Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, play a matinee opener in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, sending right-hander **Stevie Emanuels**, coming off five scoreless innings of one-hit, seven-K ball against Dayton, against Loons lefty **Lael Lockhart**, who allowed one earned run in five innings, whiffing six, in his last start at Lake County. This is the first of 24 meetings between the Lugnuts and Loons this season.

Last Series: The Lugnuts wrapped up a 7-5 homestand – comprising winning four of six against West Michigan and splitting a six-game set against first-place Dayton – with a 10-8 Sunday loss to the Dragons. In the loss, **Tyler Soderstrom** crushed a pair of home runs, notching his second two-HR game of the year. The Dragons received roundtrippers from **Jonathan Willems** and **Elly De La Cruz** in the win.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Loons through Sunday, take a day off on May 23, and then continue this 12-game, 13-day homestand with a six-game series at the Beloit Sky Carp. The Lugnuts' next home game is on May 31, opening a six-game series with the Cedar Rapids Kernels.

May Power: With two more homers Sunday, both supplied by **Tyler Soderstrom**, the Lugnuts have slugged 22 roundtrippers in 13 games in May after hitting 11 homers in 20 freezing games in April. Those 22 home runs this month lead the MWL, as does the team's .481 slugging pct.

Putting the Home in Home Run: The Lugnuts have hit 27 longballs in their 21 home games, as compared to six home runs in 12 games on the road. All six of **Brett Harris's** and **Austin Beck's** team-leading home run totals have come in Michigan's state capital.

Among the MWL Leaders: 3B **Brett Harris** ranks first in the Midwest League in OBP (.431), third in slugging (.600) and third in OPS (1.031). OF **Lawrence Butler** is tied for fifth in the Midwest League with 20 walks, INF **Euribiel Angeles** is fourth with 36 hits, starter **Jeff Criswell** is fifth with a 0.83 WHIP, and reliever **Angello Infante** is tied for second with 12 appearances and tied for third with five saves. Criswell owns the only shutout in the league thus far, seven-inning one-hitter at Lake County.

As a Team: The Lugnuts are the hardest offense to strike out in the MWL (280 K's) while ranking second in team batting average (.249), third in hits (262), third in OBP (.334) and fourth in slugging percentage (.400).

Athletics Farm Spotlight:

• **Double-A Midland:** Former EMU Eagle **Max Schuemann** broke out with the Lugnuts last year and has continued to excel in Midland this year. On Sunday, Schuemann went 3-for-5 and is now slashing .381/.490/.513 with 43 hits and 22 walks in 30 games for the RockHounds.

166 Major League Nuts...: Pitcher **Danny Young** (2016 in Lansing) debuted for the Seattle Mariners on May 9 with 2 1/3 scoreless innings in relief, becoming the 166th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the fifth this year, joining A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson** and infielder **Christian Lopes** and Toronto utilityman **Vinny Capra**.

Talent Rich: The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in **Tyler Soderstrom**, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of seven Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 9) and **Euribiel Angeles** (No. 10), starting pitcher **Joey Estes** (No. 15), first baseman/outfielder **Lawrence Butler** (No. 17), pitcher **Jeff Criswell** (No. 18) and pitcher **Grant Holman** (No. 30).

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

Personal: Born in Seattle... played three years in Little League for, coincidentally, the A's, and still has his old A's baseball cap... younger brother, Josh, is currently a pitcher at Washington, standing 6'3... uncle, Jake, also played baseball for Washington.

Hometown: Bellevue is the third largest city in the Seattle metropolitan area... "belle vue" in French means "beautiful view"; it's situated across Lake Washington from Seattle... Amazon was founded in Bellevue in Jeff Bezos's garage on July 5, 1994... many companies are headquartered in Bellevue, notably T-Mobile USA, the North American headquarters for Pokémon, QFC, Expedia Group, Coinstar and Eddie Bauer... Russell Wilson and Ciara are currently seeking to sell their house in Bellevue (with amazing tree hosue) for \$36 million.

Glory Days: Attended Interlake High School... rated by Baseball Northwest as Washington's No. 1 baseball recruit in the Class of 2017... rated by Perfect Game as Washington's No. 4 right-handed pitcher... Interlake's alumni includes John Olerud, Larry Andersen, Jim Mora Jr., and actor Timothy Omundson.

Life as a Huskie: Ascended from setup man to closer to ace starting pitcher from freshman to junior year at Washington... broke the Washington freshman record with 34 relief appearances, tied for second most in school history for a single season; led all freshmen in the Pac-12 in appearances... also led Washington as a freshman in wins (8-2, 4.37, 45 1/3 IP, 2 HR, 28 BB, 32 K)... followed up a sophomore in 2019 with 31 appearances (2.35 ERA, 6 saves, 53 2/3, 3 HR, 22 BB, 65 K)... made four starts as a junior, including 13-K, 6-IP gem vs. Fresno State, before season was shut down (0.79, 22 2/3 IP, 2 ER, 0 HR, 9 BB, Pac-12 leading 38 K)... 15.1 K/9.0-IP ranked 16th in the country... named a 2020 3rd Team All-American by The Collegiate Baseball.

2021 Professional Debut: Opened season as the Lugnugs' Sunday starter... excelled in pro debut, May 9 vs. Lake County: 4 1/3 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 5 K... followed up five two-hit scoreless innings at Dayton, May 16... season curtailed due to injury, however, after four starts in May and three appearances in June... set Lugnugs franchise single-game record in last appearance, June 20 vs. Great Lakes, allowing four home runs: two apiece by Andy Pages and Deacon Liput in back-to-back innings... made one scoreless appearance in Arizona Complex League before season's end.

2022 - Back in Lansing: Piggybacked Jeff Criswell in season debut, Sunday, April 10, striking out six Lake County Captains in three innings... earned win as Lugnugs topped Caps, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep... made first start of the year in the fourth game of the series at West Michigan, pitched scoreless 1st and 2nd inning and recorded two outs into the 4th, but in between, gave up five runs on six hits in the 3rd inning, including doubles by Parker Meadows, Colt Keith and Jake Holton and a triple by Andrew Navigato... that supplied the lion's share of the Whitecaps' offense in a 6-3 victory over Lansing... April 23 vs. Fort Wayne, Game 2: tied his own franchise single-game record, giving up four home runs to the TinCaps (Corey Rosier leading off the game, Robert Hassell III hit two, Ripken Reyes hit one) in six innings in Lugnugs' 6-2 defeat.

Last Start: Dominated the Dayton Dragons with five scoreless innings... four of the five were perfect, with a double (Justice Thompson) and two walks allowed in the third inning before he bore down and stranded the bases loaded... tied career high with seven strikeouts... Lugnugs won comfortably against the first-place Dragons, 6-1.
