#### RIDERS SHUTOUT NATURALS IN WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders took a six-run lead after three innings and held the Northwest Arkansas Naturals to two hits in a 6-0 victory on Saturday night at Riders Field. Frisco (34-33, 72-63) used four pitchers to toss a two-hitter, starting with four hitless innings by **Daniel Missaki**. The righthander struck out seven and walked two. Thomas Ireland (1-0) then pitched three innings with one hit to collect the win. He allowed a single to the first batter he faced but then recorded a double play. **Joey Danielson** tossed a hitless eighth inning and **Willian Bormie** closed out the game in the ninth, allowing a two-out double but recording the final out on the next batter. Frisco now leads the series four games to one with Northwest Arkansas (33-35, 66-71). The Riders scored two runs in the first inning. **Cam Cauley** doubled on the first pitch of the first inning and scored after singles by **Frainyer Chavez** and **Sebastian Walcott. Keith Jones II** brought in a run on a fielder's choice to give the Riders a 2-0 margin. **Marcus Smith** homered to right field in the second inning, putting Frisco ahead 3-0. The Riders tacked on three more runs in the third, using an RBI single from Jones II and a two-RBI double by Cauley. **Sebastian Walcott** singled for a second time in the fourth inning and went 2-for-4 in the game. Along with Cauley's two doubles and Chavez's single and double, the top three batters in the Riders' order combined for six hits. Hunter Williams (5-6) started for the Naturals and took the loss, allowing eight hits and six runs over three innings.

Frainyer Chavez has been swinging a hot bat for the RoughRiders. Over his last 32 games (since August 7th), he is hitting .377 (46-for-122), 476/.484/.960 with seven doubles, two home runs, 14 RBIs, 25 runs, 23 walks and 22 strikeouts. On an 12-game hitting streak, he is batting .417 (20-for-48) with a 1.074 OPS. On Wednesday, he was named Texas Rangers Minor League Hitter of the Month, batting .337/.462/.407/.869 over the month with 19 walks to 17 strikeouts over his 24 games.

DAVALILLO WINS TEXAS LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE MONTH:
Frisco RoughRiders starting pitcher David Davalillo was named July Texas League Pitcher of the Month, Minor League Baseball announced on Thursday. The No. 7 prospect in the Rangers organization made five starts over the month, going 1-1 with a 1.82 ERA. Over his 24.2 innings, he struck out 23 while walking eight and surrendering only 17 hits. Opponents hit .191 against him and he totaled a 1.01 WHIP. The highlight of his month came against Midland on August 14th when he poured in 7.0 shutout innings, striking out one batter and ceding only three hits in a 4-1 Frisco win.

#### CAULEY'S HISTORIC NIGHT LEADS TO PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARD:

The RoughRiders witnessed an incredible night from **Cam Cauley** against the Hooks on August 19th, when he tied a franchise record with three home runs. He tied his career-best with four RBIs as well. It was the fifth time in franchise history that a RoughRiders player has hit three home runs in a game and the fifth time in Double-A this season that a player hit three home runs in a game. He followed it up with another home run on the 21st, giving him four home runs in the first two games of the series. In three games, he is 7-for-11 and has increased his season OPS from .696 to .742.

#### ROTATION ROTATING:

With the RoughRiders' promotions of **Trey Supak** and **Ben Anderson** and the trade of **Mitch Bratt**, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (**Winston Santos**).

#### THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.982) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (83). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .984 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A.

#### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

#### WALLY'S WORLD:

WALLY'S WORLD:
Rangers top prospect Sebastian Walcott has been incredible for a 19-year-old in Double-A. This season, his walk rate of 12.4 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 20.5 percent, a career low. By stealing his 30th base on September 4th, he joined an exclusive group as one of the only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A, joining Elvis Andrus (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott became the first Texas League teenager to have double-digit homers and 30-plus steals since Roberto Alomar in 1987 (12 Hz 43 SR with Wichita) Walcott participated in the Eutures Game for the second season in a (12 HR, 43 SB with Wichita). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively. Walcott collected a walk-off single on Tuesday.
