FOR STARTERS: The Rocket City Trash Pandas begin a six-game homestand with game one of a six-game series against the Milwaukee Brewers affiliate Biloxi Shuckers at Toyota Field ... The clubs will meet 12 times this season, and this is the first of two series against the Shuckers in 2025, with the Pandas making a return trip to Biloxi, July 22-27 ... Rocket City is coming off of a 4-8 road trip to Pensacola (2-4) and Chattanooga (2-4) ... All-time the Shuckers lead the series 30-25, and were 12-6 against Rocket City in 2024...

TRASH PANDAS DROP SERIES FINALE IN CHATTANOOGA: Chase Burns led the Chattanooga Lookouts to a 7-2 victory over the Rocket City Trash Pandas. The top prospect for the Reds won his second game of the series and fourth of the season, striking out a career-high 10 while allowing only one run on three hits. The Lookouts secured the series by winning four out of six games against the Trash Pandas. Rocket City initially took a 1-0 lead, but the Lookouts responded with three runs in the fourth inning, aided by a two-run single from Dominic Pitelli. **Josh Crouch** contributed a solo home run in the seventh. Rocket City finished the 12-game road trip with a 4-8 record.

ROSTER MOVES: On Tuesday, the Angels placed Rocket City LHP **Houston Harding** on the 60-day Injured List. The lefty out of Mississippi State last appeared in a game on May 11 ... On Wednesday, the Angels activated INF **Cole Fontenelle** from the Development List, placing the Trash Pandas roster at 27 active players

HOMECOMING FOR MITCH DALY: On May 20, the Trash Pandas added INF **Mitch Daly**, who attended Madison's Bob Jones High School. He was a four-year starter at shortstop and ranked as the top shortstop in Alabama, signing with Texas and eventually finishing his college career at Kentucky. Daly moved eight times as a kid, was born in Fort Hood, TX, and was the son of a four-star General in the United States Army, Edward Daly. This week will be his first experience playing at Toyota Field.

JUST A WALK IN THE PARK: After nine walks on Saturday night, Rocket City has drawn 188 walks this season, ranking 2nd in the Southern League (to Biloxi, 226) and 7th in all the minors.

RADA IS RUNNING WILD: CF **Nelson Rada**, the youngest player in the Southern League at 19 years and 8 months, leads all of Double-A with 22 stolen bases this season, including 17 in May. **Rada ranks among the league leaders in stolen bases** (1st, 22), OBP (1st, .404), batting average (9th, .276), and walks (T-3rd, 29)

"MAY" BE A GOOD MONTH FOR BROWN AND RADA: Over 21 games in May, **Sam Brown** is 4th in the league in batting at .312 (24-for-77), with eight extra-base hits, and 12 RBIs, and **Nelson Rada** is 3rd in batting at .314 (22-for-70). This month, Rada leads all of Double-A and is 4th in MiLB with 17 stolen bases.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU: INF **Sam Brown** has reached base safely in 27 of his last 32 games since April 18, posting a .327 batting average (36-for-110), tops in the Southern in batting over that time. **Brown ranks among the league leaders in doubles** (T-5th, 8), batting average (7th, .281), OBP (6th, .378), hits (8th, 41), and OPS (9th, .762). Defensively, Brown hasn't committed an error in 42 games, which is T-1st (w/PNS Nathan Martorella) in the Southern League.

THE "GUZ" IS LOOSE AGAIN: Over the last two weeks, **Denzer Guzman** is T-2nd in the Southern League with 10 RBI, recording three doubles and a home run on May 22 at Chattanooga. The 21-year-old now **ranks among the Southern League leaders in RBI** (4th, 25), doubles (T-5th, 8), extra-base hits (T-8th, 13), and home runs (T-10th, 5).

NEED TO SCORE FOUR: The Trash Pandas have won 14 games this season, scoring four or more runs in each victory. They are 14-8 when scoring four or more runs and 0-21 when scoring three runs or fewer.

