ABOUT SUNDAY: Despite an early 3-0 lead on a first-inning 1B **JT Schwartz** three-run home run, Wilmington rallied back for five unanswered runs and eight shutout innings from the bullpen to beat Brooklyn in the series finale 5-3 and a series split four games apiece. RHP **Luis Moreno** allowed five runs over 4 2/3 innings in the loss, but LHP **Cam Opp** tossed 3 1/3 innings scoreless to finish the game. Aside from Schwartz, OF **Tanner Murphy** and OF **Rowdey Jordan** each collected hits.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs in Coney Island, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 26 home runs in the past 29 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

FIRST HALF CLOSING: The first half of the season ends Thursday, June 23 during the six-game series with the Jersey Shore BlueClaws. The second half begins on Friday, June 24th. Aberdeen clinched the first half division title on Wednesday night, beating Jersey Shore. The first half division winners in the North and the South clinch a playoff berth against the winners of the second half. In case of a repeat winner at the top of the division, the team in that division with the best full season record is awarded the playoff spot.

JT JOLTING!: 1B **JT Schwartz** clobbered a three-run home run on Sunday at Wilmington, his second of the season. During June, Schwartz is hitting .349 with a .397 on-base percentage. The No. 19 New York Mets prospect, according to MLB Pipeline, is slugging .460 after slugging just .317 in May and .362 in April. During this month, Schwartz has hits in 13 of 18 games.

BYE-BYE BMAC: OF **Brandon McIlwain** earned a

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia farm system returns to Maimonides Park for the first time since the opening home series of the year April 12-17. This season, the Cyclones have won eight of the 12 games in the series. Jersey Shore hosts nine of Philly's Top 30 prospects, including No. 1 and No. 2 prospects RHP Andrew Painter and RHP Mick Abel. OF Johan Rojas is the No. 4 prospect in the org.

promotion to Double-A Binghamton Saturday. Prior to his call-up, he had been on base in 21 of his past 23 games and 14 straight. Since April 30th, McIlwain was hitting .330 with a .430 OBP in 35 games.

ARMS STRONG: Brooklyn arms have posted a 3.65 earned run average in 20 games with 10 home runs, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

GRRR-ERRERA: Watertown, CT native OF **Justin Guerrero**, who attended Fairfield University, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie on June 10. Guerrero earned All-MAAC First Team honors and Fairfield University Male Athlete of the Year in 2021 before being selected by the Mets in the 20th round.

ROUGH N' ROWDEY: OF **Rowdey Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State leads the team with 74 total bases and 16 doubles is tied with **C Francisco Alvarez** atop the entire Mets organization.

PALMER'S POP: Brooklyn native OF **Jaylen Palmer**, the team's top prospect according to *MLB Pipeline* (No. 14), leads the club with six home runs, including a grand slam to win the game last Sunday against Aberdeen. His career high is seven home runs which game during his second professional season in 2019, playing with Rookie-level Kingsport.

ST LUCIE STALWART: Seymour began his season with Low-A St. Lucie, tossing four consecutive scoreless outings. He finished his Florida State League experience with a victory over the Yankees affiliate in Tampa, striking out a career-high eight batters over 5 1/3 innings.

K-STATE: The 6-foot-5 righty transferred to Kansas State after one year at Dartmouth, sitting for the 2019 season due to NCAA transfer rules before pitching for two seasons in the Big 12 Conference.

GOOD COMPANY: Seymour's college teammate at Kansas State, RHP Jordan Wicks, was selected 21st overall by the Chicago Cubs and signed for \$3.1 million.

DYNAMIC DAD: Carson's father Brian was a professional tri-athlete (swimming, biking, running), finishing the Hawaii Ironman competition four times.

FROM MANHATTAN (KS) TO QUEENS: Seymour was selected in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets and signed for \$291K. The last time the Mets selected a player directly from Kansas State, they drafted 2013 Brooklyn Cyclones OF Jared King who reached as high as Double-A Binghamton.
