CARDIAC FREDNATS: After winning the first series of the two-week home stand with a six-run comeback and walk-off victory, the FredNats begin the biggest series of the year so far with the Fayetteville Woodpeckers, Single-A affiliate of the Houston Astros. The teams will play seven total games to make up for a rainout the last time Fayetteville was in town. The standings implications of this series are noted below. RHP Bryan Polanco starts for the fourth time against Fayetteville this year and will pitch for the first of two scheduled starts this week. He has an ERA of 4.66 in his first three starts against FAY. He faces Woodpecker righty Raimy Rodriguez, who has allowed just two earned runs on seven hits in three starts against Fredericksburg this season. The FredNats now lead all of Minor League Baseball with nine walk-off wins this season.

ABOUT LAST WEEK: Fredericksburg won its first series in over a month, four games to two over Salem. Two of the four wins were in walk-off fashion, and on Sunday, erased a 7-1 deficit to win 10-9 in extra innings. The FredNats also drew a walk-off balk on Friday. The draft class was a heavy presence, driving in a combined 14 runs in the series.

STANDINGS WATCH: The FredNats are now just 1.0 game out of first place in the 2nd half in the North Division behind the Carolina Mudcats. Fayetteville is right on Fredericksburg's heels, 2.0 back of Carolina and just one game behind the FredNats. Fredericksburg has 14 home games remaining in the 2025 season, seven this week with the Woodpeckers and then seven with the Mudcats to finish up the 2025 regular season. Fredericksburg is 9-8 this year against the Woodpeckers depsite Fayetteville scoring 11 more runs in the season series.

INSTANT IMPACT: Fredericksburg currently has three members of Washington's 2025 draft class on the roster, and each player has made an instant impact since arriving to the team. Saturday night, 2nd round pick Ethan Petry hit his first professional home run, and also slugged two doubles for the first three extra-base hits and RBIs of his pro career. Then, 9th rounder Wyatt Henseler also slugged his first pro home run in the 8th inning. Henseler was promoted to Wilmington prior to today's game with Jorgelys Mota's activation from the injurd list. 14th round pick Nick Hollifield had the walk-off hit on Sunday, and on the weekend, he had four game-tying or go-ahead hits in the final three innings of the games. He's driven in seven runs and scored seven runs in his first seven FredNat games.

START EARLY: The FredNats are 54-54 overall this season, but are 18 games over .500 (32-14) when scoring first in 2025. In the first two innings this season, Fredericksburg has been outscored 79-117 (-38).

WHY TRY IT?: Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 82. Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB by four with 53 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 42% of would-be base stealers. 14 of the caught stealings this season have come against the Woodpeckers.

HE'S INEVITABLE: FredNat outfield prospect Cristhian Vaquero picked up his MiLB-leading fourth walk-off hit of the season last home stand, and overall, he's enjoyed a very strong second half of the season offensively, pairing his hot bat with his exceptional outfield defense. In 29 second half games, Vaquero is fifth in the league in batting average (.313), fourh in OPS (.866), and he's second among active players in slugging (.493). He's also fifth in hits (42) and sixth in total bases (66). He also picked up his 11th outfield assist of the season last week.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

LAST TIME OUT: Polanco failed to finish three innings last week against Salem, marking his shortest start since the first month of the season. He allowed seven total hits and three earned runs against the Red Sox, getting his first loss to Salem of the season.

LONG BALL LATELY: Polanco has allowed 14 home runs this year, the most of any FredNat pitcher and the most in Single-A baseball. Despite allowing seven hits to the Sox, Polanco did not surrender a home run for the first time in his last seven starts.

BYE BYE JULY: July was a real return to form month for Polanco, who posted a 3.50 ERA across 18.0 innings after an uncharacteristically inflated 5.23 mark in June. In August, a month in which he has a career 7.36 ERA in, he will look to limit the long ball more. Polanco allowed nine combined home runs between June and July this year.

VS FAYETTEVILLE: Polanco has come out on the losing end in each of his three starts against the Woodpeckers this season, despite having allowed only five earned runs in 9.2 IP. In those three starts, Polanco has 14 strikeouts, with 10 coming in a career-high performance on 6/14. That start is still the only double-digit strikeout outing for a FredNat pitcher this season.

BUY IN BULK: Polanco has been chomping up innings in the Carolina League over the past two years. Since the start of the 2024 season, no one has thrown more than Polanco's 183.2.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