BUSY BULLPEN ARMS: Three Rocket City relievers rank in appearances among the top six of the Southern League. **Jared Southard** and **Brady Choban** are T-1st with 16. **Samy Natera Jr.** is T-5th with 15 outings. Natera is also T-7th with four saves.

C-MO TO TRIPLE-A: The LA Angel's top prospect and eighth-overall pick in the 2024 draft, **Christian Moore**, was promoted to Triple-A Salt Lake on May 20. The former All-American at Tennessee heads west riding a seven-game hitting streak and has been on base in 16 of his last 17 games, batting .302 (19-for-63).

PUTTING THE HURT ON 'EM: Starter **Joel Hurtado** leads the club with four quality starts and ranks among the Southern League leaders in several categories, including ERA (10th, 3.51), innings pitched (1st, 48.2), WHIP (10th, 1.27), and wins (T-10th, 3).

BACK TO THE ROOST: Former Rocket City Trash Panda RHP **Coleman Crow** returns to Toyota Field for the first time since 2023. Crow spent the 2022 and part of the 2023 seasons with the Pandas. In 2022, Crow made 24 starts, compiling a 9-3 record with a 4.85 ERA over 128 innings, striking out 128 batters. He was the Southern League's June Pitcher of the Month. Crow had a strong start, going 2-0 with a 1.88 ERA and 31 strikeouts in 24 innings over four starts. In June 2023, the Angels traded Crow and fellow pitcher Landon Marceaux to the New York Mets in exchange for infielder Eduardo Escobar.

BUTTS AND SAUCE: On Monday, Trash Pandas announced two new alternate identities for 2025, paying homage to the long history of BBQ in Alabama, the Bama Butts and Alabama White Sauce! The identities and specialty uniforms will be worn during a delicious, slow-cooked, and saucy weekend at Toyota Field on Friday, June 13, and Saturday, June 14. The BBQ Weekend at Toyota Field will be highlighted by "Best Pork Butt" and "Best White Sauce" contests.

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ADDITIONAL NOTES (CONT)

PROSPECTS WITH A HALO: The Trash Pandas roster features four of the Angels' top 10 prospects and nine of the top 25; included in the top 10 are RHP **George Klassen** (3), LHP **Sam Aldegheri** (5), OF **Nelson Rada** (6), and INF **Denzer Guzman** (9). The other members of the roster included in the Top-30 include LHP **Samy Natera Jr.** (16), RHP **Walbert Ureña** (17), RHP **Joel Hurtado** (19), RHP **Camden Minacci** (20), and INF **Cole Fontenelle** (23).

PANDAS ADD VETERAN ARMS: On May 7 the Trash Pandas added a pair of right-handed pitchers in 28-year-old **Jordan Holloway** and 31-year-old **Sean Poppen**. Both were signed in April and have combined for 78 MLB appearances since 2019. Holloway appeared in 15 games for Miami in 2021-22, and Poppen pitched in 63 MLB games for the Twins, Pirates, Rays, and Diamondbacks. He also pitched in the Southern League for Pensacola in 2018 and Chattanooga in 2019, while they were affiliated with the Twins. On May 10, the Trash Pandas added LHP **José Quijada**, who hadn't pitched since spring training. Over four-plus years of MLB service, he holds a career 4.64 ERA in 140 games for both the Marlins and the Angels, with 172 strikeouts, 84 walks over 128.0 innings pitched. He was claimed off waivers by the Angels on February 10, 2020, after being designated for assignment by the Marlins on February 3, 2020. He has since served as a bullpen arm for the Halos. His 2023 season was cut short due to an elbow injury that required Tommy John surgery. After recovering, he returned in 2024, not allowing a run in 17 of 22 outings for the Angels, including a streak of 12 consecutive scoreless appearances (11.0 innings) between August 14 and September 18.

