#### LAST TIME OUT...

**WORCESTER, Mass. (July 17, 2021)** –The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders game against the Worcester Red Sox Saturday at Polar Park was suspended in the second inning due to heavy rain. The RailRiders and Red Sox will resume the game on Sunday at 12:05 P.M., playing to a full nine innings with a seven-inning version of Sunday's series finale to follow.

The RailRiders will have runners on first and second with one out in the second inning when play resumes. The batter is slated to be Max McDowell. The top of the second has featured Thomas Milone singling to center and stealing second base, and Kyle Holder drawing a walk.

The contest is currently scoreless thanks to a great defensive play by Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the bottom of the first. With Danny Santana aboard at third, Franchy Cordero flew out to centerfielder Estevan Florial, who threw home to nab the runner tagging from third for a double play.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**TREY DAY:** After months of anticipation and literally thousands of reply tweets sent to the RailRiders social media accounts begging for such a move, the New York Yankees on Thursday announced the signing of OF **Trey Amburgey** to a major league contract and his addition to the Yankees 26-man roster ahead of Thursday's game with Boston. In parts of two seasons with the RailRiders, Amburgey hit .283/.341/.514 with 29 home runs and 97 RBIs in 162 games. From August 26, 2019 through July 10 (G2), 2021, the slugging outfielder had a franchise-record 42-game on-base streak. Amburgey was a 13th round pick of the Yankees in the 2015 MLB Draft out of St. Petersburg College in Lake Worth, Florida.

**MOVIN' ON UP:** Owing to the COVID health and safety protocols effecting the New York Yankees MLB roster, the RailRiders roster has seen dramatic change over the weekend. Before Friday's game, **Hoy Park**, **Rob Brantly**, and **Greg Allen** were all added to the Yankees 26-man roster for the first time, and **Chris Gittens** was recalled by the Yankees. In return the RailRiders received **Thomas Milone**, **Matt Pita**, **Donny Sands** and **Christian Perez** from Double-A Somerset. Milone and Perez have previous stints this year with SWB, while Pita and Sands are in their first go-arounds in Triple-A.

**IT'S THE FINAL STRETCH (DA NA NA NA):** In lieu of a traditional playoff in Triple-A Baseball, Major League Baseball announced on Wednesday that all Triple-A teams will compete in a 10-game postseason tournament called the Triple-A Final Stretch from September 22 through October 3. Each league will have a regular season champion, crowned for having the best record across 120 games, and a Final Stretch champion, crowned for having the best record in the added 10 games. Unlike any tournament you may be familiar with, the Triple-A Final Stretch has a set schedule of opponents and you continue to play even if you are eliminated from contention. MLB announced the RailRiders will play Syracuse from 9/22-26 at PNC Field and finish the Final Stretch at Rochester from 9/28-10/3. MLB also announced it will give a prize to the winners of the Final Stretch.

**SPLITSVILLE:** Wednesday's doubleheader with the Worcester Red Sox was the fourth twin bill of the season for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders. Thus far, the RailRiders have split them all, winning the first game thrice (6/10 at Buffalo, 7/7 vs Syracuse, 7/14 at Worcester) and the second game once (7/10 vs Syracuse). The doubleheader also marked the third double feature for the RailRiders in an eight-day span (7/7 and 7/10), completing a rough stretch of nine games in eight days. Overall, because of back-to-back seven-game series, SWB is finishing up a stretch of 14 games scheduled in 13 days. The RailRiders are 7-5 through the first 12 games of the run.

**WOO HOO:** The RailRiders complete their second series with the Worcester Red Sox tonight, playing games six and seven in a seven-game, six-day set. This is the second consecutive such series for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. The RailRiders have won four of the first five games in the set to clinch a series win. The season series with the WooSox is condensed into 24 games in a span of 54 days. SWB travels to Polar Park for 18 contests, with the WooSox heading to PNC Field only once. Worcester is tied with Syracuse for the second-most frequent opponent of the RailRiders this season after the club's 36 games with Lehigh Valley. Worcester took three of five games in the first matchup of the year with SWB.

