FIVE HOME RUNS BUOY FRISCO WIN IN AMARILLO:

Frisco used five home runs to beat the Amarillo Sod Poodles 10-7 and take a 2-0 series lead on Wednesday night from HODGETOWN. Frisco (7-4) got a leadoff blast from **Frainyer Chavez**, his third of the year, off of Amarillo (2-9) starter Daniel Eagen (0-3). **John Taylor** then promptly launched his second homer of the year – a two-run shot – for a 3-0 lead in the first inning. **Keith Jones II**'s first home run of 2026 highlighted a three-run third inning that gave Frisco starter **Blake Townsend** a 6-0 advantage to work with. Townsend turned in three scoreless innings before allowing a home run to Manuel Pena and three earned runs in the fourth, but got help from **Wilian Bormie** (3-0) to end the frame. **Keyber Rodriguez** smacked a solo shot in the fifth inning, though, and **Corey Joyce** blasted a three-run bomb in the eighth to bring Frisco to double-digit runs on the night.

ORLANDO, WHERE DREAMS COME TRUE:

Riders outfielder **Orlando Martinez** has enjoyed his first two days in Amarillo. On Tuesday, he collected 5 hits (going 5-for-6), the only 5-hit game in the Texas League this year and one of two in Double-A. It is the only 5-hit game with 2 home runs in the Minor Leagues this year and the third time in franchise history (since 2005) a Riders player accomplished the feat, joining **Cody Freeman** on April 25th, 2024 and **Abimelec Ortiz** on September 14th, 2024. Freeman's was at home against Amarillo, while Ortiz collected the 5 hits and 2 home runs at Amarillo. On Wednesday, Martinez ripped three more hits, and is hitting .727 (8-for-11)/.727/.1545/2.272 in the first two games of the series. This week, he is 1st in the minors in hits (8), doubles (3) and OPS (2.272, min. 10 PA).

CHAVEZ IN CHARGE:

RoughRiders infielder **Frainyer Chavez** has been on fire at the plate. Last Thursday, Chavez tied a career high with 4 hits, going 4-for-5, followed that up with a two-hit game on Friday, including a home run, and another blast on Sunday. In his 11 games, he has reached in all 11, and is hitting .319 (15-for-47)/.400/.553/.953 with 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 7 RBIs, 7 walks and just 8 strikeouts. The five-year RoughRider is 9th in the league in T-1st in runs (13), T-3rd in home runs (3), 4th in total bases (26) and T-4th in hits (15).

THIS BASEBALL BAT BRO CAN SWING IT:

RoughRiders utility player **John Taylor** rides a 8-game hitting streak into action on Thursday. In the streak, he is hitting .323 (10-for-31)/.405/.548/.953 with 1 double, 2 home runs, 9 RBIs, 5 walks and 7 runs scored. Taylor has hit safely in every game he has played in except for one while collecting multiple hits in 3 games. The streak is the longest-active streak on the Riders and the fourth-longest active streak in the Texas League. Taylor is part of the social media-famous Baseball Bat Bros, who rate baseball bats and have over 1 million followers on YouTube, TikTok and Instagram.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 11 games the RoughRiders are 1st in Double-A with 119 hits and T-1st among all non-Triple-A teams. Among teams with at least 11 games played, they are second in Double-A in batting average (.295) and 5th in runs (71, 6.5 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. The Riders are 2nd in the Texas League in homers (15) while they are 1st in SLG (.468) and OPS (.828). For perspective, the Yankees led MLB last year with a .787 team OPS. On Tuesday and Wednesday, they scored 15 and 10 runs, plating 10+ runs in back-to-back games for the first time since May 13-14, 2025 vs. CC. The last time they scored 10+ in three-straight was July 3-5, 2022. The Riders have six qualified hitters batting over .300 (see table), accounting for 30 percent of all Texas League batters hitting over .300 (20 total).

QUITE THE DEBUT:

RoughRiders infielder **Corey Joyce** collected two hits, including a three-run home run, in his first Frisco start on Wednesday. After being signed as a MiLB free agent on April 8th, he joined the Riders on April 14th. With Double-A Knoxville in the Cubs organization last year, he hit just two home runs in 92 games with a .272/.393/.347/.740 slashline. The longtime Tigers farmhand was a 12th-round pick by Detroit in 2019 and played for them through 2024.

AMARILLO BY MORNING:

In 2025, the Riders went 12-6 against Amarillo and showed off the power, hitting 22 homers while allowing 12 overall. In HODGETOWN, the Riders hit 18 home runs in 12 games, following a trend over the years. Since Amarillo joined the Texas League in 2019, the Riders have played 85 games in HODGETOWN, 14 more than the next-closest team (Midland). In those 85 games, Frisco has hit 149 home runs (1.8 HR/G) averaging 6.5 runs per game. Since 2019, Frisco is averaging just 0.8 HR/G at all other Texas League parks and averaging just 4.8 R/G since 2019 in all other parks. Former Rider **Blaine Crim** holds the record for the most home runs at HODGETOWN by a visiting player, hitting 10 over his 18 games there while slashing .354/.381/.785/1.166. **Abimelec Ortiz** (8) and **Justin Foscue** (7) are also in the top 5 among visiting players. The RoughRiders franchise record for most home runs in a six game series is 17 and has been done three times, all in Amarillo (6/7-6/12, 2022 at AMA... 8/30-9/4, 2022 at AMA ... 9/10-15, 2024 at AMA).

ABOUT WINSTON

- Signed by Rangers for \$10,000 in 2019.
- Worked on increasing his fastball velocity from the low 90s when he signed. He spent the fall of 2023 at the Rangers spring training facility and working out in the biomechanics' lab where the velocity was up to 99 mph.
- Looking to become the first player born in Payita to make MLB debut.
- Enters the 2025 season as the No. 4 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB Pipeline.
- Enters the 2025 season as the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB Pipeline.
- Was named First Team All-Spring Breakout after throwing three perfect frames with six strikeouts on March 16th, 2025 against the Giants prospects.
- Was placed on the Injured List with a Back Stress Reaction on April 22nd. Activated on August 29th.

2024 SEASON

- After the graduation of Wyatt Langford from MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30, Santos went from unranked to No. 15.
- Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on April 23rd after striking out 12 in 5.0 scoreless innings during 5-3 win over Greensboro on April 19th.
- Owned 0.44 ERA over four April starts, striking out 31 over 20.2 IP to just seven walks.
- After striking out just 19.9% of batters in 2023, he recorded a 30.5% K-rate with Hickory in 2024.
- Poured in best Double-A start in second outing against Arkansas, allowing one unearned run over five innings with seven strikeouts in a win.
- Participated in the Futures Game in Arlington, allowing an unearned run over one inning pitched.
- In first career postseason start at Midland on 9/17, he picked up the loss, but struckout a career-high tying 12 batters over six innings while allowing two runs (one earned) on four hits and walking two. Frisco lost 2-0.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

PITCHING COACH

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).

Platts is back with the RoughRiders for his third season and his fourth in the Rangers organization in 2026.

In his first year, he was the strength and conditioning coach for the Low-A Down East Wood Ducks before spending a season with the Cubs, working in the Dominican Summer League.