MLB EXPERIENCE: The Trash Pandas boast seven players on the roster with Major League experience after the recent additions. **Sam Aldegheri** made his MLB debut on August 30, 2024, for the Angels, vs. Seattle, and made three starts for the Angels over the remainder of the season. **Kelvin Cáceres** made his debut for the Angels on September 27, 2023, vs. Texas, and appeared in two total games that season. **Jesus Cruz** made his MLB debut for on August 18, 2020 for the Cardinals, and has appeared in eight games between the Cardinals (20) and Braves (22). **Jordan Holloway** made his MLB debut on July 26, 2020, for the Marlins, and appeared in 15 games (4 starts) for Miami from 2020-2023, posting a 3.29 ERA. **Sean Poppen** made his MLB debut on June 19, 2019, for the Twins and has appeared in 63 games for the Twins (10), Pirates (3), Rays (1), and Diamondbacks (49) since 2019, posting a 5.08 career ERA. **José Quijada** made his MLB debut for the Marlins on April 24, 2019, against Cleveland, and has appeared in 140 games for the Marlins (34) and Angels (106) since 2019, logging a 4.64 ERA and eight saves. The only position player with MLB experience is **Travis Blankenhorn**, who made his MLB debut on September 15, 2020, for the Twins against the White Sox. Overall, he's played in 49 career games for the Twins (2), Mets (24), and Nationals (23) since 2020.

FIRST SERIES WIN: The series win in Knoxville, April 29-May 4, marked the first series win of the season, and the first series win since June 25-30 at Chattanooga, winning four of six.

APRIL IS IN THE BOOKS: The Trash Pandas finished April with a 6-16 record, the lowest win total in April and a whole month in club history. The .250 winning percentage was the second-lowest in club history, trailing the .133 win percentage after a 2-13 September in 2023. Rocket City finished last in the Southern League with a .201 team batting average and 4.58 ERA as a pitching staff.

THE YOUNG GUNS: The Trash Pandas have three of the nine youngest players in the Southern League. For the second-straight year, OF **Nelson Rada** is the youngest player in the Southern League at 19.6 years old (8/24/05). INF **Denzer Guzman** is the eighth-youngest at 21.2 years old (2/8/04), and RHP **Walbert Ureña** is the ninth-youngest, just 14 days older than Guzman, born on 1/25/04 at 21.2 years old (1/25/04). Rada had a fantastic spring with the Angels, batting .333 over 11 games, a .370 on-base percentage, and six RBI. The Venezuela native spent the 2024 season in Rocket City, hitting .234 with 13 extra-base hits in 123 games. The 19-year-old was seventh in the Southern League with 35 stolen bases as the youngest player in the league. Guzman was promoted to Rocket City on May 7, collecting six home runs, nine doubles, and 30 RBI in 83 games. The 21-year-old from the Dominican Republic had his season highlighted with a walk-off grand slam on May 25, leading the Trash Pandas to a win over Montgomery.

DARRELL-HICKS, QUERO, AND FERMIN LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: The Los Angeles Angels called up right-handed reliever **José Fermin** from Rocket City, becoming the 39th player promoted from Rocket City to the Majors. Fermin, third this season, and 13th to bypass Triple-A. Fermin was 3-0 record and a 1.13 ERA in six relief appearances this season, and was the first Southern League pitcher to earn three wins. A native of the Dominican Republic, he began his professional career in 2024 and advanced through the Angels' minor league system. The Chicago White Sox promoted **Edgar Quero** from Triple-A Charlotte, and he made his MLB debut on April 17 vs. Oakland. He picked up his first hit on April 18 at Boston. Quero, a 22-year-old switch-hitting catcher from Cienfuegos, Cuba, was acquired by the White Sox in a 2023 trade with the Los Angeles Angels involving pitchers Lucas Giolito and Reynaldo López. Quero skipped High-A and joined Rocket City in 2023. In 60 games, he posted a .242 batting average with 2 home runs, 32 RBIs, and 35 runs scored. His on-base percentage stood out at .378, thanks to 45 walks ... Former Trash Pandas pitcher **Michael Darrell-Hicks** had his contract selected by the Angels on April 6 but was optioned back to Triple-A Salt Lake on April 7. The Angels recalled Darrell-Hicks again on April 11 from Triple-A Salt Lake and made his debut that day against the Houston Astros. In his debut appearance, he pitched one inning, allowing four earned runs on three hits and issuing three walks ... He was 6-4 with a 1.73 ERA over 30 relief outings in 2024 for the Trash Pandas, earning eight saves in ten chances and 46 strikeouts to eight walks over 41.2 innings. Overall, Darrell-Hicks had a 6-7 record in Rocket City over 33 games and three starts, striking out 58 and walking 13 over 53.2 innings in 2023 and 2024.