**HIGHWAY ROBBERY:** After stealing just 39 bases in their first 45 games, the RailRiders have been on a roll since the start of the last series at Worcester. In its last 16 games, SWB is 27-for-35 (.771) in stolen base attempts, including a team-record tying seven on 6/29 at Worcester and another five on 7/6 vs Syracuse. Seven steals in a game tied a franchise mark set by the SWB Yankees on June 6, 2008 against the Norfolk Tides. **Andrew Velazquez** accomplished the rare feat of stealing three bases in one inning, while **Estevan Florial** (2), **Hoy Park** and **Ryan LaMarre** (1 each) all stole bags against the Red Sox. The barrage has SWB up to 66 steals on the year, fourth in Triple-A East, with Worcester leading the way with 79. Velazquez is one shy of the Triple-A East lead with 18 steals on the season (Brian Miller, Jacksonville).

**BULLS ON PARADE:** Since **Kyle Barraclough** relieved **Albert Abreu** in the sixth inning of the RailRiders game at Buffalo on Friday, June 11, the SWB bullpen has performed at an amazing clip. In the last 37 days, the bullpen has combined for a 2.18 ERA (36 ER/148.0 IP), while allowing just 110 hits, 51 walks and recording 182 strikeouts. The current stretch has lowered SWB's bullpen ERA to 2.78 on the season, the third-best in MiLB (1st, Somerset, 2.69). The bullpen's 32 wins are tied for second-most in the minors behind only Tampa's 41.

**HERE COME THE YANKEES:** Around the halfway point of the season, the Yankees minor league system still stands alone across minor league baseball as the most successful. Not only are all four full season affiliates currently in first place in their respective divisions, but they have an average divisional lead of nearly four games. Each affiliate has won at least 40 games entering play on Sunday afternoon, and as a whole, the Yankees have an organizational record of 183-95 (.658). That is 2.5-games better than second-place Tampa Bay's 179-94 (.656) organizational record.

# RAILRIDERS STARTING PITCHER

**54 BRODY KOERNER • RHP • 6'2" • 220 LBS • 27**

**LAST TIME OUT:** After two appearances out of the bullpen, Koerner was solid in his second start back in the RailRiders rotation, allowing two runs in 4.2 innings in Tuesday's series opener. The right-hander was touched up early in the start, but settled down to retire the final nine batters he faced and got stronger as the start went on. He walked one and struck out four, one off his season-high.

**WELCOME BACK, KOERNER:** After not playing in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Brody Koerner returns to the RailRiders for his third season with the club. He has the distinction of being the longest-tenured pitcher on the team who has stayed within the Yankees organization, with 41 appearances (30 starts) spread out since the start of the 2018 season. Only teammate Adam Warren (69 G) has made more appearances with SWB than Koerner, but left the Yankees organization on multiple occasions. Warren (56 GS) also has more starts with the RailRiders/SWB Yankees than Koerner.

**STAFF WORKHORSE:** During the 2019 season, Koerner logged 138.2 innings between Double-A Trenton and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, tying him for most among Yankees minor leaguers (Miguel Yajure -- Charleston, Tampa). The right-hander also finished t-3<sup>rd</sup> in GS (22), 6<sup>th</sup> in AVG (.289) and Winning Percentage (4-8 combined), 7<sup>th</sup> in ERA (5.00) and WHIP (1.53), and 10<sup>th</sup> in K (109).

**HEADING OVERSEAS:** Following the 2019 season, Koerner left the country to play for the Gigantes del Cibao in the Dominican Winter League. It was the first time in his career that he played in a foreign winter league after the regular MiLB season. Koerner went 1-3 with a 2.17 ERA in seven starts with the Gigantes, striking out 21 and walking 17 in 29.0 innings. The right-hander was teammates with several former SWB RailRiders in the DWL, including Abiatal Avelino, Greg Bird, José DePaula, Anyelo Gómez and Adonis Rosa. Also appearing for the team were Wander Franco (No. 1 prospect in baseball) and Eloy Jimenez. Syracuse starter Jesus Reyes also played for the Gigantes.

**2021 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Began the season on the RailRiders Break Camp Roster.
- Has allowed 2-or-fewer earned runs in 10 of his 11 appearances this season.

- Full name is Brody Tyler Koerner.
- Pitched for Clemson for three seasons (2013-15) and was 5-7 with a 7.00 ERA (97.2 IP, 76 ER) in 31 G/19 GS.
- Graduated from Clemson in 2015 with a degree in Accounting and was a 2x ACC Academic Honor Roll member.
- Graduated from Jay M. Robinson HS (NC) where he lettered three years in baseball, three in basketball and one in football. Was a two-time All-State selection in baseball.
- Born in Winchester, VA but grew up in Concord, NC, a suburb of Charlotte.
