THAT WAS SOMETHING: After losing by 12 runs last night - the largest margin of defeat this season - the FredNats will look to bounce back tonight on Thirsty Thursday against the Delmarva Shorebirds - Carolina League affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Tonight's pitching matchup is a good one, with the FredNats sending Marc Davis to the mound. Davis's recent dominance is noted below, and he will face another former LSU Tiger in lefty Riley Cooper. Last time Cooper pitched in this ballpark, he gave the game-tying home run to Cristhian Vaquero in the 7th inning in a game the FredNats ended up winning in walk-off fashion. FXBG has already beaten one former LSU pitcher in this series, defeating Blake Money on Tuesday night.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Delmarva had its best offensive night of the season, scoring 17 runs on 18 hits, and the Shorebirds cruised to a 17-5 victory on Goodwill Wednesday. Delmarva went a whopping 8-for-11 with runners in scoring position, and Jake Cunningham, Anderson De Los Santos and Leandro Arias all hits homers, with Arias' grand slam coming in the 9th inning off a position player. Cristhian Vaquero homered for the FredNats, and Everett Cooper III hit a two-run single.

COMPLETE DOMINATION: The FredNats are 15-2 this year against Delmarva, and one game under .500 against the rest of the Carolina League. In 16 games this year against the Shorebirds, FXBG has outscored Delmarva 104-56 (17 of the 56 came in last night's game) and has swept two out of the three series the teams have played this year, including the second six-game series sweep in franchise history.

HE'S BACK: Brandon Pimentel has regained the Carolina League lead in RBIs, and saw a six-game RBI streak ended last night after he picked up his 62nd of the year in the series opener. He's led the league in RBI since Opening Weekend, and has regained the league lead after losing it for a couple days last home stand.

DOMINANT STARTS: After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last month. Since June 11, FredNat starters have logged 154.1 innings and allowed just 33 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.92. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. In the last full six-game series alone, FredNat starters pitched 16.1 scoreless innings, allowing a total of seven hits.

FORTY ONE AND ONE: Last Tuesday's loss was the first time all season that the FredNats lost a game when leading after seven innings, and both doubleheader sweeps have pushed the team's record in that scenario to 41-1. FXBG's loss in Friday night's game was the first time all season the team has blown a lead after eight innings.

DOMINANT DAVIS: In his return season from Tommy John surgery that wiped out his entire 2023 campaign, Marc Davis is making the most of his time in Fredericksburg. After five more innings on Friday night allowing no earned runs, he's now allowed just one earned run in his last five starts. Covering 25 innings in that time frame, his ERA is 0.36, the opponents are hitting just .143 against him, and his WHIP is an excellent 0.88. Davis also has 25 strikeouts in that span.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 40-7 this season when scoring first, including 34 out of the last 36 wins. FXBG was beaten for the first time in nearly a month when scoring first in Salem last weekend.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 193-160 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Frelich, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Frelich begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

TONIGHT'S START: Marc Davis is set to make his 17th start of 2024, in his return to the mound from Tommy John Surgery in 2022.

Davis had a promising start to his professional career, as the right-hander posted a 3.97 ERA out of the bullpen in '22, while earning a Carolina League Pitcher of the Week nod as well.

JUCO BANDIT: Davis played three seasons at Florida Southwestern State, a junior college located in Fort Myers, FL. With the Buccaneers, Marc worked primarily as a reliever; 34 of his 44 total appearances came out of the bullpen. He recorded a stellar 3.14 ERA to go along with a 1.41 WHIP for his collegiate career, while striking out a whopping 14.55 batters per nine innings.

TWO-WAY TALENT: Davis was recruited as a two-way player out of South Gwinnett High School. He impressed scouts at the plate on the travel circuit, with exit velocities north of 90 MPH as a teenager, and displayed excellent range as a shortstop. Of course, he also possessed a rocket arm, and ultimately chose to focus on the mound.

AGAINST THE 'BIRDS: Marc Davis has seen Delmarva three times this season, and has allowed seven earned runs in 11 innings for an ERA of 5.73. Most recently though, he gave up just one run in five frames on July 4th.

LAST TIME OUT: Davis gave up a pair of unearned runs last week against Salem, in a no-decision. He allowed just two base hits while striking out seven Sox across five innings.