FONTENELLE'S CYCLE: Not only was Cole Fontenelle's cycle on April 8 vs. Knoxville the first in Trash Pandas history, but it was the first in the Southern League since former Smokies star Moises Ballesteros did it on June 15, 2024, at Biloxi. Fontenelle led off each at-bat, which has only been done once in MLB history, by Todd Helton in 1999 against the Florida Marlins. The last LA Angels' minor league player to hit for the cycle was José Rojas, who hit for the cycle on May 11, 2018, while playing for the Double-A Mobile BayBears. Rojas completed his cycle with a grand slam in the eighth inning, leading the BayBears to a 14-3 win over the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park.

TOYOTA FIELD MAGIC: **Denzer Guzman's** walk-off blast on April 5 vs. Chattanooga was his second as a Trash Panda, following a walk-off grand slam against Montgomery in May last year. The Trash Pandas had six walk-offs last season, including the previous walk-off home run on July 15, when Christian Moore hit an opposite-field home run. It was the 18th walk-off win in Toyota Field history. Guzman's first two hits of 2025 were three-run homers.

SCHEDULE UPDATE: The Sunday, April 6, game against the Chattanooga Lookouts that was postponed by inclement weather will be made up as part of a Wednesday, June 18, doubleheader when the Lookouts are back in Madison. The series will stretch from June 17 to 22 and now feature seven games in six days. Both games will be seven innings, with game one starting at 4:05 pm and game two starting roughly 45 minutes after the completion of game one.

- **2024 in Review:** Went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA (13.0 IP - 7 ER) and 10 strikeouts in three starts for Angels ... Made Major League debut Aug. 30 vs. Seattle and allowed two earned runs on six hits with two walks and three strikeouts across 5.0 innings pitched (L, 5.0 IP, 6 H, 7 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR, 2 HBP)
- Earned first Major League win in his second career start, Sept. 6 at Texas, and became the first Italian-born player to win a Major League game since Cleveland's Marino Pieretti in 1949
- Became first pitcher born and raised in Italy to play in the Majors ... Hewas the fifth Italian-born MLB pitcher and ... first since Cleveland's Marino Pieretti in 1950, but each of the previous four Italian-born pitchers moved to the United States in their childhoods ... Overall, became eighth Italian-born player in Major League history and first since Seattle's Alex Liddi (2011-2013) ... First Italian-born player in Angels franchise history
- Acquired by Angels alongside minor league RHP George Klassen from Philadelphia in exchange for RHP Carlos Estévez on July 27. Assembled a 6-9 record and 3.59 ERA (95.1 IP - 38 ER) with 134 strikeouts in 19 starts between High-A Jersey Shore (PHI) and Double-A Reading (PHI) and Rocket City (LAA)
- At the time of his promotion to Double-A on July 9, he led the South Atlantic League and ranked second at the High-A level with 95 strikeouts...Also led High-A with 12.57 strikeouts per nine innings (min. 60 IP). Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for June 10-16 following a start against the Wilmington Blue Rocks, where he tossed 6.0 shutout innings on just two hits and two walks with nine strikeouts.
- **CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Was rated as having the best pitch control in the Phillies system by Baseball America following the 2023 season
