**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 4-2. Altoona took a 3-0 lead in the first inning on back-to-back homers by Blake Sabol and Aaron Shackelford. In the third, Shackelford went deep again with a solo shot to open a 4-0 lead. **Tyler Fitzgerald** supplied both of Richmond's runs with a pair of solo homers, one in the fifth and one in the eighth. **Ryan Walker**, **Nick Avila** and **Cole Waites** combined for 3.1 scoreless relief innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. This series is the final match-up between the two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-six at The Diamond from April 12-17, winning the series finale on a walk-off grand slam by **Will Wilson** in 10 innings. Altoona won four-of-six at PNG Field from May 17-22, winning the finale, 19-8. Altoona pitchers have hit a Richmond batter with a pitch 17 times this year, more than any of their other opponents, including hitting **Tyler Fitzgerald** six times. The Curve have surrendered 21 homers to the Flying Squirrels this season, more than any of their other opponents, including five by **Sean Roby**.

**TICKET PUNCHED:** The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 6-10 to open the second half. They won three straight prior to dropping the last two. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost four and split three this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 949 strikeouts and rank second with 110 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 21-22 on the road this year, all against Southwest Division opponents. Richmond is 21-15 in games decided by two-or-less runs and 38-29 overall against the Southwest Division.

**THE CURVE** went 33-36 in the first half of the season, finishing in fourth in the Southwest Division. In the second half, they are in third place with a 10-6 record. They won four-of-six in both of their first two series of the second half against Harrisburg and at Akron. The Altoona offense ranks first in the Eastern League with a .251 batting average and tied for first with 26 triples. Altoona's roster includes 13 of MLB.com's top-30 prospects, including Henry Davis (1 - on IL), Nick Gonzales (3 - on IL), Quinn Priester (4), Llover Peguero (5), Matt Frazier (9), Carmen Mlodzinski (13), Kyle Nicolas (17), Jared Triolo (18), Tahnaj Thomas (24), Luis Ortiz (25), Connor Scott (26), Blake Sabol (28) and Matt Gorski (29 - on IL).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Wil Jensen** makes his Double-A debut. He began the season with High-A Eugene, going 6-3 with a 2.84 ERA in 15 starts and three relief outings. Over his last four starts, Jensen went 4-0 with a 1.46 ERA (4 ER/24.2 IP) and struck out 30 batters. He last pitched last Saturday at Hillsboro and matched a season high with seven innings pitched, holding the Hops to two runs (one earned) with nine strikeouts. It was his second straight start working seven innings and striking out nine. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Jensen ranked tied for second in the Northwest League in wins (6) and tied for seventh in strikeouts (77). After four years at Pepperdine, Jensen signed as an undrafted free agent with the Giants in 2020. Jensen was born in Phoenix but grew up near Salt Lake City.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander Quinn Priester makes his fifth Double-A start of the season. Last time out, he worked five scoreless innings with six strikeouts at Akron on Sunday for his first Double-A win. He missed the start of the season with an oblique injury before making one start each for Low-A Bradenton and High-A Greensboro in mid-June. He was assigned to Double-A Altoona on June 16. Priester was selected in the first round (18th overall) by the Pirates out of Cary-Grove High School in Illinois in 2019. He pitched in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game last year in Denver.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,142) and total attendance (251,837). Richmond is 13th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 110 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (113). **Sean Roby** is first in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 179 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in every season except 2021, including 2010 (71), 2011 (83), 2012 (76), 2013 (109), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83), 2017 (93) and 2019 (84).

**GO, DIEGO, GO!** After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .352 (37-for-105) with six doubles, six homers and 25 RBIs over his last 27 games since June 7. In the series at Bowie from June 28-July 3, Rincones hit .600 (12-for-20) with a homer and two RBIs and struck out twice. In last week's series against Reading, Rincones hit .143 (3-for-21) with a double and three RBIs. He is hitting .278 (5-for-18) with a homer, a double and five RBIs in his four games in this week's series at Altoona.

**SHANE TRAIN:** From May 1-June 30, **Shane Matheny** hit .315 (39-for-124) with eight homers, five doubles, a triple and 24 RBIs in 38 games. Over his last 10 games since July 1, Matheny is batting .111 (4-for-36) with two doubles and six RBIs and has walked eight times. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season at the time. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. In the Eastern League this season, Matheny is ranked fifth in OBP (.400).

**TOASTY:** Over his last nine games since July 2, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .333 (23-for-36) with a homer, two doubles and six RBIs. On July 6, he hit the first grand slam of his professional career in a win over Reading. He hit .175 (10-for-57) over a 16-game stretch from June 9-29. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. He has hit 25 homers in his Flying Squirrels career, tied for fourth-most in franchise history. In the Eastern League this year, Tostado is ranked fourth in batting average (.296), tied for third in hits (83), and tied for ninth in total bases (134).

**ROBUST:** **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin' Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is first in the EL in home runs this year ahead of Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

**SMITH SURGING:** In his last seven games since July 7, **Armani Smith** is batting .360 (9-for-25) with four doubles and six RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in three-of-his-last-five games. On Tuesday and Wednesday, he played on the infield for the first time in his professional career, manning first base.

**FITZ ON FIRE:** **Tyler Fitzgerald** has homered four times over his last four games played since Sunday. He went deep in the series finale against Reading on Sunday. He added a solo homer on Thursday night in Altoona and hit two solo homers on Friday night. In his last five games since July 9, Fitzgerald is batting .438 (7-for-16) with four homers, a double and four RBIs.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked fourth in batting average (.296), tied for third in hits (83), and tied for ninth in total bases (134). **Sean Roby** is first in homers (23) and eighth in SLG (.506). **Shane Matheny** is fifth in OBP (.400). **Mike Gigliotti** is eighth in OBP (.385) and fourth in stolen bases (22). **Ryan Walker** is tied for third in wins (6). **Matt Frisbee** is tied for first in complete games (1).

**WHERE THE CURVE RANK:** In the Eastern League, Andres Alvarez is ninth in OBP (.377), 10th in SLG (.493), seventh in OPS (.870) and sixth in walks (46). Llover Peguero is tied for first in hits (84), tied for fifth in doubles (19), tied for third in triples (4) and sixth in stolen bases (20). Jared Triolo is tied for sixth in hits (80), tied for fourth in walks (47) and tied for eighth in steals (18). Aaron Shackelford is tied for seventh in homers (15) and fifth in SLG (.530). Matt Fraizer is second in triples (6). Tyler Samaniego is fifth in saves (7).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (11), **Cole Waites** (19), **Ricardo Genoves** (27) and **Chris Wright** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genoves (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.

**LOOKING AT THE FUTURE:** On July 6, it was announced by Major League Baseball that LHP **Kyle Harrison** will participate in the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles tonight. Harrison, currently rated by MLB.com as the San Francisco Giants' No. 2 prospect and the No. 27 overall prospect in baseball, will represent the Giants in the annual prospect showcase as part of MLB's All-Star festivities. The 2022 Futures Game features the top Minor League prospects competing as part of the first-ever All-Star Saturday. It will once again feature a National League vs. American League format, which was introduced in 2019 following 20 years of U.S. vs. World matchups. The game, which is scheduled for seven innings, will begin at 7 p.m. ET/4 PT exclusively on Peacock and SiriusXM.
