"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

SAINTS STUNNED IN DOUBLEHEADER SWEEP BY I-CUBS: The St. Paul Saints jumped out to a 7-0 lead, scoring four runs in the first inning off former Minnesota Twin Kenta Maeda. They tacked on three more in the fourth inning. From there, it was all I-Cubs as they scored nine unanswered to take a 9-7 lead going into the ninth. Will Holland drove home two in the top of the ninth to tie the game up. In the bottom of the ninth, however, a bases loaded RBI single by Owen Caissie sent the Saints to a 10-9 defeat, their fifth straight loss.

IT'S MCCRUSHER TIME: The time has finally come for Carson "McCrusher" McCusker to have the lights shine bright on his game. After an incredible 38 game start to the season in which he slashed .350/.412/.650, McCusker had his contract selected by the Minnesota Twins. This is the first time he's been called up to the Major Leagues in his career. He went undrafted out of Oklahoma State and 145 games with the Tri-City Valley Cats (Independent, Frontier League) from 2021-23 before the Minnesota Twins purchased his contract. His 94.1 mph exit velocity is the second highest in Minor League Baseball. He was among the Top 10 in eight different offensive categories at the time of his call up. McCusker is the third Saints player to get called up to the Twins for the first time in their career this season joining Luke Keaschall and Ryan Fitzgerald.

APPARENTLY THERE ARE THINGS IN LIFE THAT ARE FREE: The St. Paul Saints pitchers walked a season high 12 I-Cubs on Saturday night. The 12 walks were tied for the third most in franchise history, and tied for the second most in a nine inning game. They walked a franchise record 14 on August 28, 2021 @ Toledo, a game that went 14 innings. The only other nine inning game in which they walked more came on June 13, 2023 when they walked 13 @ Louisville. They also walked 12 on June 21, 2024 vs. Toledo.

A BEAR OF A LINEUP: The St. Paul Saints will be ecstatic when they can put the I-Cubs in their rearview mirror after this week. The Saints have faced five different teams this season and their ERA is dramatically higher against the I-Cubs than any of the other four teams. Below is the Saints ERA against all five teams they have faced:

PITCHING PARTICULARS: The Saints recent struggles on the mound continued as they've yielded 37 runs across the last 31.1 innings of baseball in Des Moines. Since the start of May, St. Paul pitching has produced a 6.90 ERA (93 ER, 121.1 IP), the second-worst mark in Minor League Baseball only ahead of the Rochester Red Wings (7.19) since the turn of the calendar page. Since the start of May, the Saints' opponents have produced an OPS of .946, the highest allowed by a pitching staff in minor league baseball among all 120 full-season teams since the beginning of May. Despite the pitching struggles, the Saints' team OPS of .889 is the second-highest in MiLB in May.

CHICKS DIG THE LONGBALL: After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the second-fewest in the International League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 42 round-trippers in their last 29 games since April 14, which ranked tied for the most in the minors in that stretch, with the Sugar Land Skeeters. St. Paul had left the yard at least once in eight straight games, a season-long streak for the club, until going homerless on Tuesday and Wednesday this week in Iowa.

HEY MICKEY, YOU'RE SO FINE: Saints utility man Mickey Gasper was named the International League Player of the Week for the previous week. After being optioned by the Twins for the second time this year on May 5, Gasper hit .478 (11-23) with two doubles, four homers, and six RBI in six games last week vs Buffalo. His 11 total hits and 4 homers were both tied for the most in minor league baseball last week and his .571 OBP, 1.087 SLG%, and 1.658 OPS were all the highest among hitters with at least 20 AB in MiLB last week. The New Hampshire native now has seven homers in 15 games in a Saints uniform this year, more than halfway to his career-high total set last season in the Boston organization between Double-A and Triple-A. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure) & 3rd in OPS in MiLB:

TWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins (26-20) have won 13 straight, MLB's longest win streak of the season, after topping the Brewers 7-0 yesterday. Pablo Lopez tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing two hits while walking two and striking out six. Justin Topa, Jorge Alcala, and Kody Funderburk each pitched a shutout inning to complete the shutout. Six different players had multi-hit games with Ryan Jeffers and Kody Clemens both homering. Wichita (21-17) were 11-2 winners over Arkansas with Kyle Fedko going 2-4 with a double, home run, and four RBI. High-A Cedar Rapids (22-15) fell 6-5 to Peoria, and Fort Myers (18-20) beat Jupiter 6-5 in 10.

LAST APPEARANCE: Started in Tuesday night's series opener in Des Moines, and settled in after allowing two runs in the first inning. After giving up an RBI single to Kevin Alcantara that made it 2-0, threw up zeros in innings 2-4, pitching around traffic in each inning on the night with the help of three double plays. Threw 21 four-seamers (25%), 21 cutters (25%), 17 changeups (20%), 15 sinkers (18%), 6 curveballs (7%), and 5 sweepers (6%). Induced eight whiffs, led by four on his changeup (4/12 for a 33% whiff-rate). Recorded his lone punchout on the curveball, getting James Triantos to chase in the dirt in the fourth.

ON THE FAST TRACK: In just his second full-season in the minors last year, Morris ascended through three levels of the minor league ladder to finish the year making his first six starts at the Triple-A level. It's not the first time that Morris has accelerated at a faster pace than his peers. He graduated high school at just 16 years old, starting his freshman season of college at just 17. He was born on the cutoff date of September 1 for starting school and his mother chose to start him in kindergarten a year ahead. Not only that, he also skipped second grade as he was being homeschooled in Alaska.

BUILDING UP TRAVEL POINTS: Although he was born in New York City, Morris claims Boulder, Colorado as his hometown. He moved from NYC as a child to Oregon, then to Alaska, and then to Colorado, where he attended Monarch High School in Boulder. He tells people Boulder is where he's from as that's where he lived the longest.

LET'S GET FUNKY: Lacking the prototypical build of a frontline starter, Morris' unusual delivery has been noted as a reason why hitters have such a hard time picking up his pitches. Fangraphs prospect writer Eric Longenhagen noted in [last year's mid-season report](#) that "Morris' delivery is weird. He has a high front side throughout his delivery and creates a slight crossfire angle with stride direction before throwing out of a high arm slot. It's rare for cross-bodied pitchers to also have a north/south arm slot this extreme and it seems to disorient hitters."

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Before transferring to Texas Tech for his senior year, Morris pitched for three years at Division 2 Colorado Mesa University, helping his team reach the DII National Championship Game in 2019 as a freshman (Mesa finished as Runner-up to Tampa that year). Morris was named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year for his efforts that season and was a Division 2 2nd-Team All-American in 2021 before transferring to Texas Tech as a redshirt junior.

MAD MORRIS: Morris' mound routine can involve arguing with himself or talking to himself on the mound. "I'm really just analyzing the last pitch, moving on to the next pitch and what it should be," Morris remarked. "Sometimes there are not-so-nice words involved, but real it's 'Trust it. Throw it to the mask' Other times, 'it's good left side, how can we work off of that? What's next, and then next?' There's lots of things going through my head."
