### **SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES**

<u>EARNING A SPOT</u>: MLB Pipeline announced on Monday that **OF Jackson Chourio** and **INF Tyler Black** were named to the MLB Pipeline Prospect Team of the Week... The pair were the second and third Shuckers' to be named to the prospect Team of the Week in 2023, and the first since **C Jeferson Quero** earned a spot on the team for the week of May 22.

ACTION JACKSON'S MONTH: OF Jackson Chourio has hit safely in 10 straight games, his longest since he tallied a hit in 13 straight from May 24 to June 7, 2022... Chourio has multi-hit efforts in nine of those 10 games, including a streak of four straight entering today... Over the 10 game streak, Chourio is hitting .489 (23-47) with 4 doubles, a triple, 4 home runs, 13 RBI, 12 runs and 5 stolen bases... Chourio is also six home runs away from becoming the first teenager with a 20/20 season between Double-A and Triple-A since OF Delmon Young in 2005.

<u>TYLER'S TERROR</u>: INF Tyler Black extended his hit streak to seven games with a double on Sunday... In July, Black has hit safely in 12 of 14 games, hitting .345 (20-58) with 5 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 7 RBI and 5 stolen bases... Since June 1, Black owns a .346/.446/.654 slash line with a 1.100 OPS over 34 games.

THE OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION: Over six games last week against the Montgomery Biscuits, the Shuckers scored 55 runs, the most in Double-A and the third-most in Minor League Baseball... The Shuckers also enter today with at least 10 hits in seven straight games, and seven-plus runs in 10 of their last 11 games... The Shuckers' 29 home runs in July are the second-most in Double-A and tied for the fourth-most in Minor League Baseball.

**CLUTCH GENE**: **C Nick Kahle** smashed a bases-clearing double to the wall in right-center on Saturday night, giving Biloxi a 10-7 lead during their 10-run ninth inning... In games when the Shuckers' trail by three runs or fewer, are tied or are ahead by only one run in the seventh or later, Kahle is 4-5 with two doubles, two walks and six RBI... Since the start of July, Kahle is a perfect 4-4 in the situation with two doubles and two singles.

<u>HE'S ON THE MOVE</u>: With two stolen bases on Thursday, INF Tyler Black has 45 stolen bases in 2023, seven away from tying **OF Johnny Davis**' franchise record of 52, set in 2017... Black enters today with 17 stolen bases against the Biscuits, the most by any opposing player this year... Black currently leads the Southern League and Double-A in the category.

Meeker has gone at least five innings in two of his last three starts, including five shutout innings on July 4 at Pensacola... At MGM Park, Meeker has a 3.80 ERA in 10 appearances and two starts... He also enters today with five walks in 54.1 innings, the lowest walk rate in Minor League Baseball (2.2%).
