series of the season, welcoming the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, for a six-game set. It is the first-of-six matchups between the teams this season, with all six at FirstEnergy Stadium. The teams met 12 times in 2025 with Chesapeake taking the season series 7-5. The teams split the series in Bowie and the Baysox took four-of-six in Reading last season.

The Comeback Kids

The Reading Fightin Phils (23-16, 53-55) erased a five-run deficit to defeat the Richmond Flying Squirrels 6-5 on Sunday, earning a series split and continuing their streak of splitting or winning every series in the second half. Richmond jumped out to a 5-0 lead through three innings, scoring on RBI hits from Charlie Szykowny, Maui Ahuna, Ty Hanchey, Trevor Cohen and Jose Astudillo. Reese Dutton settled in after the early damage, finishing with five runs allowed over five innings in a no-decision. Reading began its comeback in the seventh when Pedro León launched a solo home run, his 12th of the season and 15th in the Phillies organization. The Fightins then erupted for four runs in the eighth, with Aaron Escobar scoring on a wild pitch, Raider Tello delivering an RBI single and Caleb Ricketts scoring on a double play. León came through again with two outs, ripping an RBI double to score Bryan Rincon and tie the game at five. Reading completed the comeback in the ninth when Alex Binelas tripled and scored the go-ahead run on another wild pitch. Wen-Hui Pan earned the win with a scoreless eighth inning, while Estibenzon Jimenez recorded his third save with a scoreless ninth. León led Reading offensively, going 3-for-5 with a home run, double and two RBIs as the Fightin Phils maintained a one-game division lead with 30 games remaining.

Fightin For the Postseason

Entering play tonight, the Fightin Phils hold a one-game lead for first place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division and have the second-best record in the Eastern League since the season flipped to the season half on June 23. Reading holds a one-game lead on second place Portland and the teams meet one more time from Aug. 18-23 in Portland. This marks the latest in the season that the Fightin Phils have been in first place since they finished the 2019 second half with a 41-31 record, which clinched the second half division title that season.

Hammering Homers

Entering play tonight, the Fightin Phils have hit 140 home runs this season, which is 22 clear of their total for all of 2025 (118). Reading is second in the Eastern League in home runs, trailing only Somerset (152). The Fightin Phils are currently on pace for 179 home runs this season, which would be their most since slugging 185 in 2016. Alex Binelas leads Reading with 23 home runs, while Raylin Heredia (19) and Bryan Rincon (18) are shortly behind him. Five different Fightins hitters have slugged at least 10 homers, with Bryson Ware (13) and Pedro Leon (12) and being the other two. Before Binelas, the last time a Fightin Phil slugged 20 home runs in a season was Carlos De La Cruz (24) and Oliver Dunn (21) in 2023, which was also the last time Reading had five guys hit more than 10 home runs in a season.

One Year Turnaround

The Fightin Phils finished the 2025 season with a 55-81 record, which was the lowest win total under Al Pedrique (since 2023). Entering play tonight, Reading is just two wins shy of their total from last year and the 2025 team did not pick up its 53rd win until Sept. 10. Through 108 games in 2025, the Fightin Phils held a 44-64 record, so this year's team is currently nine wins ahead of the pace from the 2025 campaign.

The Century Mark

After Alex Binelas knocked his 100th base hit of the season on Sunday, giving Reading two players with over 100 base hits this season, with Raylin Heredia being the other (121). Reading also had two players log over 100 hits in 2025 as Felix Reyes knocked 123 base hits and Aidan Miller followed with 105. Heredia currently ranks second in the Eastern League in hits, trailing Hartford's Andy Perez by two. Binelas is eighth in the league in hits.

Mr. Doubles

Raylin Heredia knocked his 30th double of the season on Sunday, making it the second-straight season that a R-Phil had over 30 doubles, as Felix Reyes had 34 in 2025. The last time Reading had a player with over 30 doubles in back-to-back seasons was Brock Stassis (32) in 2015 and Dylan Cozens (38) in 2016. Heredia is the 24th R-Phil in franchise history to have over 30 doubles in a single-season and currently ranks as tied for the 21st most doubles in a single-season in team history. Greg Jacobs (2007) and David Doster (1995) hold the franchise record in single-season doubles with 39. Heredia currently leads the Eastern League in doubles, is tied for first in Double-A and tied for eighth amongst all full-season minor league players.

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 11, 1913: At Reading, Maikel Franco goes 3-for-4, scores twice and hits the Fightin Phils' only grand slam of the season in a 14-5 pasting of New Britain. All nine Reading starters collect at least one of the team's 16 hits and all but Justin Dalles score at least once.

Checking On Chesapeake

The Baysox enter tonight with a 51-56 overall record and 22-17 mark in the second half, which is four games back of first place Erie in the Eastern League's Southwest Division. Chesapeake was at home last week against Harrisburg, taking four-of-seven games. Following this week, the Baysox return home and host Richmond for a six-game series. The Baysox roster features eight of the Orioles' top-30 prospects: Anthony Eyanson (1), Joseph Dzierwa (4), Wehiwa Aloy (5), Aron Estrada (9), Caden Hunter (15), Ethan Anderson (16), Braxton Bragg (18) and Patrick Reilly (29).

On the Bump for the Baysox

Righty, and Orioles' No. 15 prospect, Caden Hunter makes his third Double-A start tonight. He has allowed two-earned runs over 13 innings, with 20 strikeouts. Hunter allowed two runs over six innings, with 10 strikeouts against Harrisburg on Aug. 4. He has split his first pro season between Delmarva (A) and Frederick (A+) and has posted a combined 1.44 ERA (13 ER, 81.0 IP) over 18 appearances/16 starts, along with 122 strikeouts (13.56 SO/90 IP). The 22-year old was drafted by the Orioles in the sixth round of the 2025 draft out of the University of Southern California.
