LAST OUTING: Lindblom's last time out was a start against the Indianapolis Indians on June 9 at First Horizon Park. The right-hander worked 4.0 innings and limited Indy to just 1 hit and 1 walk to go along with 4 strikeouts. He got a no decision in Nashville's 9-4 win and threw 55 pitches, 39 for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Lindblom is facing Gwinnett for the third time in his career, and first since 2017. He pitched in relief against Gwinnett on June 3, 2017 and again on July 9, 2017.
