Today: It's a Dog Days of Summer, with dogs welcome to the ballpark, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the second game in a six-game series against the Fort Wayne TinCaps, High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. This is also the second game in a stretch of 12 home games in 13 days for the Nuts.

Last Night: TinCaps 15, Locos 14. The first Locos game of the year truly was loco. 18-year-old **Leo De Vries** went 5-for-5 with a single, double, triple, two home runs, a sacrifice fly and eight runs batted in, achieving the third cycle in Fort Wayne TinCaps franchise history on a tie-breaking, two-out, two-run triple in the 9th. In the loss, **Cole Conn** drew two walks, singled, doubled and homered, driving in four runs, and **Tommy White** singled, doubled and crushed his first homer of the year.

LUG•NOTES

What About Today? The last two home games have had a combined 52 runs and 60 base hits: a 12-11 12-inning victory on April 13 against Great Lakes (in which the Nuts rallied for six runs in the bottom of the ninth to force extras, then rallied from a two-run deficit in the 12th to walk off on a Jared Dickey two-run single), followed by last night's 15-14 Fort Wayne victory.

Double Trouble: The TinCaps only collected one double last night, notched by **Leo De Vries** in the third inning on his way to the cycle. Lansing, conversely, knocked a season-high eight doubles, including two by **T.J. Schofield-Sam**. Entering the day, Lansing's 22 doubles had ranked among the lowest in the MWL; the Nuts' 30 doubles today rank 5th in the 12-team league, and **Tommy White's** six doubles are tied for 3rd.

Home Cooking: The Lugnuts boast the best home offense in Minor League Baseball, leading the 119 other MiLB teams in home batting average (.323) and OBP (.448), while walking (50) more than they strike out (44).

All Things Considered: Lansing's offense doesn't just rank 1st in the Midwest League with a .277 overall team batting average, the Nuts are 5th in all of Minor League Baseball behind four Pacific Coast League squads. The Lugnuts' .394 team on-base percentage is 3rd in the Minors, trailing only the Carolina Mudcats and Modesto Nuts.

Streaking: **Nate Nankil** has reached base in 13 straight games, while **Clark Elliott** has reached base in 12 straight. **Rodney Green, Jr.'s** 12-game on-base streak ended last night. He was the only hitter out of the 18 combined batsmen between the two teams to not collect at least one base hit.

Heating Up: Third baseman **Tommy White** opened the season 0-for-11 at Fort Wayne and 4-for-24 vs. Great Lakes. Since then, White is batting .448 (13-for-29) with four doubles and a home run. He has scored three runs twice in the last four games, pushing him into a tie for 5th in the Midwest League with 12 runs scored.

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the A's second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 19. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 29.

DK at the Helm: The 19th manager in Lugnuts history is **Darryl Kennedy**, entering his second year in the A's organization. Kennedy distinguished himself as a catcher at Manatee Community College before starring at the University of North Florida and was named an NCAA All-American in 1991 en route to North Florida's Hall of Fame, inducted in 2017. Kennedy played in the Minor Leagues for seven seasons, including parts of four seasons in Triple-A. Following his 1997 retirement, he immediately began managing, leading the Gulf Coast League Rangers to the 1998 GCL Championship. Kennedy won a second title with the GCL Rangers in 2000, moving on to stops in the Florida State League, Northwest League and Texas League through 2006. Upon joining the Royals' organization, Kennedy managed in the Appalachian League, Carolina League, Pioneer League, Arizona League and Texas League through 2020. He served as bench coach for the KBO's Hanwha Eagles from 2021 through 2023 before joining the A's.

History vs. Fort Wayne

The Lugs are 220-237 vs. the TinCaps, 116-101 in Lansing, 104-136 at The Fort. Last year: 8-10, 4-5 at Fort Wayne.

2019 was the last time the Nuts opened in FW, splitting a four-game home-and-home series. Before that: 2009 to open Parkview Field, a three-game TinCaps sweep.

APRIL 23RD IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2006: In four hours and 50 minutes, the Lugnuts outlasted the Beloit Snappers at Olds Park, 4-3, in 17 innings, thanks to Joey Metropoulos two-out RBI single. The score was tied 1-1 at the end of nine innings, with each team scoring runs in the 12th and 13th innings (including a two-out game-tying Anthony Garibaldi HR in the bottom of the 13th). Aaron Tressler fired the final five innings, allowing one run, to earn the victory.

2011: The Lugnuts and West Michigan Whitecaps combined to set a professional baseball record with 10 double plays, six by Lansing and four by West Michigan. The Nuts won, 6-1, wrapping up the victory when Rob Brantly lined into an unassisted double play to 1B K.C. Hobson.

2014: Down 4-0 in the 4th, D.J. Davis delivered a three-run triple and scored the tying run on a Mitch Nay single. In the 7th, he supplied an RBI groundout. And in the bottom of the 9th, he knocked a walk-off RBI single. In all, a 6-5 win, Davis drove in five and scored the sixth for Lansing.

Last Game: Set a new career high with eight strikeouts, achieved in 4 2/3 innings in a no-decision at Wisconsin; allowed one run on three hits and four walks on 87 pitches... removed with two runners aboard, both stranded by Jake Pfenngs... Lansing was trailing 1-0 entering the 8th before rallying for three runs and a 3-1 victory.

In a Nutshell: Making his Lugnuts debut this season... only native Cuban on the team... noted for mid-90s fastball / split-changeup combo... one of three pitchers on the roster standing at least 6-foot-6 or taller (Kyle Robinson, Jake Pfenngs)... looking to become second ever Major Leaguer named Yunior (joining Santo Domingo native Yunior Marte, who spent last season in the Phillies' pen).

Hometown Hero: Though born in La Habana, Yunior grew up in Santiago de Cuba, which also produced such notable Major Leaguers as Bárbaro Garbey, Adeiny Hechavarría and Orestes Destrade.

Dominating in Cuba: Yunior pitched three seasons for Avispas ("Wasps") de Santiago de Cuba in the Cuban National Series, from 2018-2021... in 2019-20, at age 19, posted remarkable line: 0.00 ERA, 9 saves, 22 scoreless innings, 8 hits, 16 walks (two intentional) and 24 strikeouts... teammate: Oscar Colás, now with the White Sox... followed up in 2020-21: 2.11 ERA, league-leading 14 saves, 38 1/3 IP, 32 hits, 10 runs (9 earned), 25 walks, 45 strikeouts.

2023 - Joining the A's: Signed with the Athletics for \$100,000 three days before the end of the international signing period on May 8, 2023... made his pro debut with the Arizona Complex A's on June 5, allowing two runs (one earned) in four innings with no walks and four strikeouts against D-Backs Black... moved up to Stockton on June 17 and finished the season with 19 appearances out of the Ports' pen.

2024 - Back to Stockton: Pitched in relief for the Ports on Opening Day, April 5, and pitched a scoreless sixth before allowing three runs in the seventh inning, suffering the loss in a 7-2 defeat to Modesto... worked as a piggybacker throughout the year, alternating starts and relief appearances... tossed career five innings on four different occasions, allowing one run or fewer each time; curiously, these gems happened once a month - April 18, May 23, June 15, July 31... struck out seven Lake Elsinore Ports in three hitless innings, August 6, setting pro high... vs. lefties: .285/.356/.468, 6 HR... vs. righties: .255/.339/.418... base-stealers went 14-for-16 in successful attempts.
