TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express visit the Pacific Northwest for the first time since 2017 on Thursday night to open a six-game series against the Tacoma Rainiers. E-Train RHP Drew Anderson is scheduled to get the start up against Rainiers RHP Jaime Schultz. First pitch at Cheney Stadium is set for 9:05 p.m. CT.

LAST TIME OUT

The Round Rock Express capped off a series victory over the rival Sugar Land Skeeters with an 8-5 victory in Tuesday afternoon's finale at Dell Diamond. After Skeeters RF Bryan De La Cruz hit a solo home run to lead off the contest, the Express dropped a four-spot on rehabbing Houston Astros RHP Jake Odorizzi in the second, highlighted by a three-run Curtis Terry homer and an RBI groundout courtesy of 3B Yonny Hernandez. De La Cruz hit his second solo home run of the night in the third to pull Sugar Land to within 4-2. Round Rock 2B Charles Leblanc recorded an RBI single in the fourth before RF Jason Martin hit a solo homer of his own in the fifth. The Skeeters attempted a rally in the sixth, plating a trio of runs to trim the gap to 6-5. However, the E-Train put the game away for good in the sixth as Leblanc tripled before scoring on another Hernandez groundout. Terry added one final insurance run in the eighth to extend the final score to 8-5.

A SECOND START

Round Rock RHP Drew Anderson is set to make his second straight start in tonight's series opener against Tacoma. The righty posted a 3.2-inning relief appearance on May 8 against Oklahoma City before his first start of the season on May 14 against Sugar Land, allowing three runs in 4.0 innings.

SCARY TERRY

Express 1B Curtis Terry drove in four runs in Tuesday's victory, including a three-run homer in the second inning that set the tone for the rest of the contest. The performance matched his second-most RBI in a game in his career. Terry's all-time high is six, set back on April 5, 2019 with Class-A Hickory. The slugging first baseman has posted four other four-RBI games in his career.

BACK WITH A BANG

E-Train LHP James Jones earned the victory in Tuesday night's contest thanks to a perfect 1-2-3 eighth inning of relief. The outing marked Jones' first time on the mound in a Round Rock uniform since August 9, 2018.

J-MART GOES BACK-TO-BACK

For the second time this season, Round Rock RF Jason Martin has homered in consecutive games. The outfielder blasted back-to-back jacks on May 7 and May 9 against Oklahoma City before accomplishing the feat again on May 17 and May 18 against Sugar Land. Martin has tallied four homers on the year to go along with 10 RBI.

BIG LEAGUERS? NO BIGGIE!

The Express earned victories over rehabbing Houston Astros pitchers in consecutive days last week, defeating LHP Framber Valdez 6-4 in game one of Monday's doubleheader before sending RHP Jake Odorizzi home with an 8-5 loss on Tuesday.

UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY...

The Round Rock Express are returning to Tacoma for the first time since the 2017 season on Thursday night. The Rainiers played at Dell Diamond in both 2018 and 2019 before the 2020 season was shelved. Tacoma leads the all-time series with Round Rock 37-22, including a 19-8 record in games played at Cheney Stadium.

BUT STILL A REUNION

Three members of the E-Train have previously suited up for the Rainiers in their careers, RHP Sam Gaviglio (2015-2017), LHP James Jones (2013-2015) and C John Hicks (2014-2015).

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Eleven members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021, RHP Jason Bahr, OF Carl Chester, RHP Demarcus Evans, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, INF Charles Leblanc, RHP Ryder Ryan, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, OF Leody Taveras and RHP Collin Wiles. C Blake Grant-Parks and C Jack Kruger are also seeking their Triple-A debuts with the Express. Interestingly enough, Evans, Tejeda and Taveras all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 16 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Nevada, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, South Carolina, Texas, Utah and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Five different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 25 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, INF Anderson Tejeda and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
